**PUBLIC NOTICE**

A debt payable in Pakistan currency or any other currency is owing by a banking company by reason of a deposit, not being a deposit in the name of a minor or a government or a court of law, at a branch of the banking company in respect of which no transaction has taken place and no statement of account has been requested or acknowledged by the creditor during the last ten years period are considered as unclaimed deposits. These include demand deposit, time deposit, pay order, demand draft, etc.

Banks/DFIs have surrendered their unclaimed deposits as of Dec 31, 2007 to SBP. State Bank is providing continuous access to information on the unclaimed deposits submitted by Banks/DFIs for the benefit of the general public. The list of unclaimed deposits for the year ended 2007 may be accessed at the following places:

1. Web site of State Bank of Pakistan ([www.sbp.org.pk](http://www.sbp.org.pk))
2. Field Offices of SBP Banking Services Corporation in Karachi, Lahore, Peshawar, Quetta, Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Faisalabad, Multan, Sialkot, Bahawalpur, Gujranwala, Hyderabad, Sukkur, D.I.Khan and Muzaffarabad.
3. All branches of Banks/DFIs including their head offices.
4. Respective web sites of Banks/DFIs, wherever available.

All the claimants can apply for refund in the bank branch where deposit/instrument account was opened/payable. In cases where such branches have been closed /shifted, the nearest branch of the same bank should be contacted.

It may please be noted that after completion of one-year from the date of making the list public, all unclaimed deposits/instruments will cease to be claimable and will be transferred to the government.
