## Law Officers (OG-3)

The responsibilities of incumbent will include but not limited to the following:

- 1. Provide legal advice / opinion on the issues pertaining to the various departments of the Bank and its subsidiaries to safeguard Bank's interest and avoid its exposure to legal and financial liabilities.
- 2. Examine and vet legal documents including contracts and other instruments.
- 3. Expertise in drafting /vetting speaking orders, guidelines, notices, documents, contracts, letters, legislation etc. in coordination with Bank's client departments and external advocates.
- 4. Attend meetings/ seminars/ hold discussions on behalf of the Bank with Legal Advisor with the higher management of the Bank or Government Authorities, Foreign Agencies / delegates pertaining to the legal issues/ contracts and policies of the Bank.
- 5. Interact with counterparts as and when required in commercial Banks with a view to discuss their problems and render legal advice and guidance from a supervisory and regulatory perspective.
- 6. Appear before the Court and various other for aon behalf of the Bank where necessary.

## **Legal Officers (OG-2)**

The responsibilities of incumbent will include but not limited to the following:

- 1. Coordinate with different departments of the Bank and its subsidiaries to facilitate legal advice/ opinion on the issues pertaining to general operations of the Bank.
