Figure 1: Export Receipts from group of countries

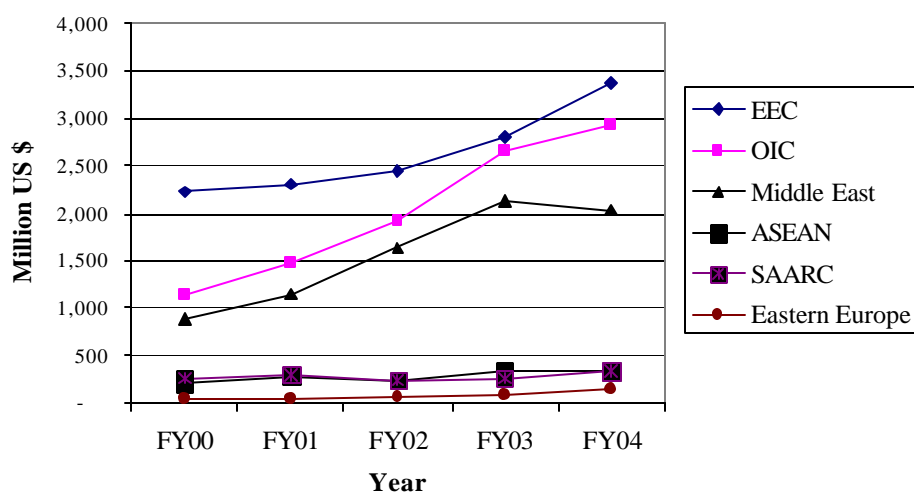

Figure 2: Export Receipts of five Major Commodity Groups.

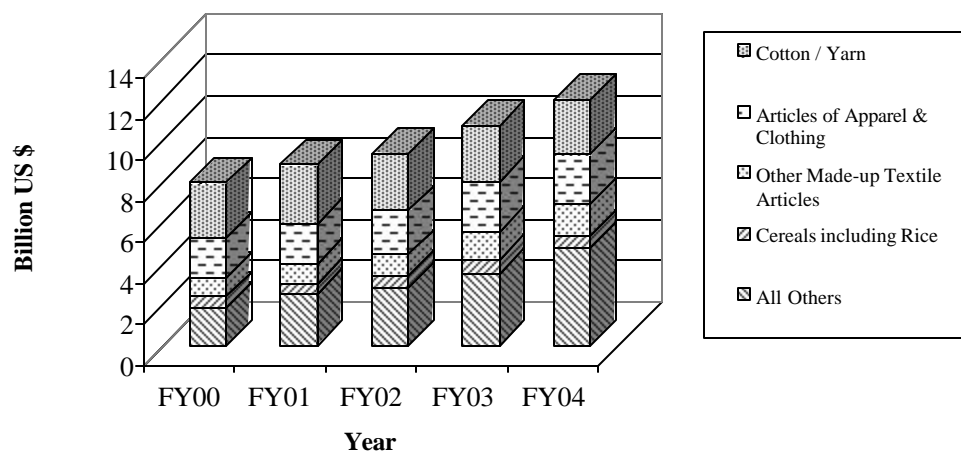


Figure 3: % Share of Major Commodities

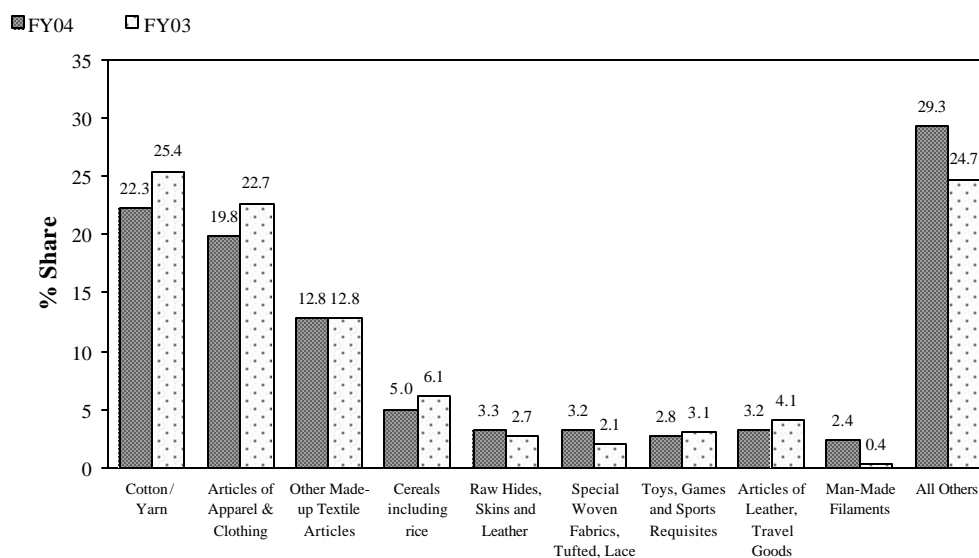


Figure 4: % Share of Export Receipts by Major Countries.

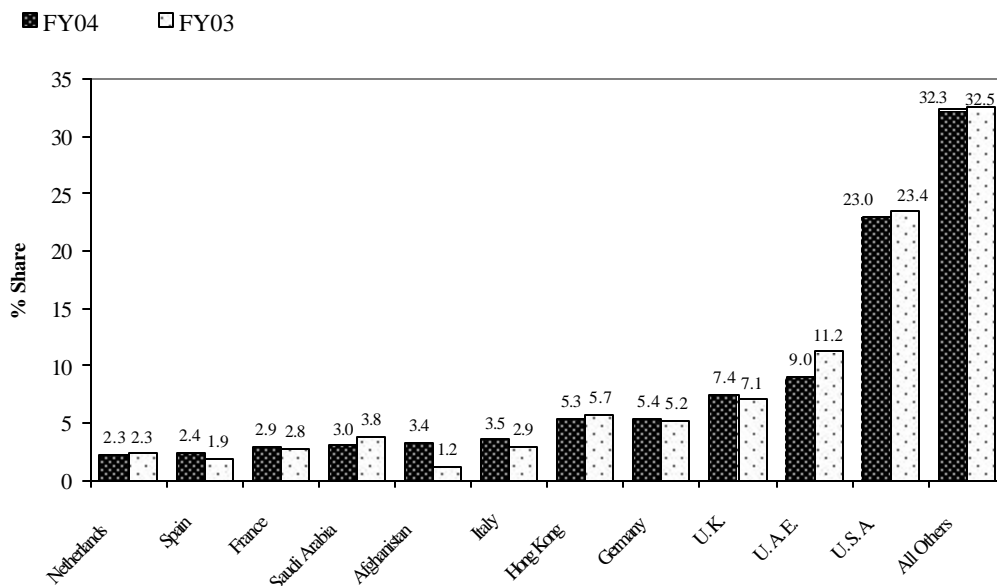


Figure 5: Year-wise Export Receipts.

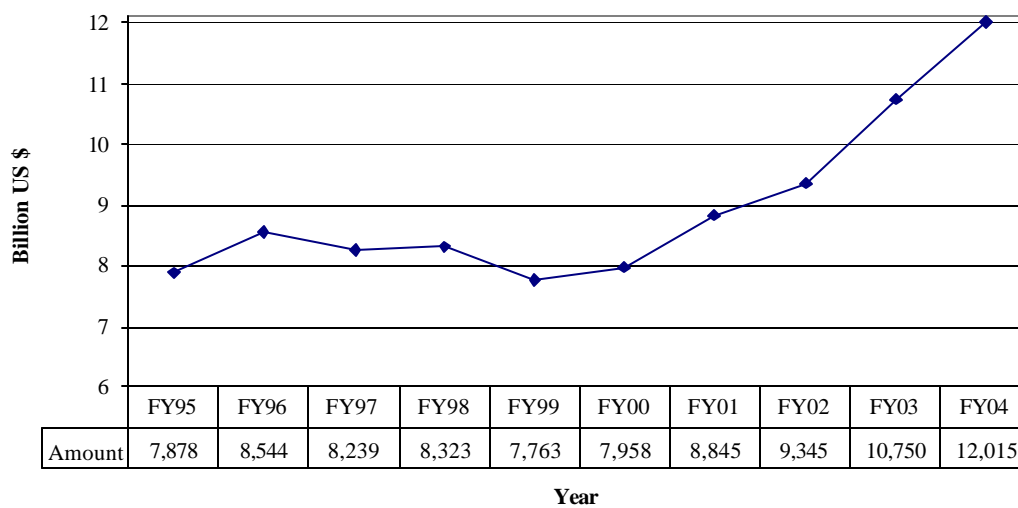
