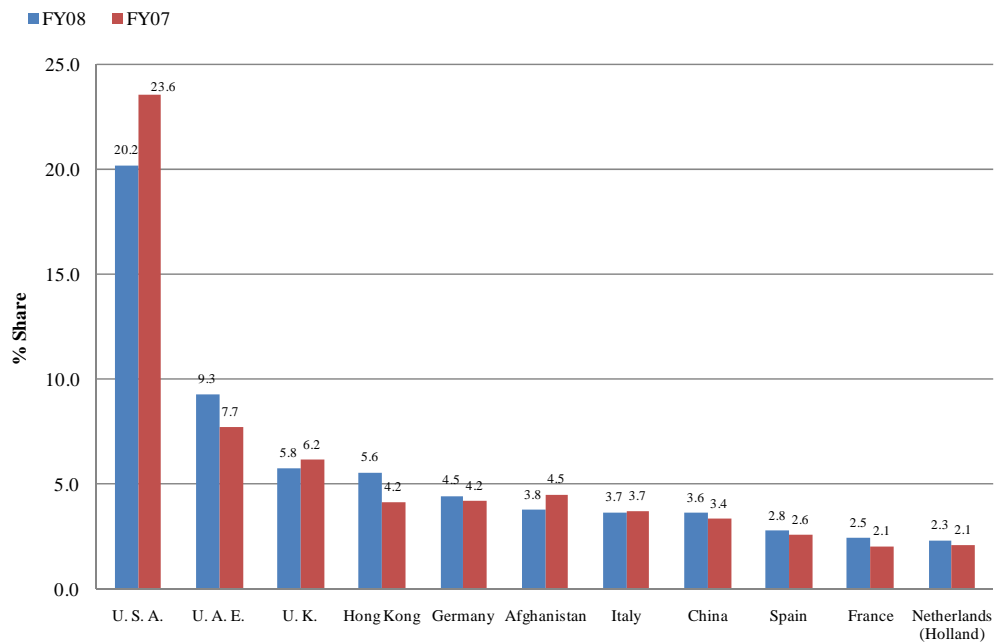

**Figure 5: Year-wise Exports**

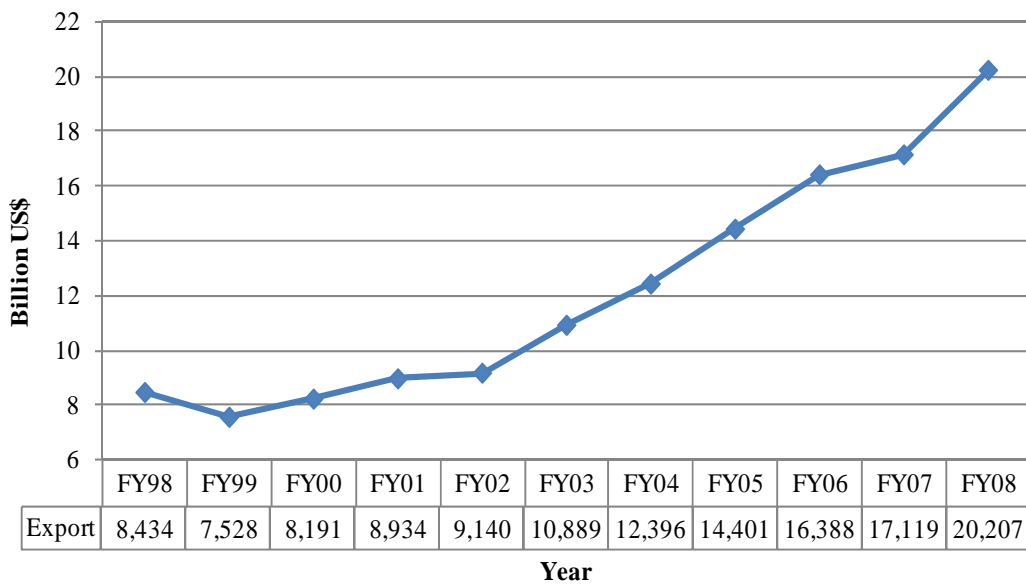
