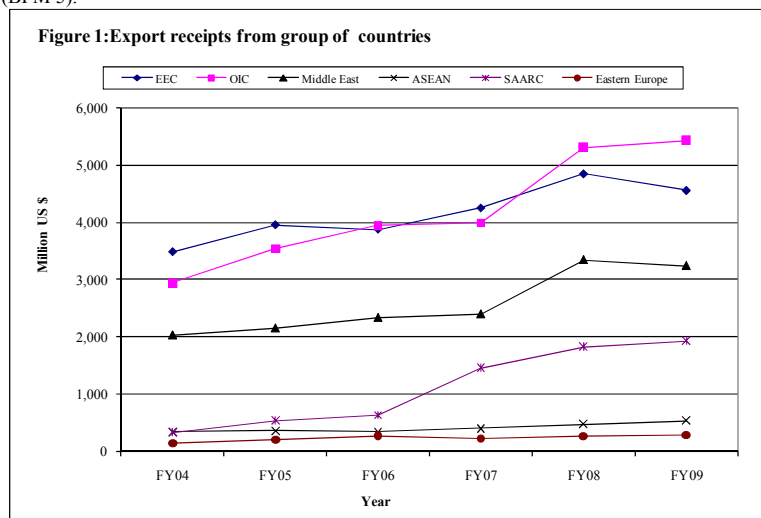

Figure 2: % Share of major commodities in export receipts

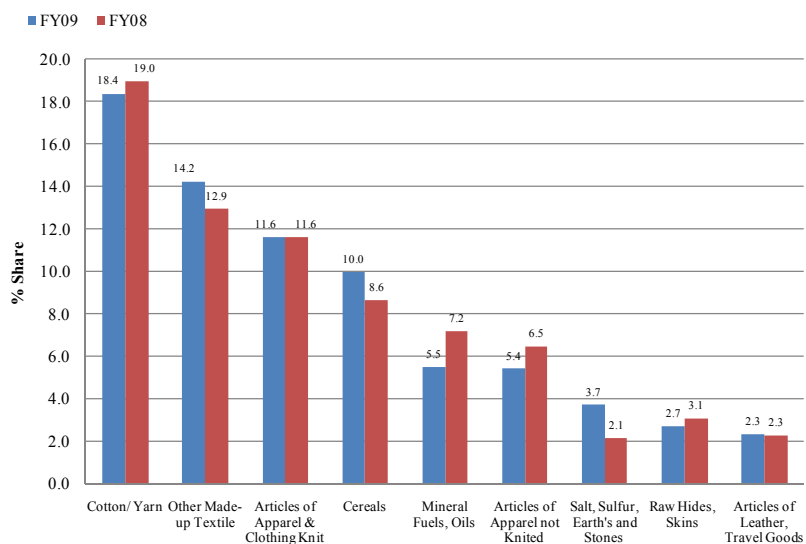

Figure 3: % Share of major countries in export receipts

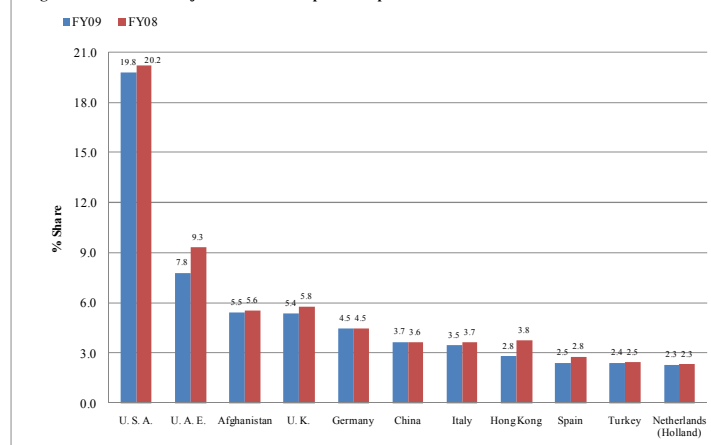

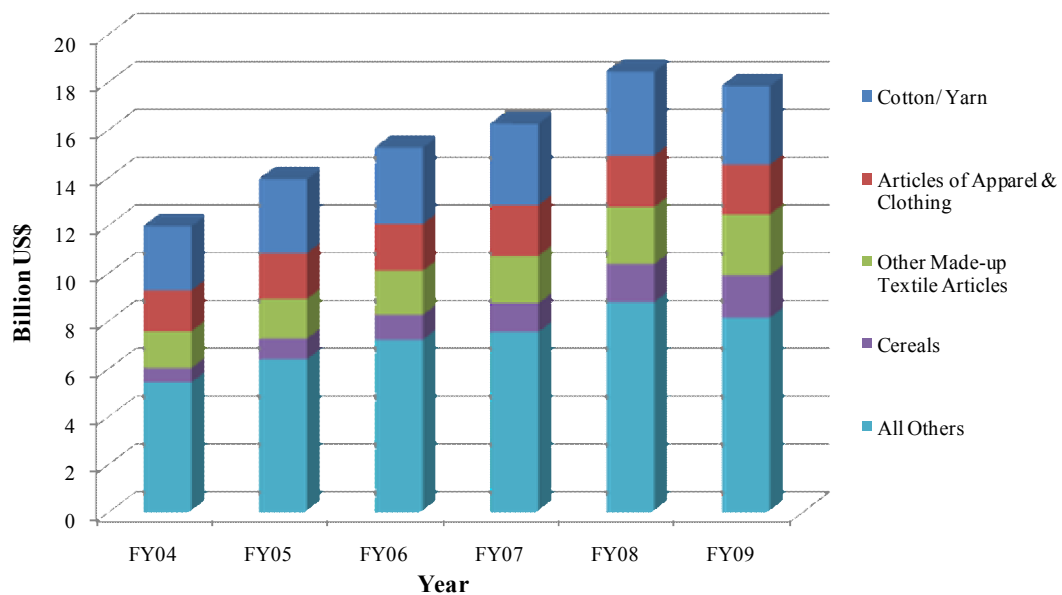
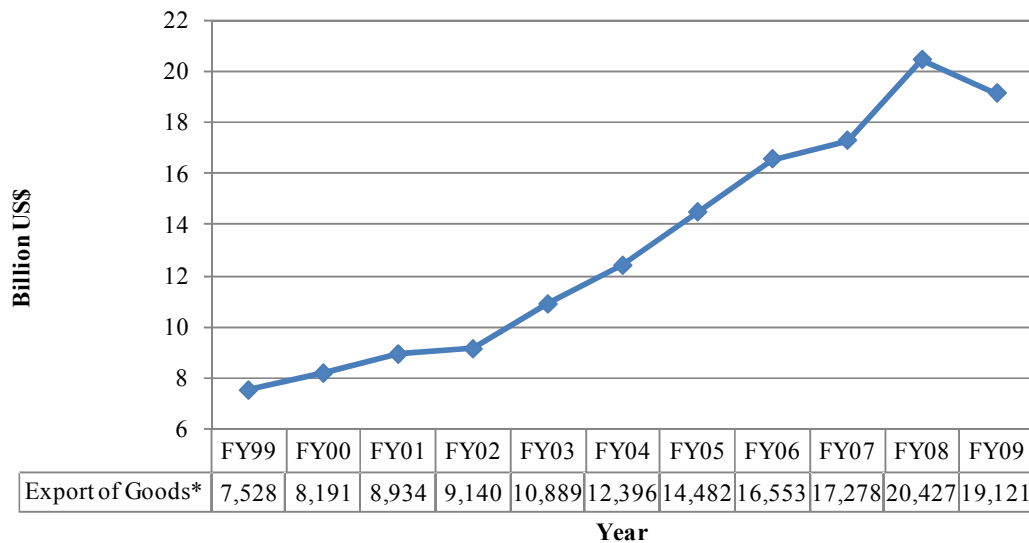
