Figure 1: Export receipts from group of countries

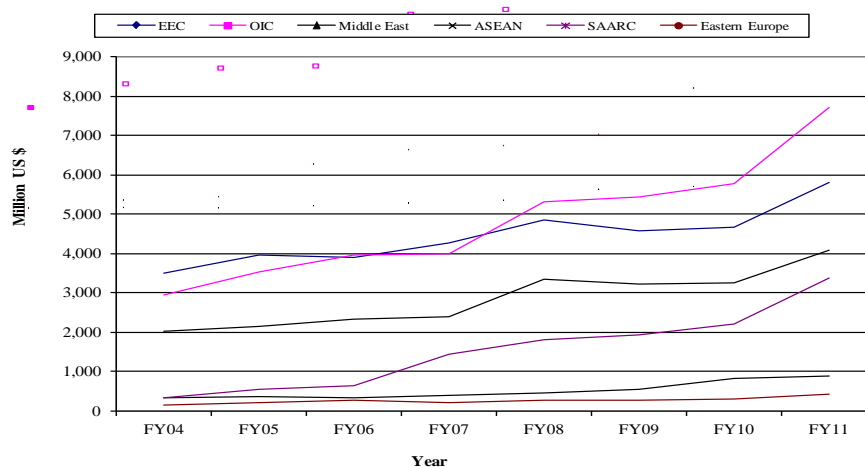

Figure 2: % Share of major commodities in export receipts

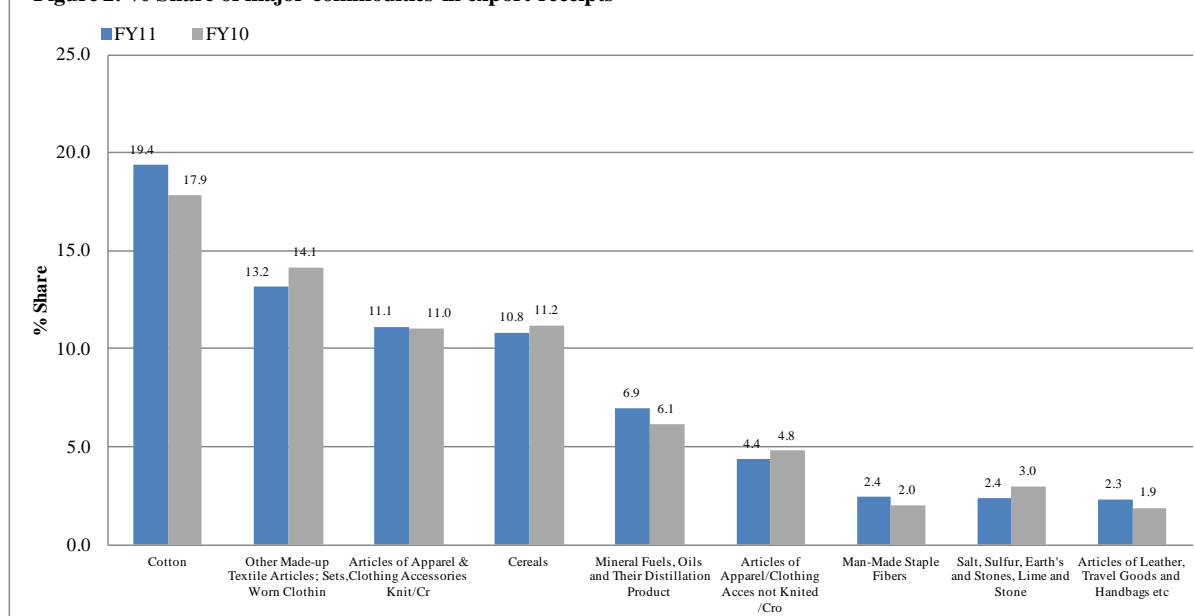
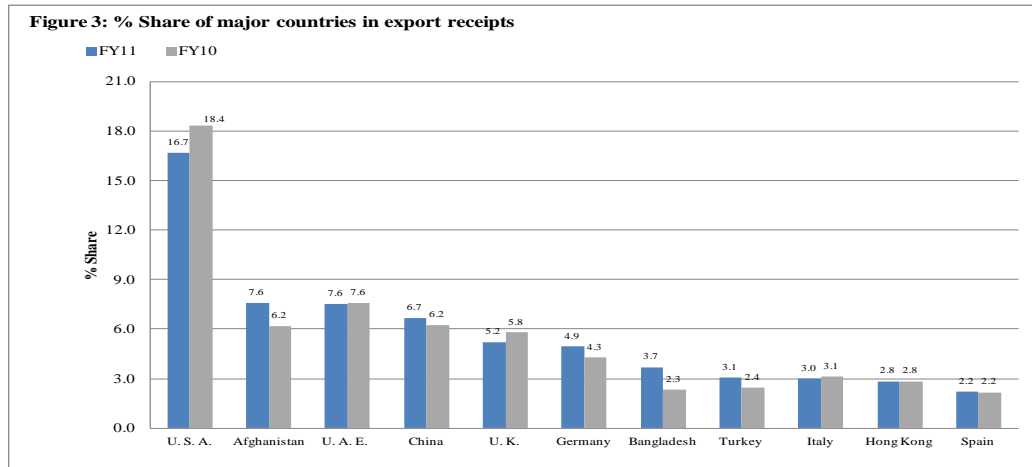
