Figure 1: Export Receipts of Goods from Group of Countries

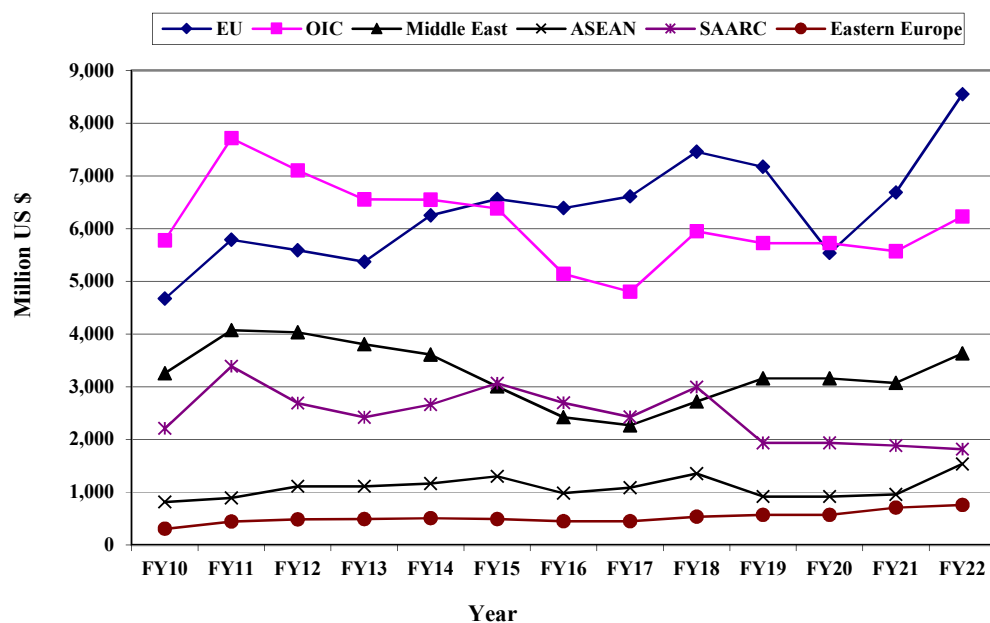

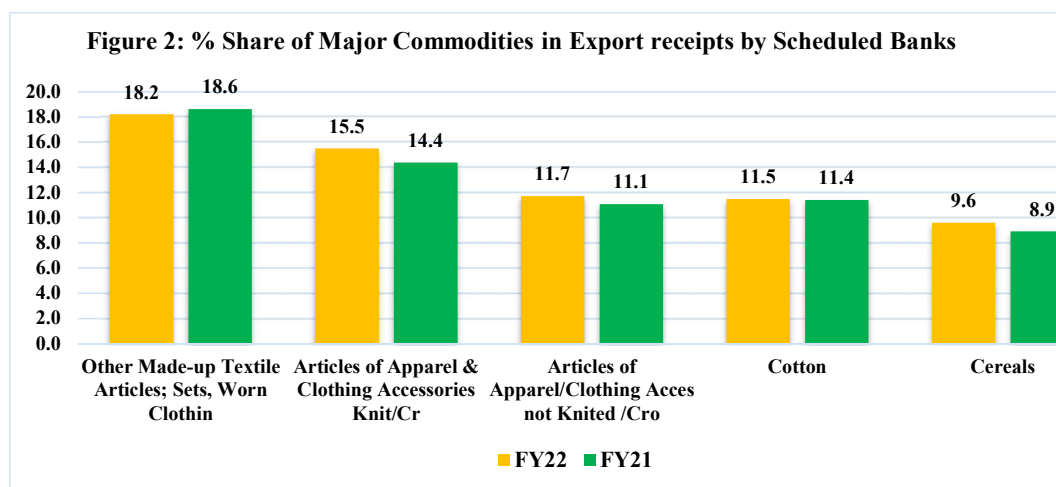

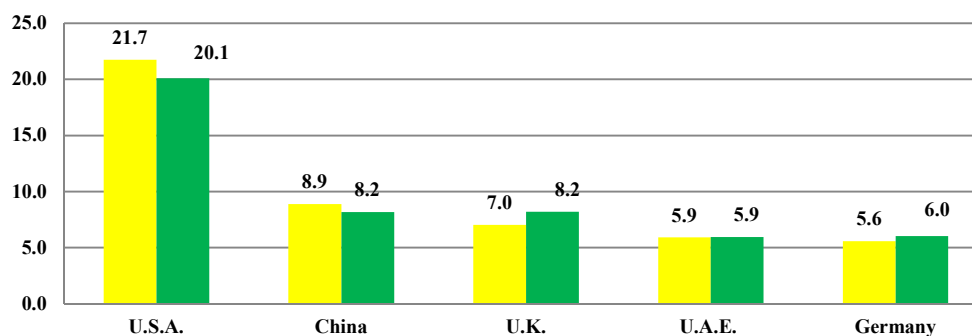
Figure 3: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts by Scheduled Banks ■ FY22 ■ FY21

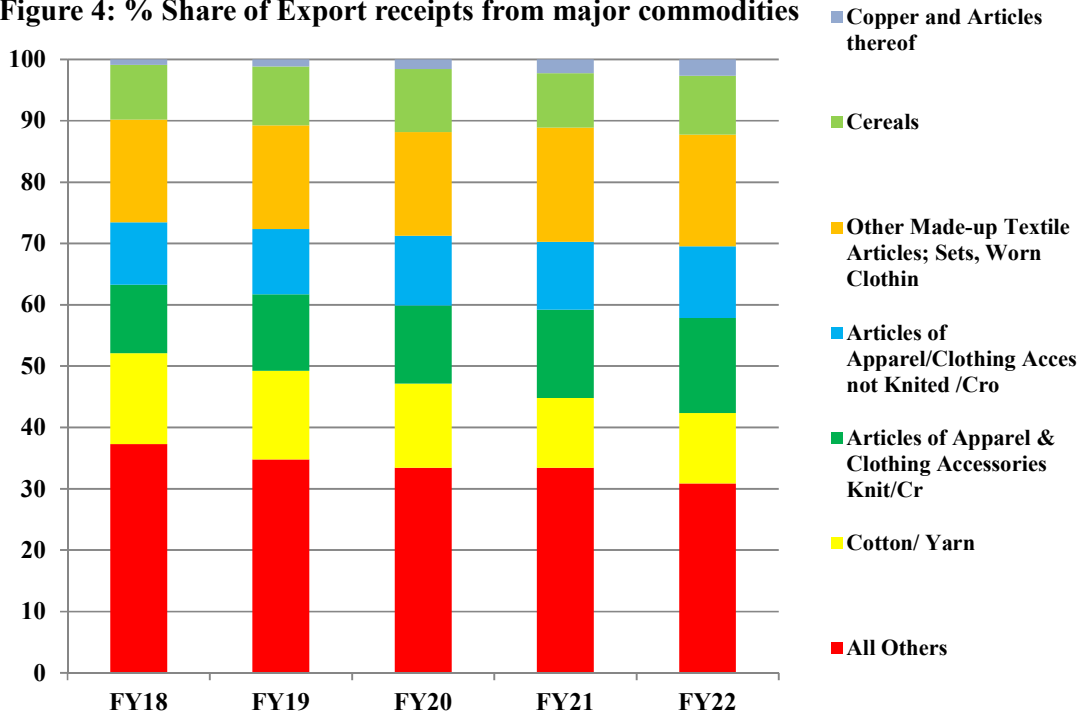

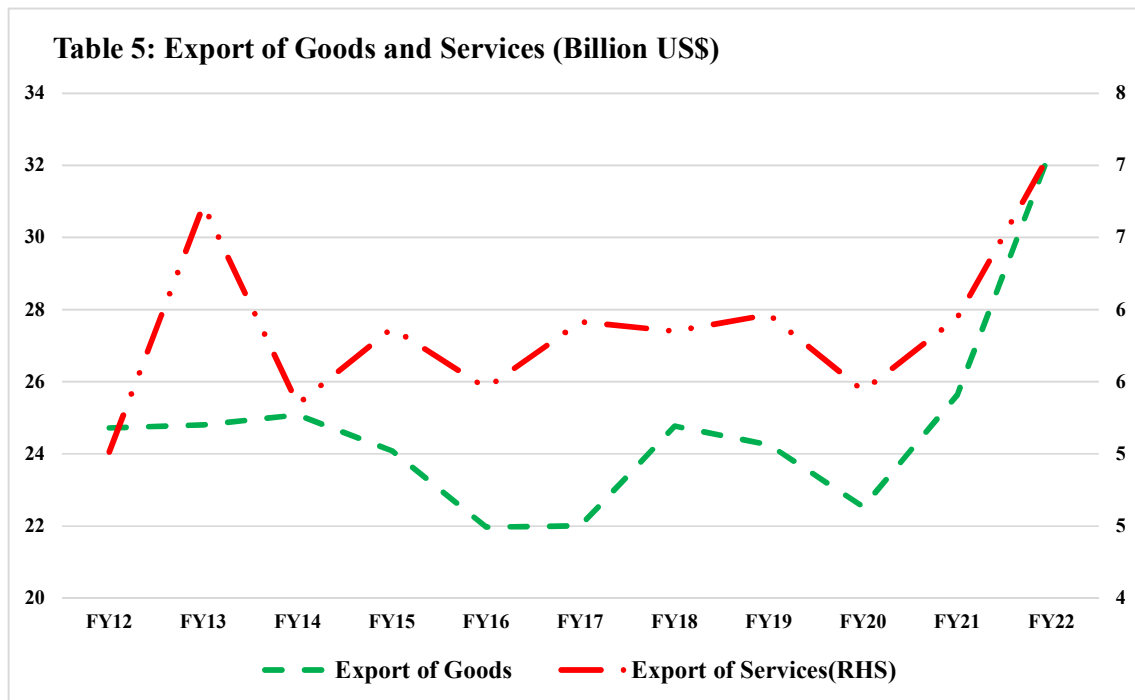
