ORDER

S.R.O. (I)/2006. - In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (I) of section 3 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950), the Federal Government is pleased to direct that the following further amendments shall be made in the Import Policy Order, 2005, namely: -


In the aforesaid order, -

- (a) in Appendix 'A', in Part-II, serial number 14, in column (1), and the entries relating thereto in columns (2) and (3) shall be omitted; and
- (b) in Appendix-B, in Part-I, after serial number 47 in column (1) and the entries relating thereto in columns (2), (3) and (4), the following new serial number and entries relating thereto shall be inserted, namely: -

"47A	3915.1000 3915.9000	Waste, parings and scrap of Poly Ethylene and Poly Propylene	Importable by industrial consumers for their own use only subject to the following conditions, namely: -
------	------------------------	--	--

- (i) certification from the exporting country that the scrap being exported does not include hazardous waste as defined in the Basel Convention on the Control of Transboundary Movements of Hazardous Wastes and their Disposal;
- (ii) certification from the Pakistan Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (PCSIR) or an accredited laboratory in Pakistan to the effect that the consignment is free from hazardous substances as defined under Basel Convention; and
- (iii) it shall not be used in the production of bags for packing of foodstuff".
