**MR. MANSUR-UR-REHMAN KHAN APPOINTED AS  
DEPUTY GOVERNOR, STATE BANK OF PAKISTAN**

The Federal Government has appointed Mr. Mansur-ur-Rehman Khan as Deputy Governor, State Bank of Pakistan with immediate effect for a period of three years or till his superannuation, whichever is earlier, says a notification issued by the Finance Division, Islamabad today. Prior to his elevation as Deputy Governor, Mr. Mansur-ur-Rehman was Executive Director, State Bank of Pakistan.



Mr. Mansur brings to his new assignment 36 years of central banking experience. He joined the State Bank in July, 1968. He served the State Bank in several responsible capacities in almost all the departments of the Bank. As Director, he served the Banking Supervision, Banking Policy and World Bank Consultancy Project before being promoted as Executive Director, State Bank of Pakistan in May, 1997.

Mr. Mansur-ur-Rehman Khan attended a number of courses which included 'Management of the Training Function and Training Techniques', 'Management Information System' and '60<sup>th</sup> Advanced Course in Administration and Development' at NIPA, Lahore.

He is a Member of the Technical Committee of Islamic Financial Services Board. He is also serving as Deputy Chairman of Risk Management Working Group of Islamic Financial Services Board.
