PAKISTAN RECEIVES \$ 313.14 MILLION AS WORKERS' REMITTANCES DURING JULY, 2005

Pakistan received an amount of \$ 313.14 million as Workers' Remittances during the first month (July, 2005) of the current fiscal year. This amount includes \$ 3.13 million received through encashment and profit earned on Foreign Exchange Bearer Certificates (FEBCs) and Foreign Currency Bearer Certificates (FCBCs).

The inflow of remittances into Pakistan during July, 2005 from USA, Saudi Arabia, UAE, GCC countries (including Bahrain, Kuwait, Qatar and Oman) and UK amounted to \$ 91.30 million, \$56.63 million, \$ 43.31 million, \$40.56 million and \$ 33.72 million respectively. Remittances received from Norway, Switzerland, Australia, Canada, Japan, EU and other countries during the last month (July, 2005) amounted to \$ 44.49 million.
