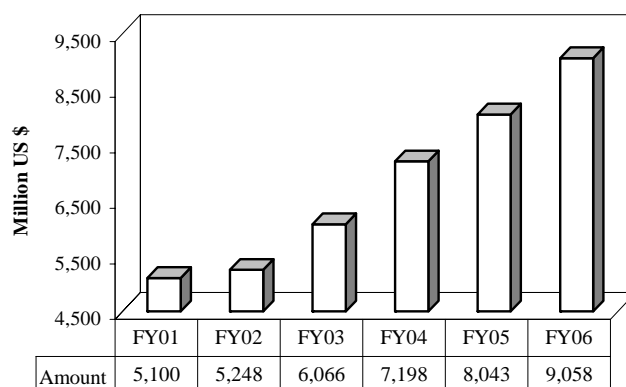

Figure 1: Export for the Periods July-January



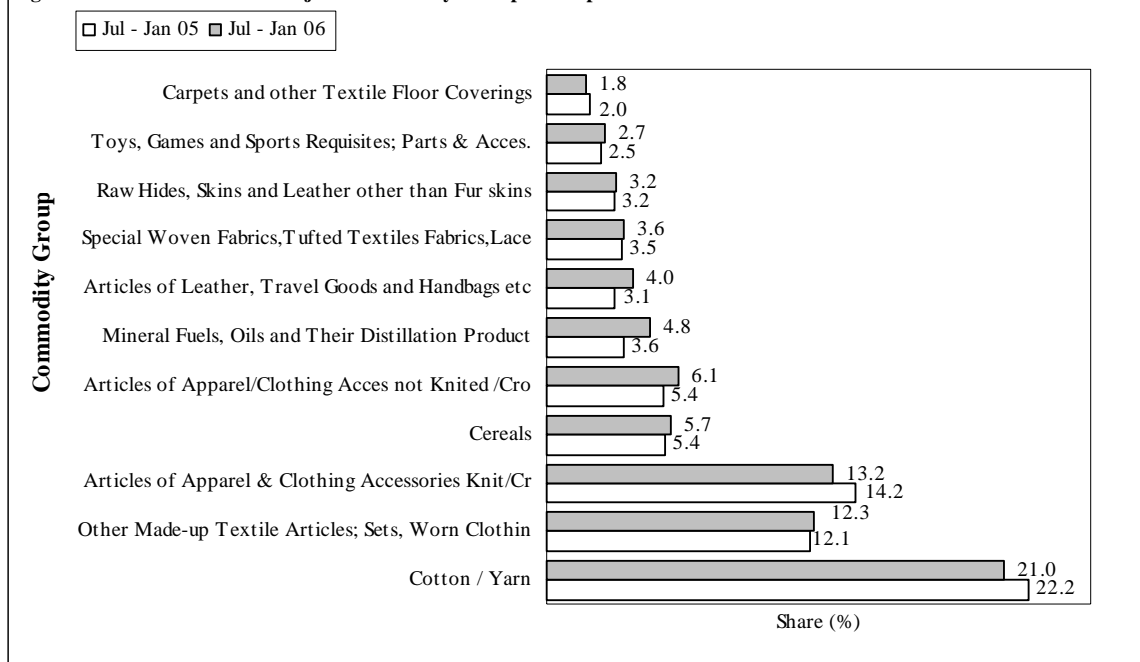

**Figure 2: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Export**

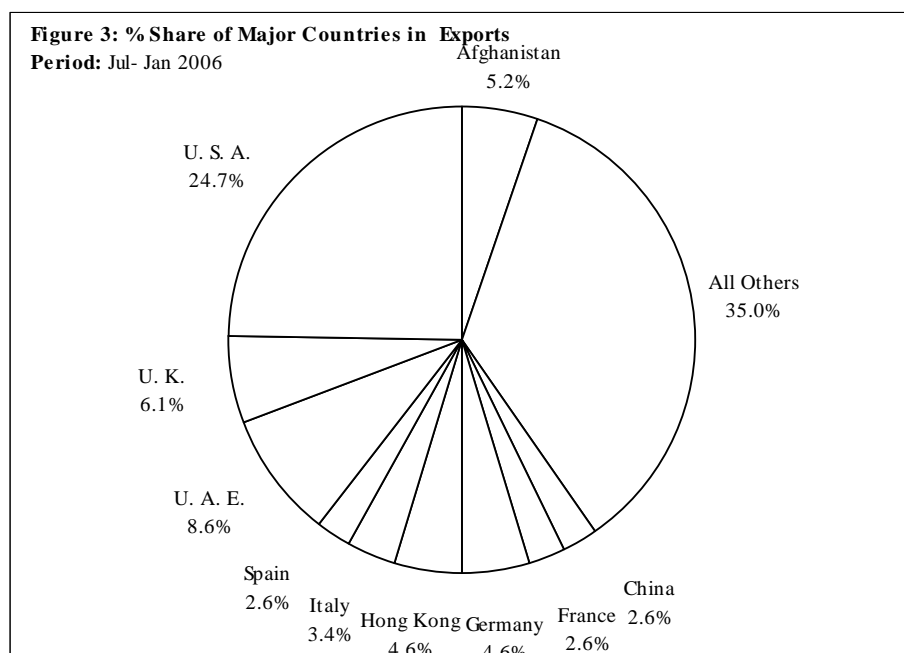

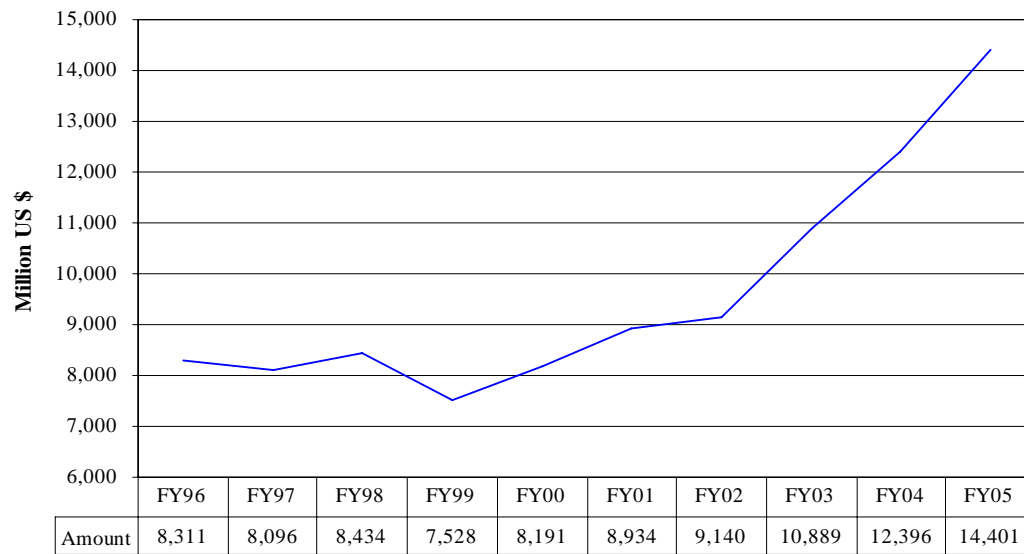
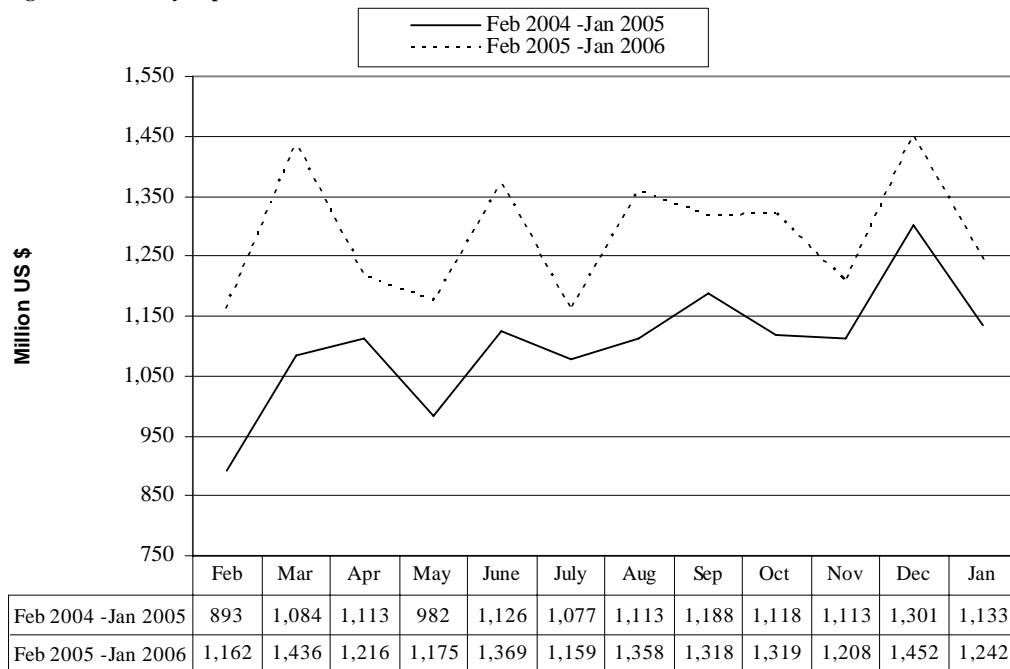
**Figure 4: Exports from FY96 to FY05****Figure 5: Monthly Exports for Feb 04 - Jan 05 & Feb 05 - Jan 06**
