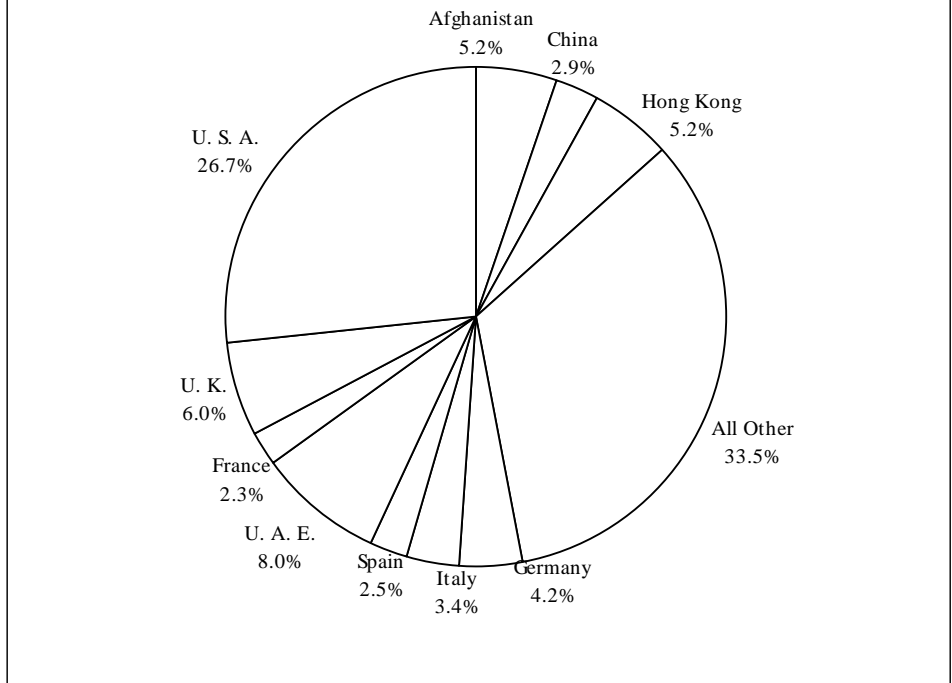

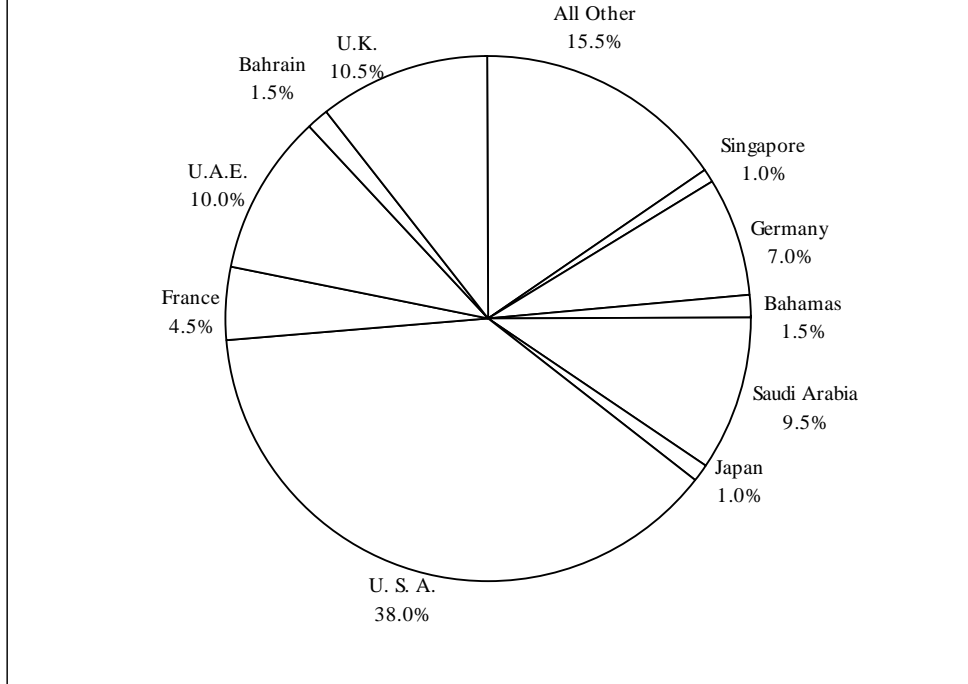

**Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Goods During July 2006**

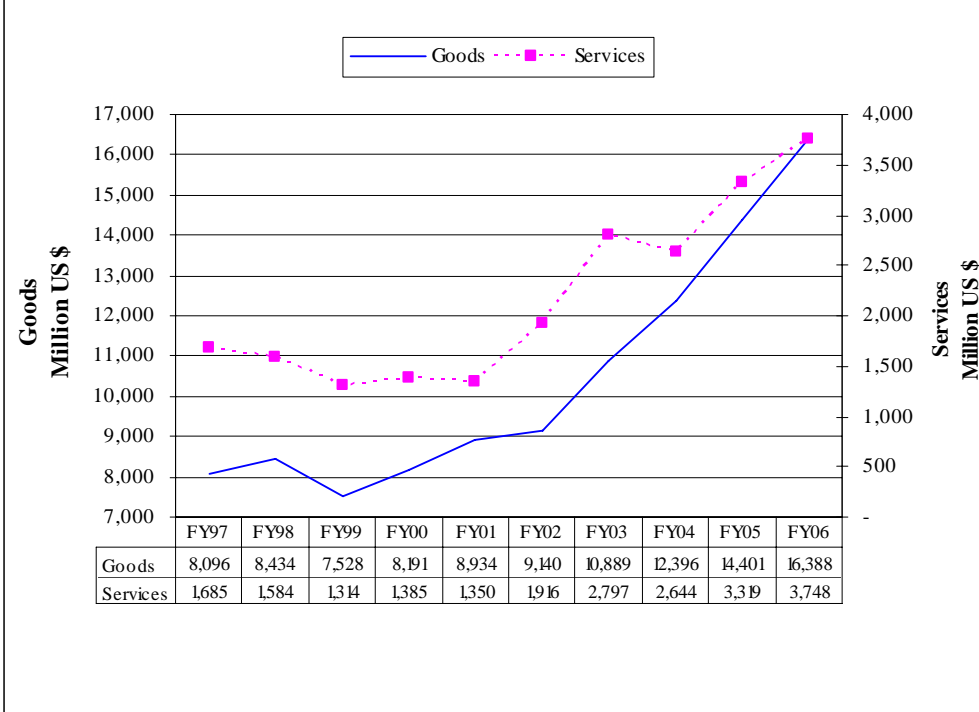

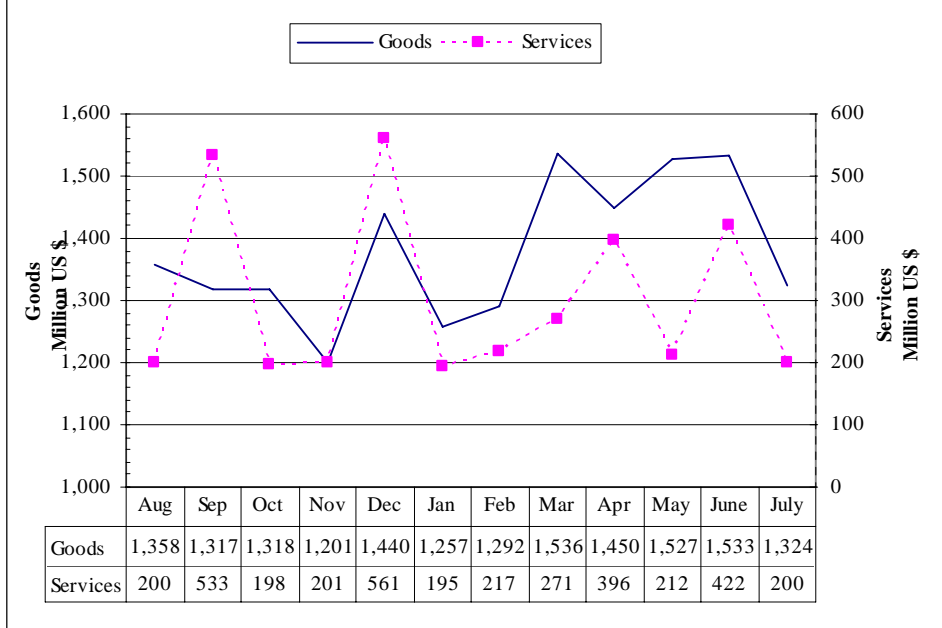
**Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services During July 2006**
