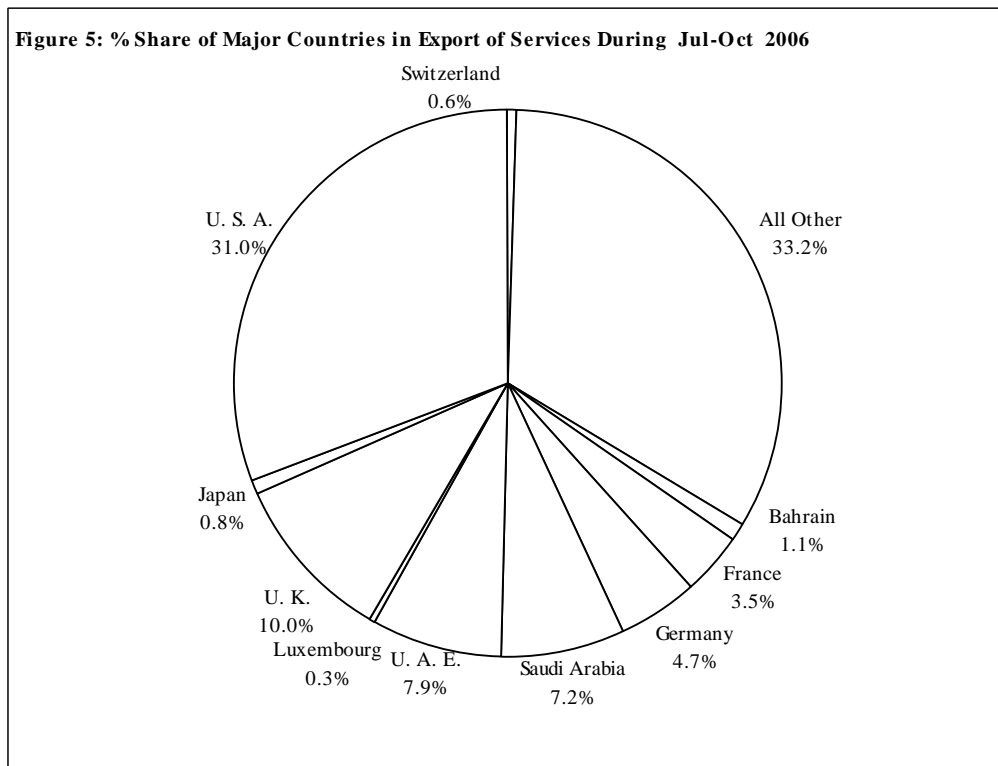


Figure 6: Annual Export of Goods & Services from FY97 to FY06

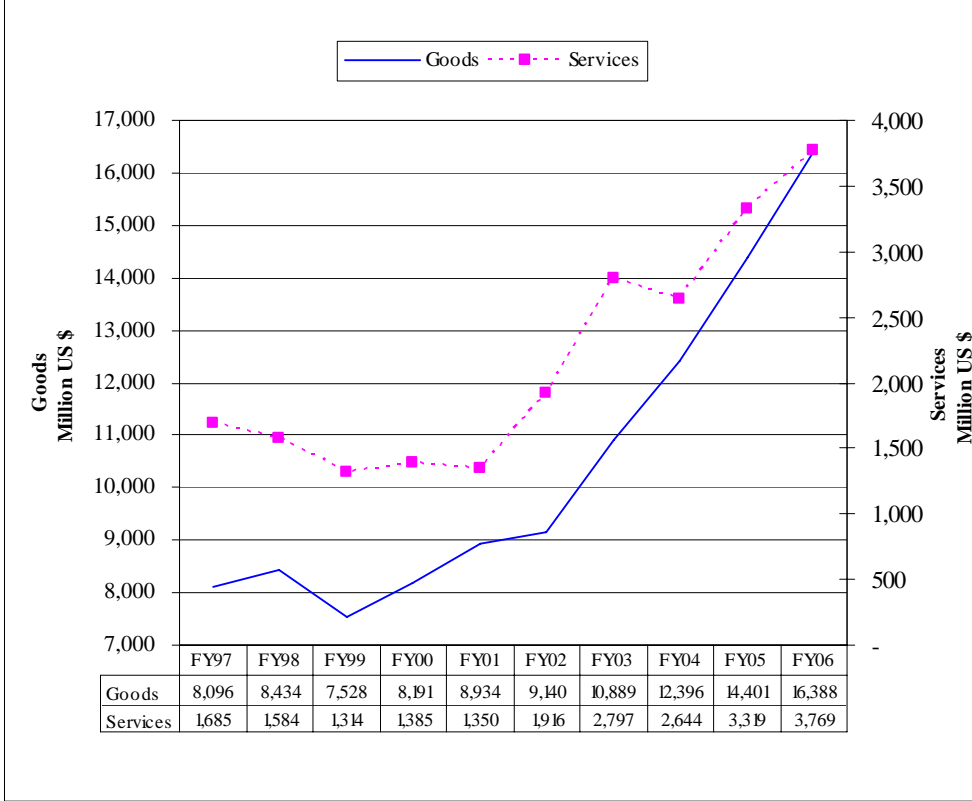


Figure 7: Monthly Export of Goods & Services

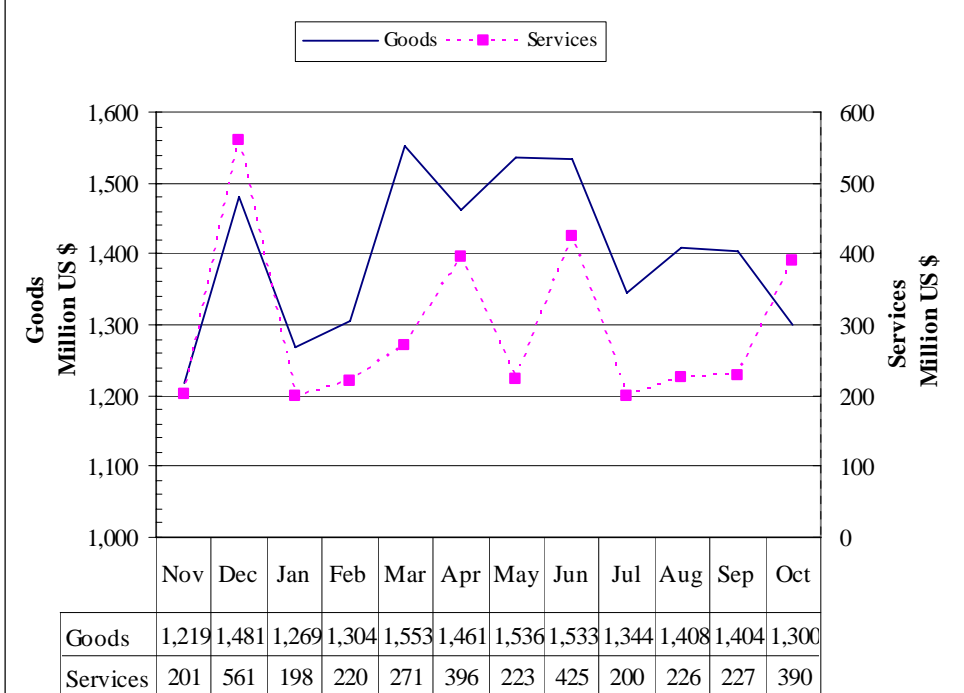
