Figure 1. Export During July-January

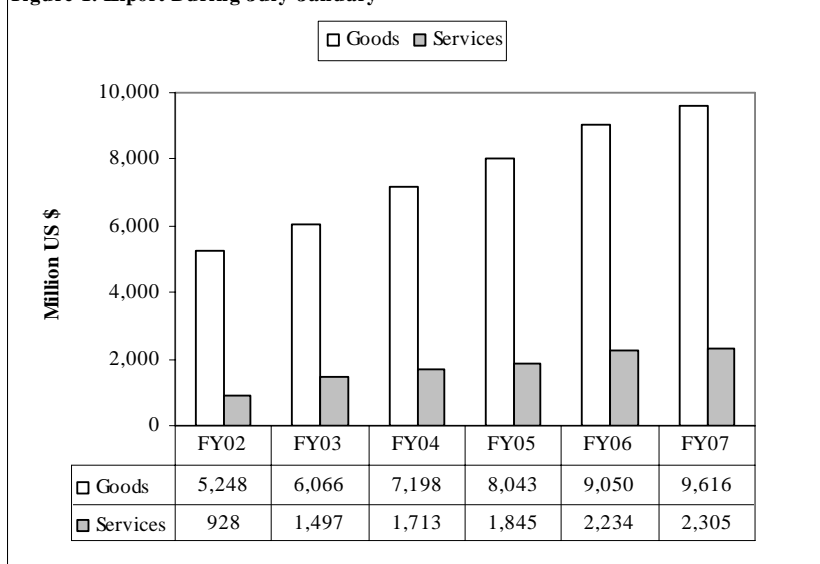
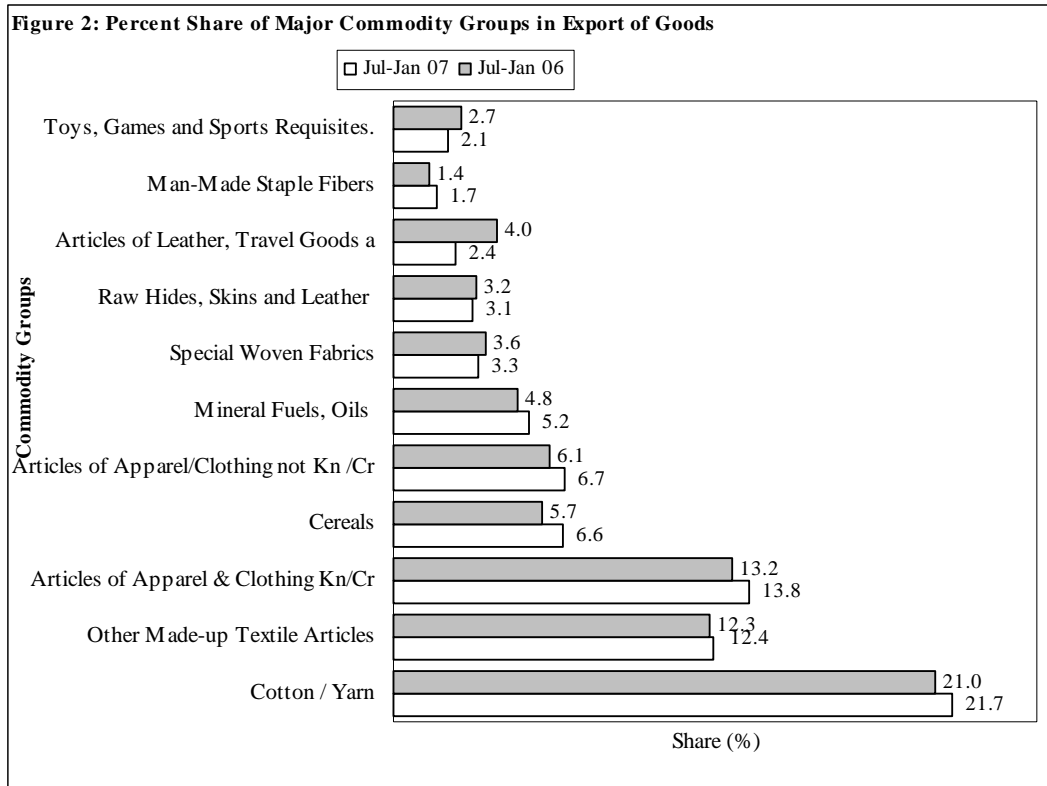
