Figure 1. Export During Jul-Apr 09

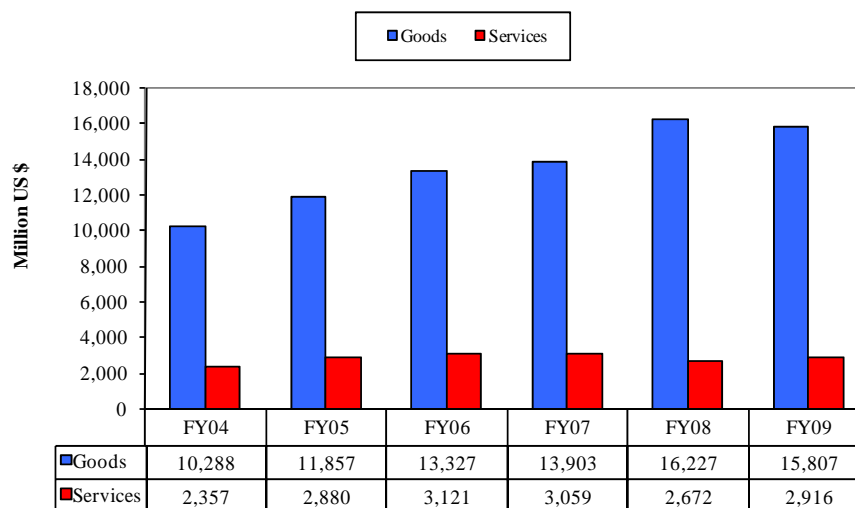
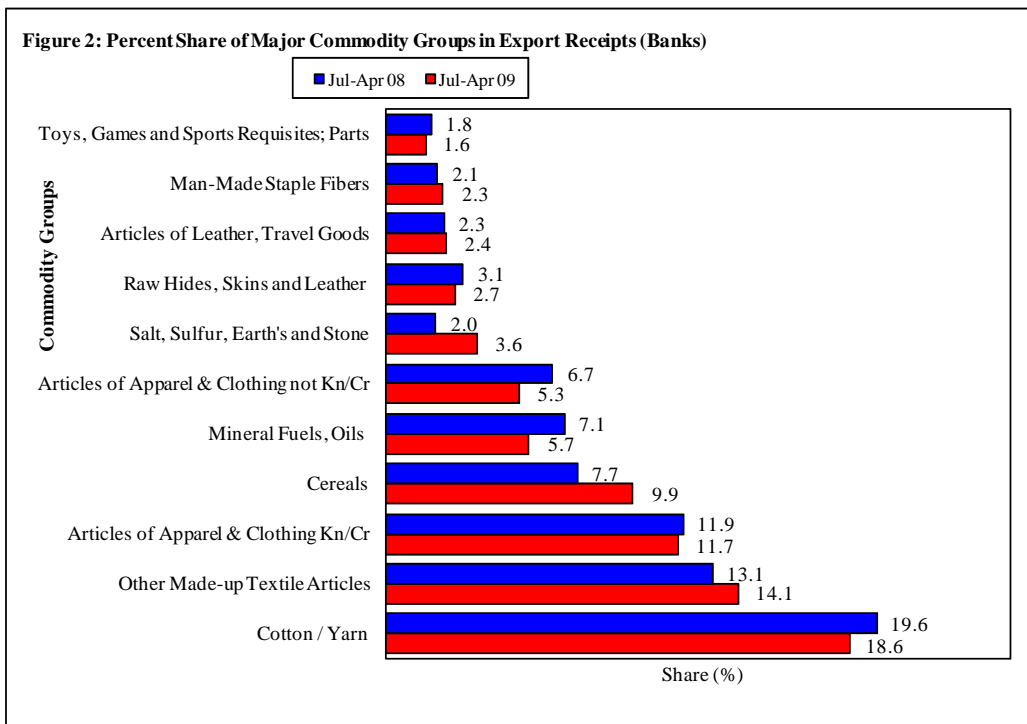

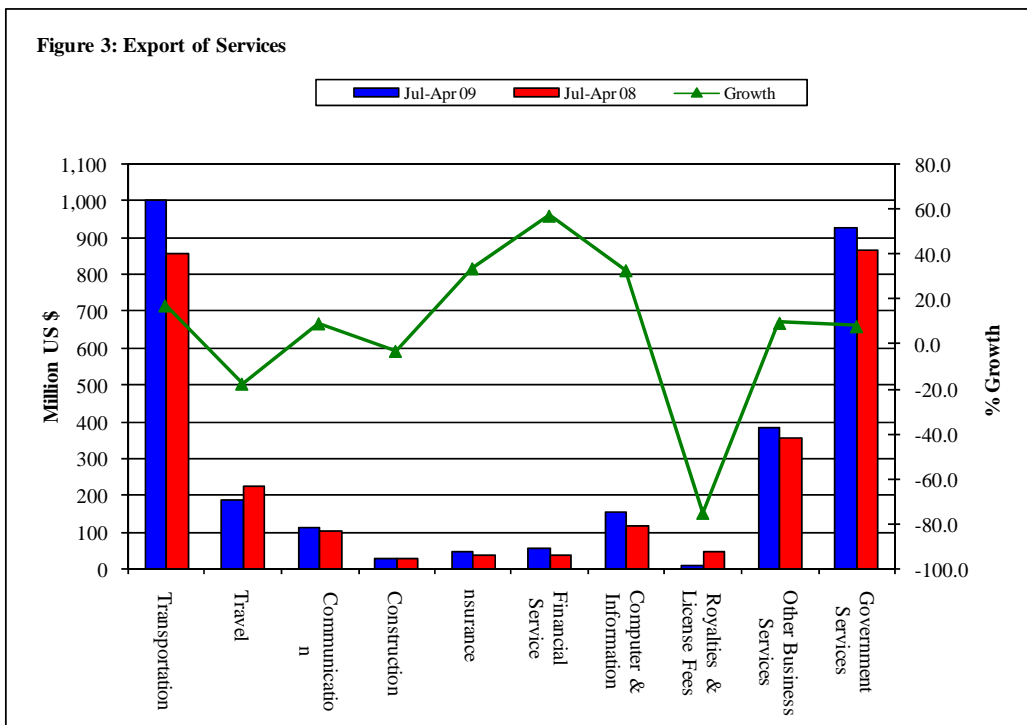

Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) During Jul-Apr 2009

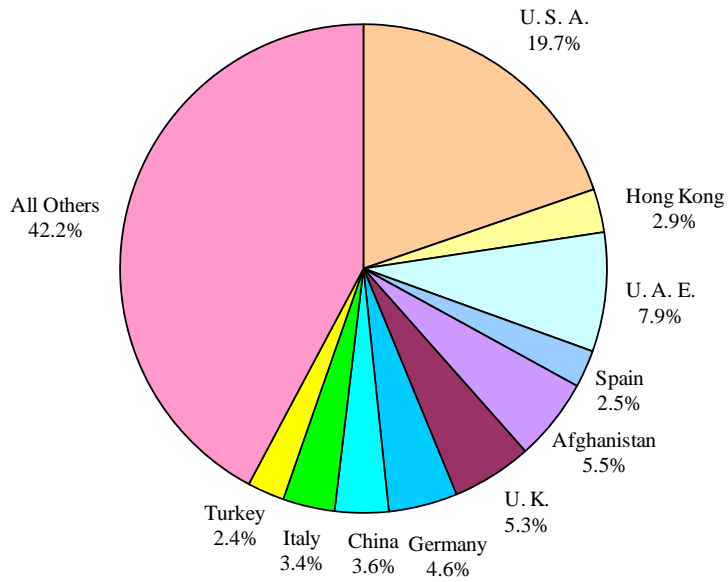
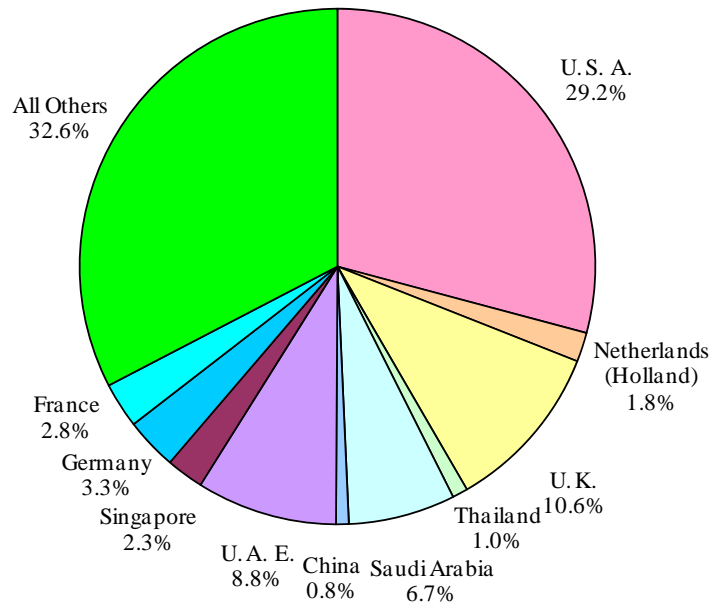
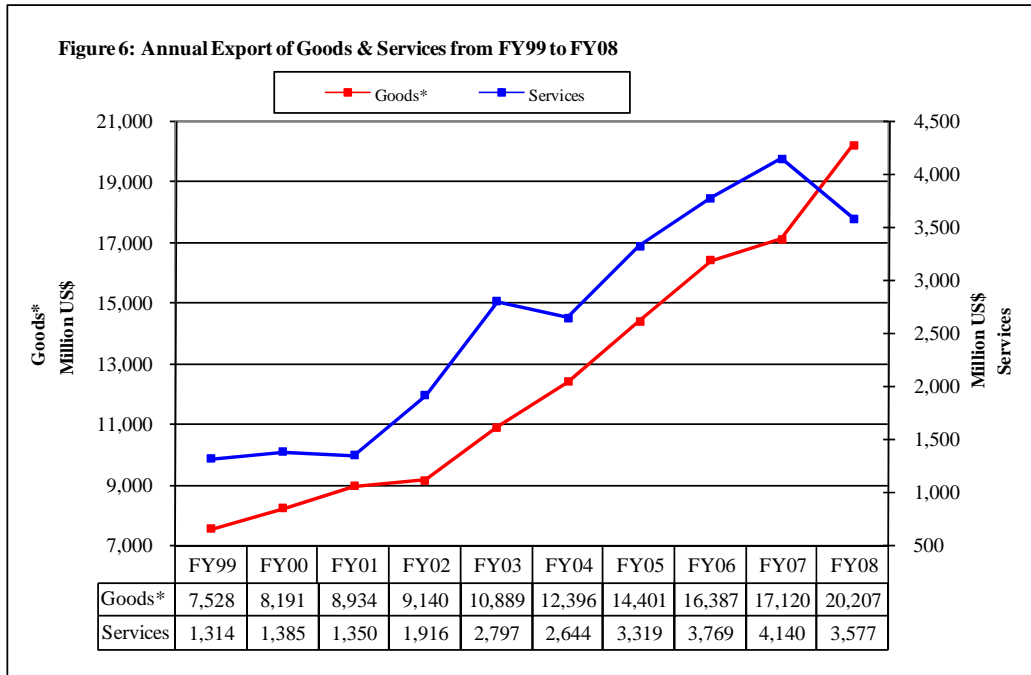


Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services During Jul-Apr 2009

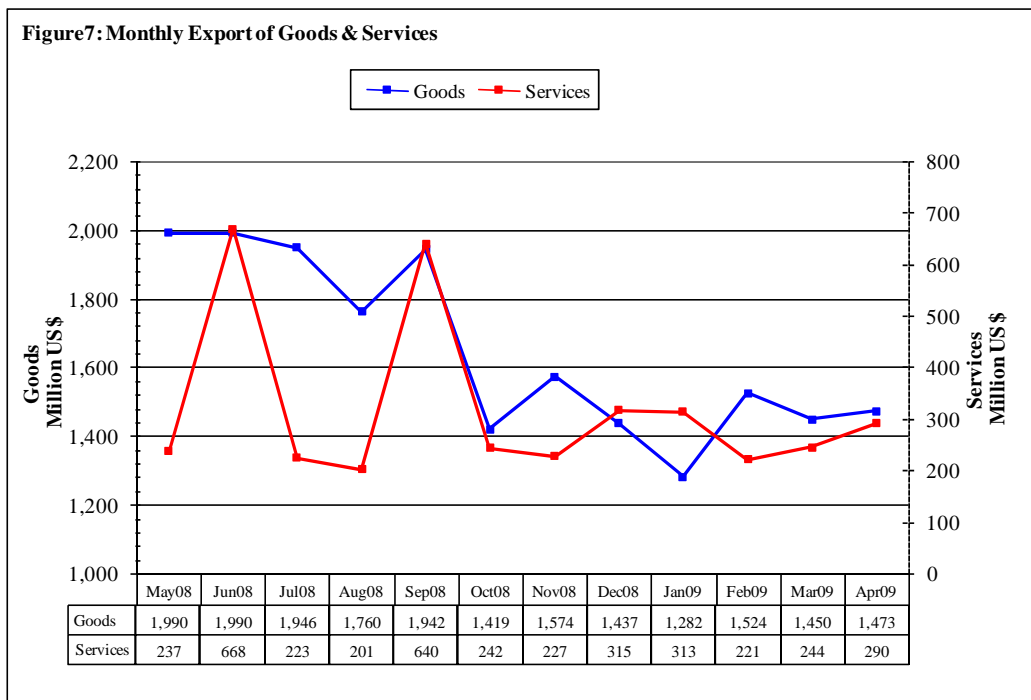
