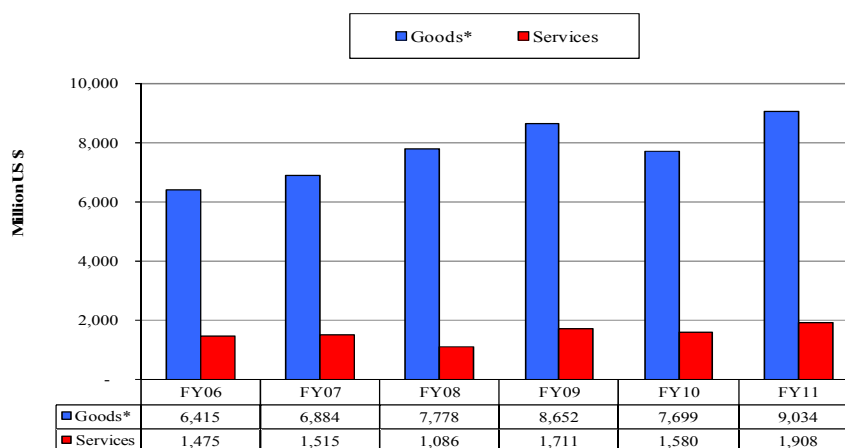

Figure 1. Export During Jul-Nov

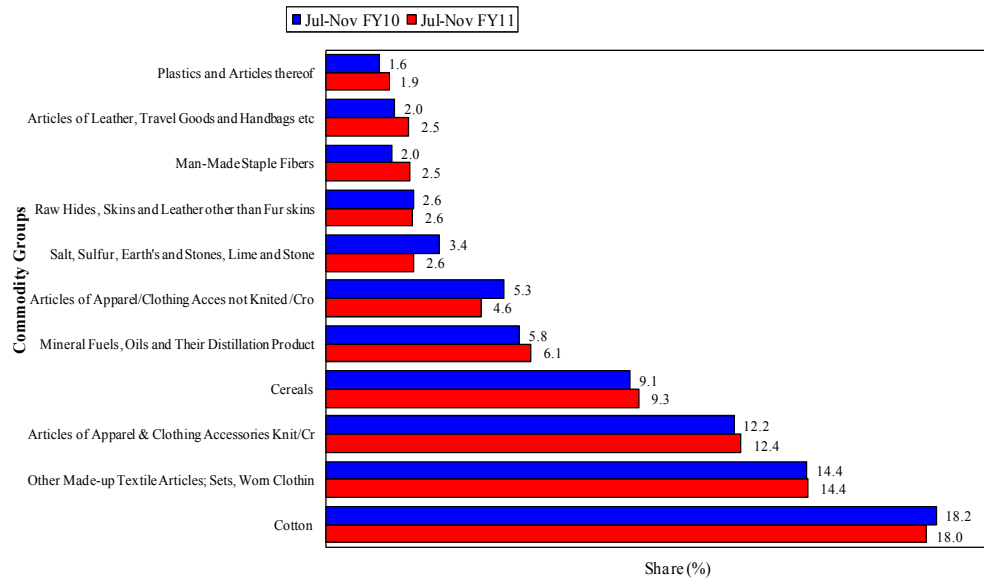

Note: - The share is based on the share of commodities in Export Receipts through Banks

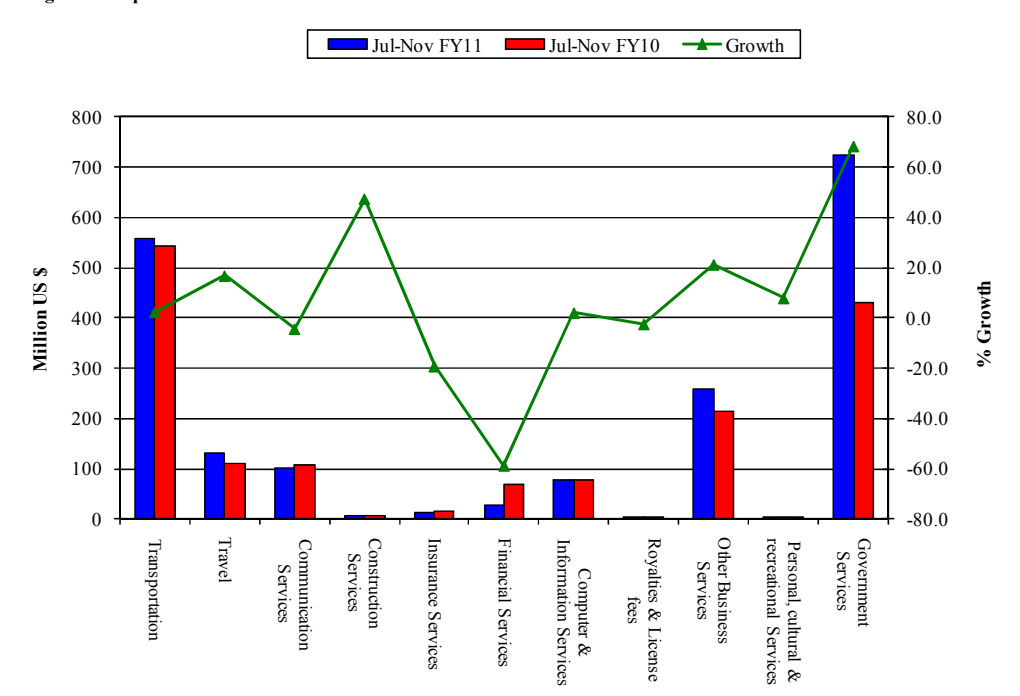
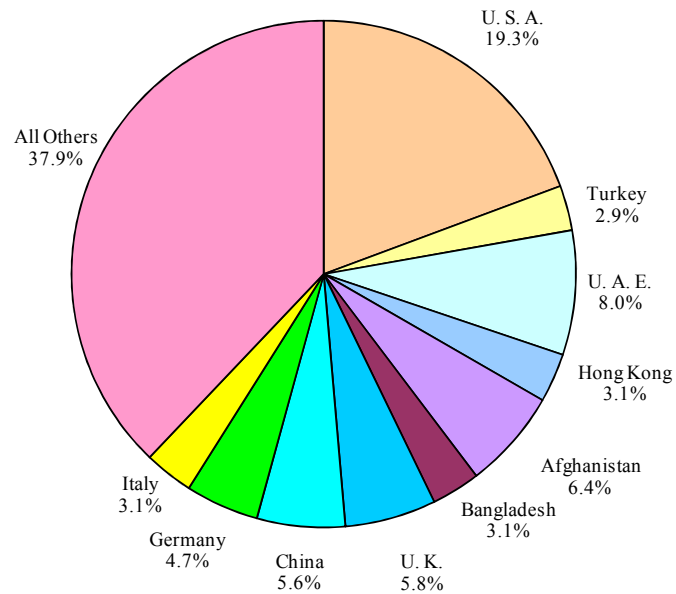
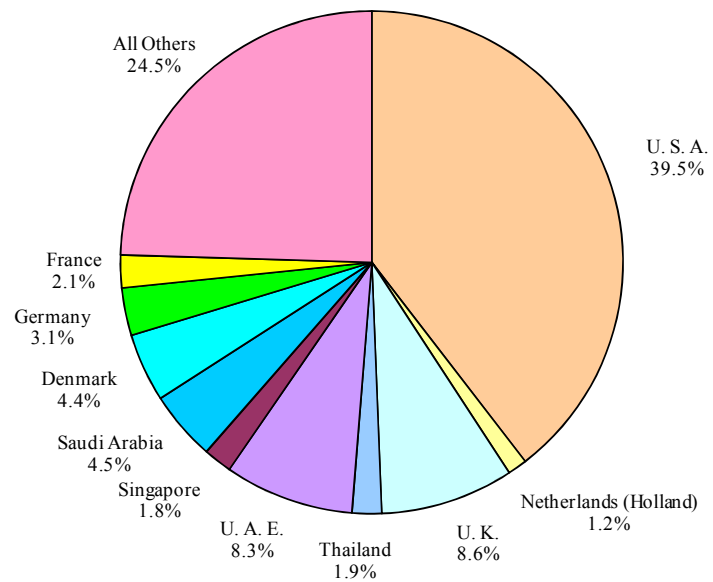
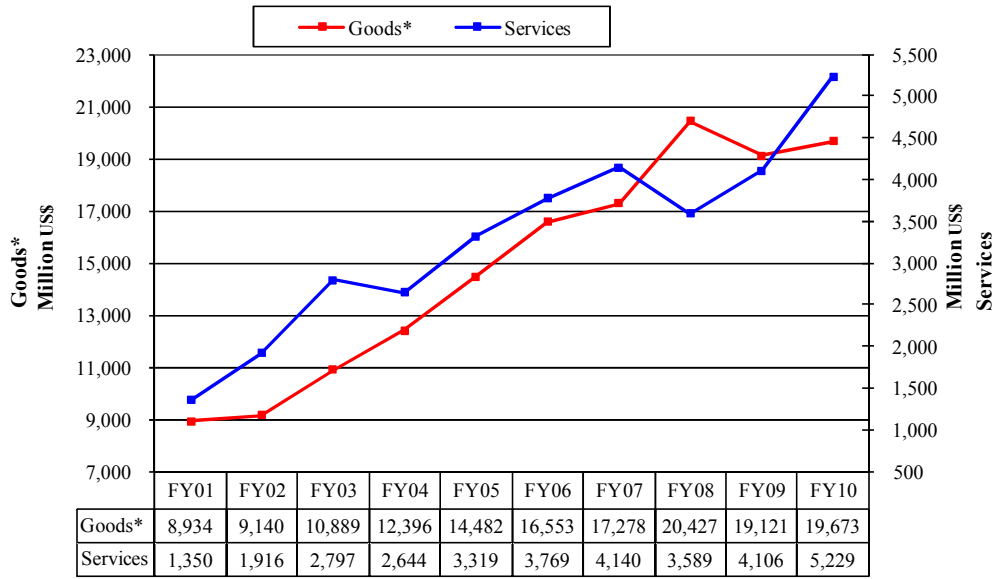
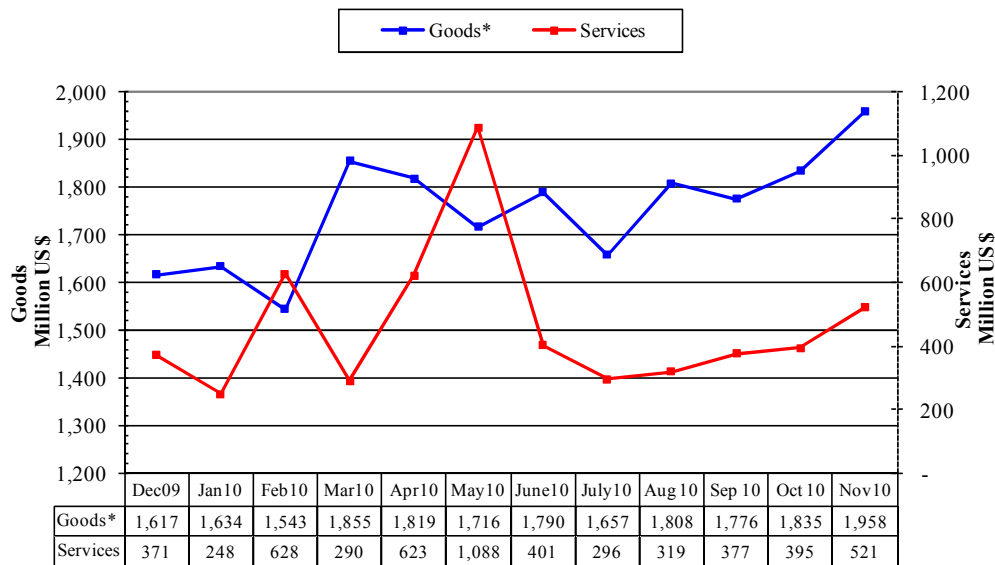
**Figure 3: Export of Services**
