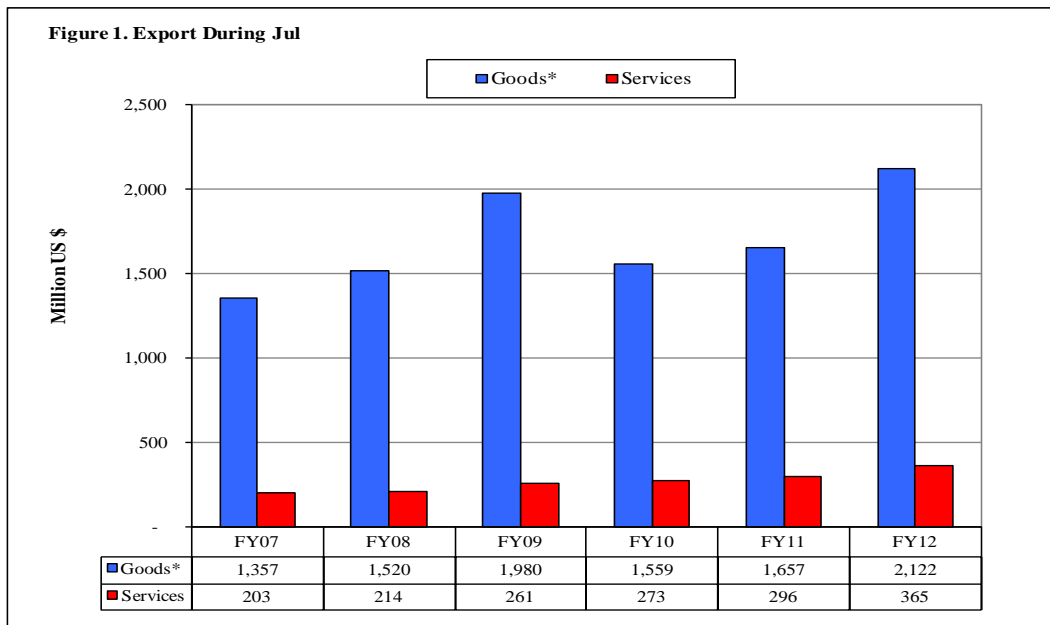

Figure 2: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Export Receipts (Banks)

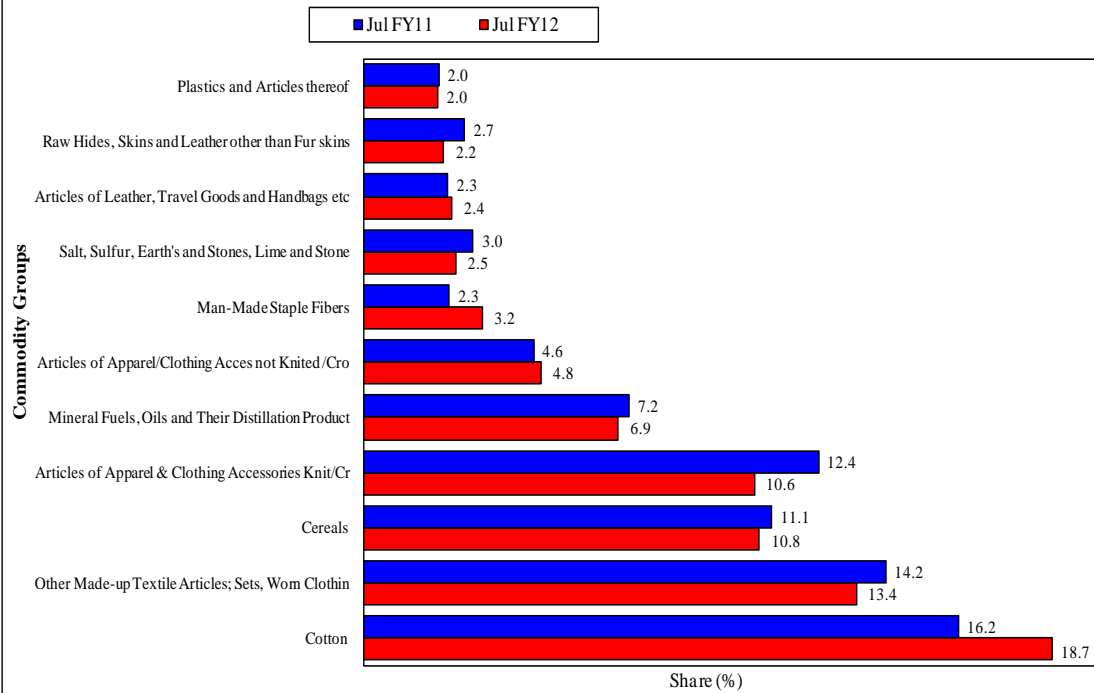


Figure 3: Export of Services

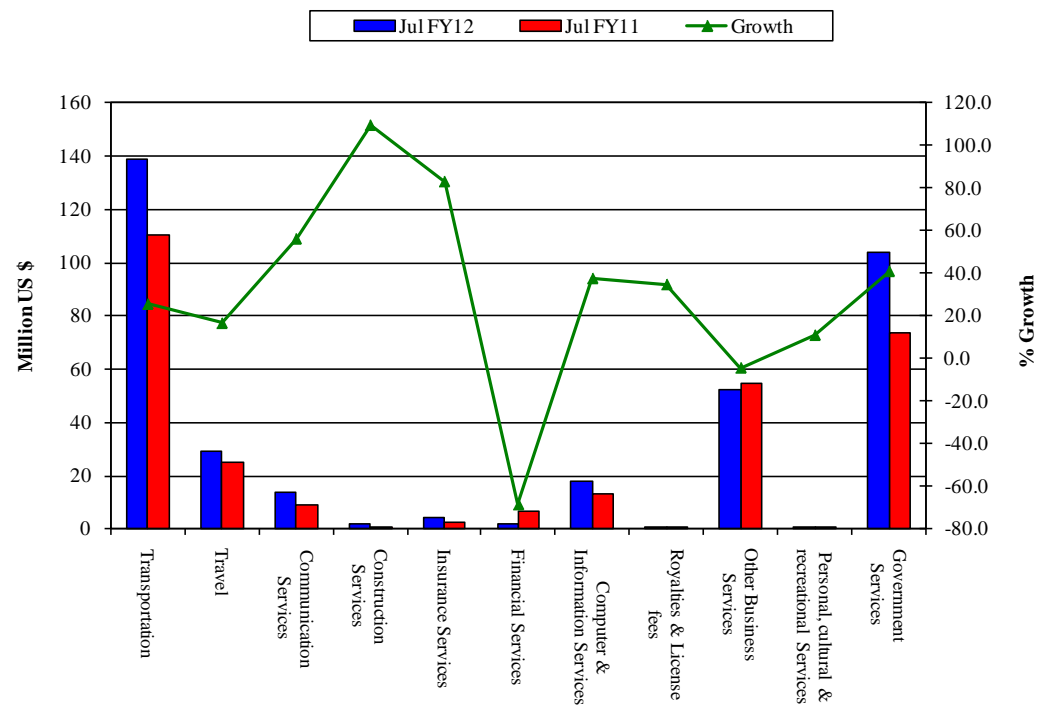

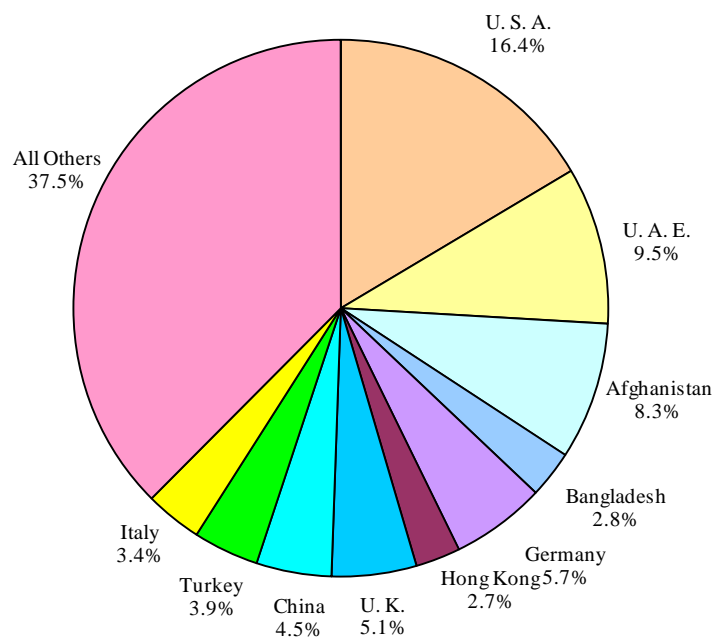
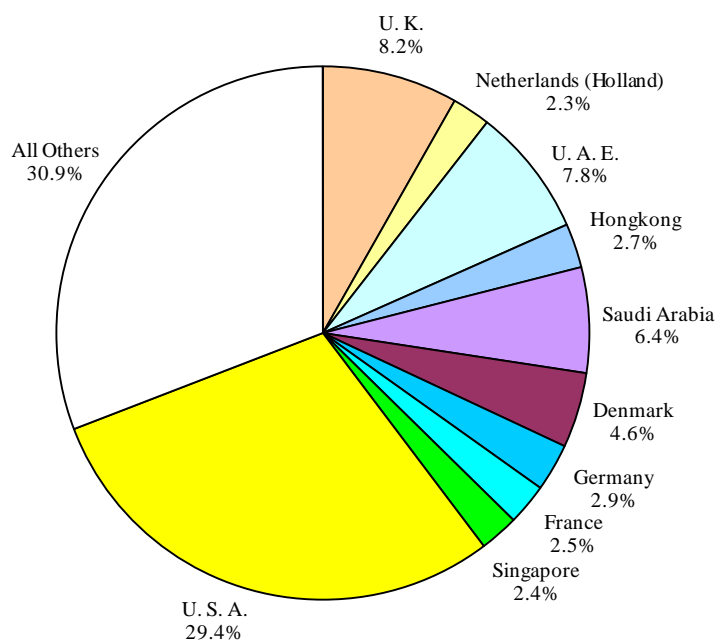
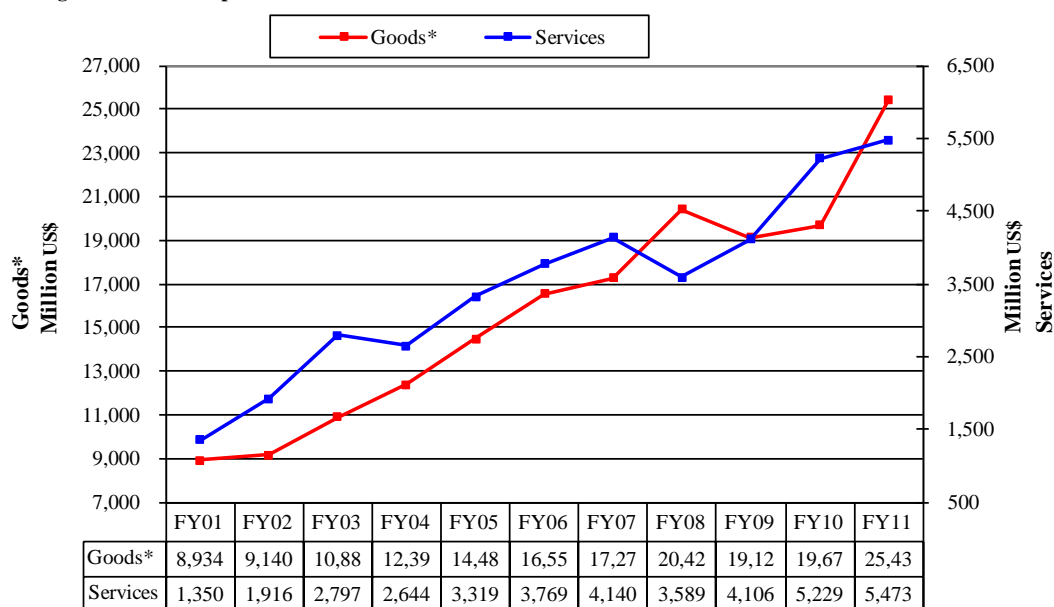
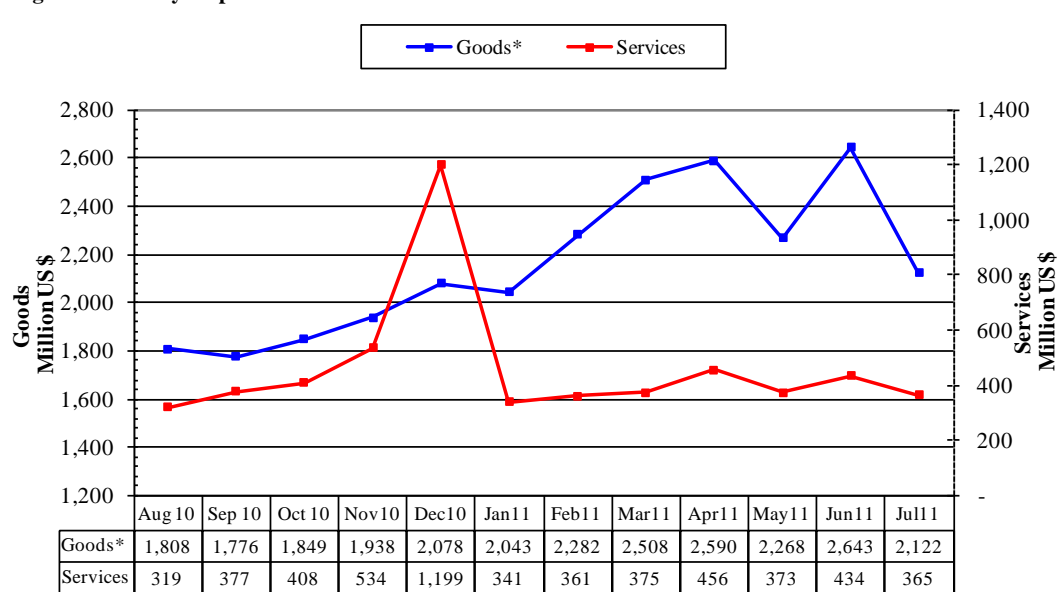
Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) During Jul FY12**Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services (Banks) During Jul FY12**
