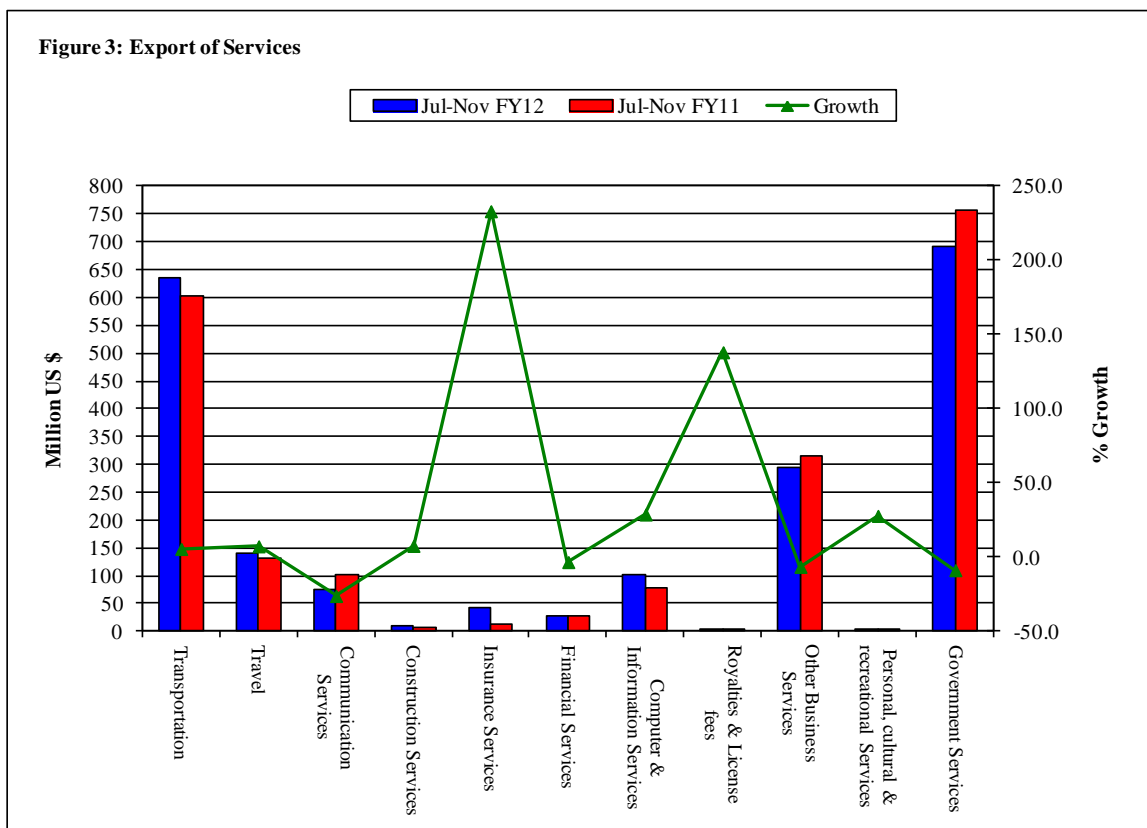
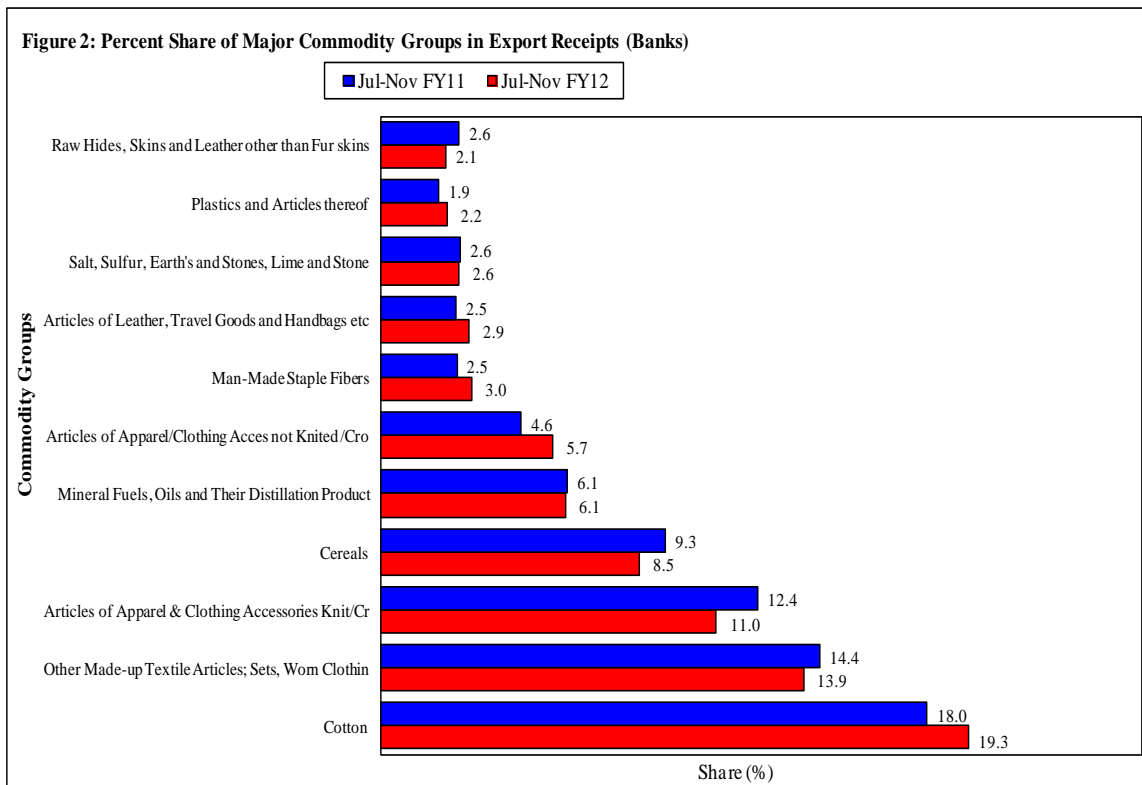

Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) During Jul-Nov FY12

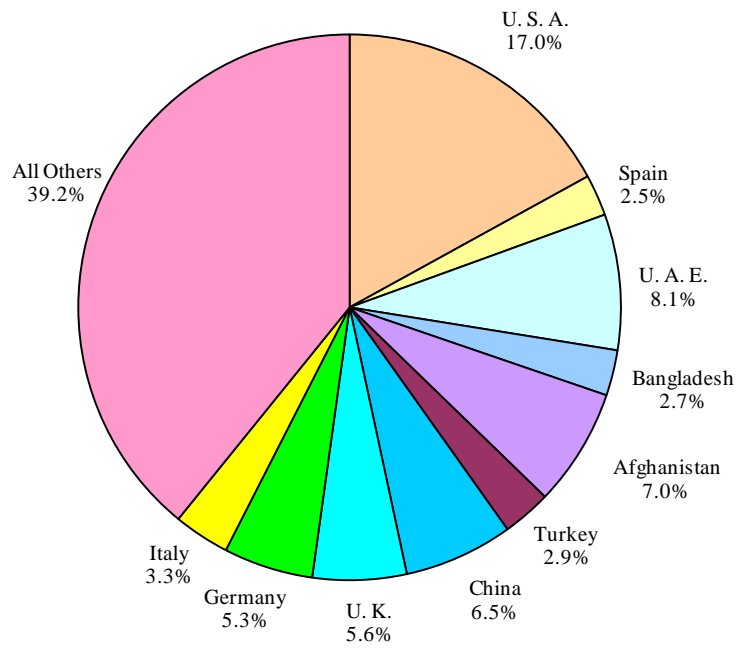
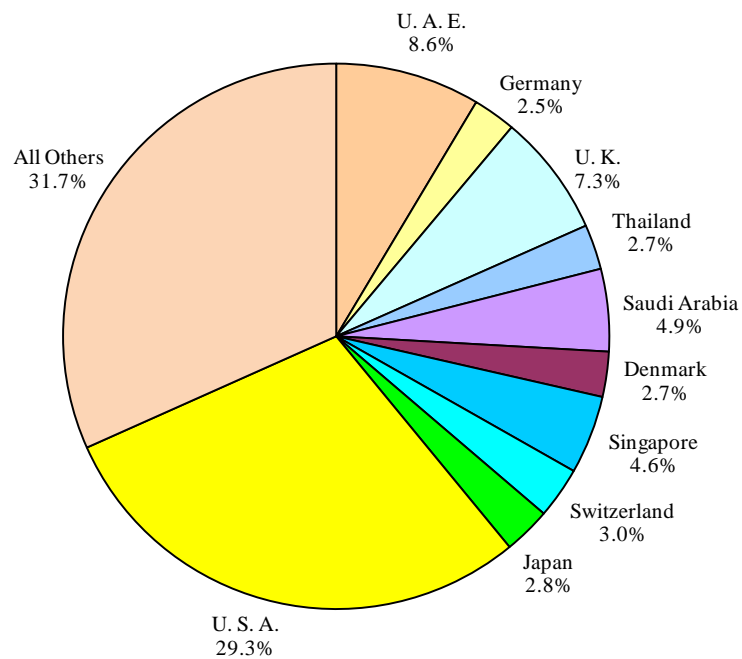
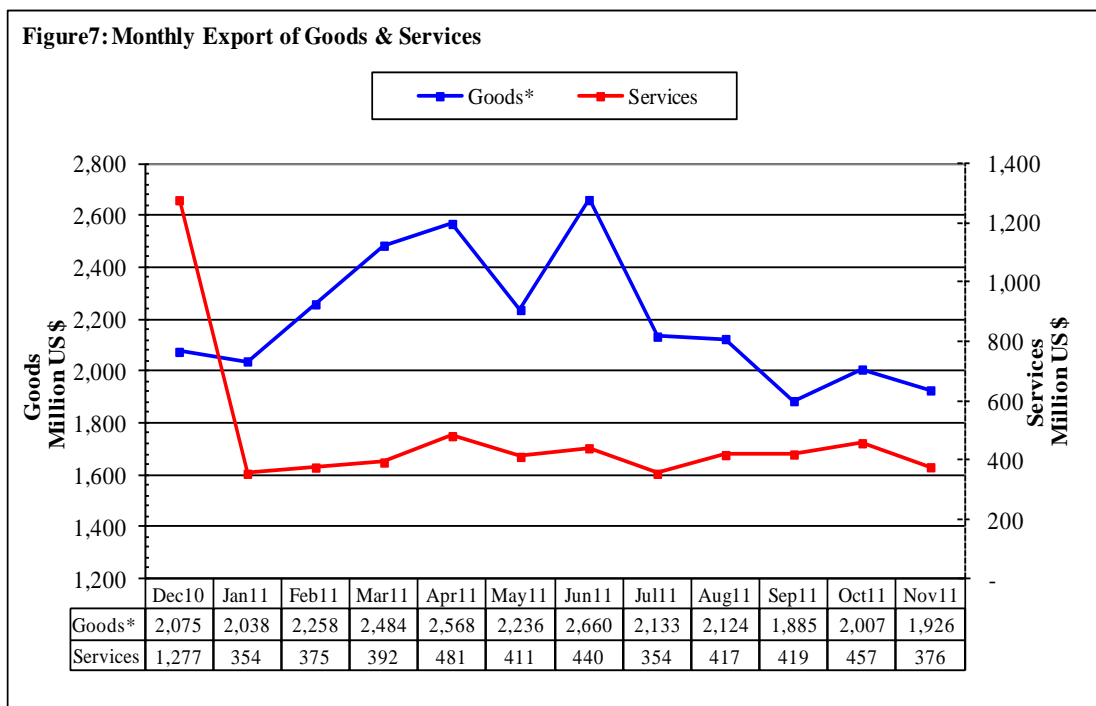
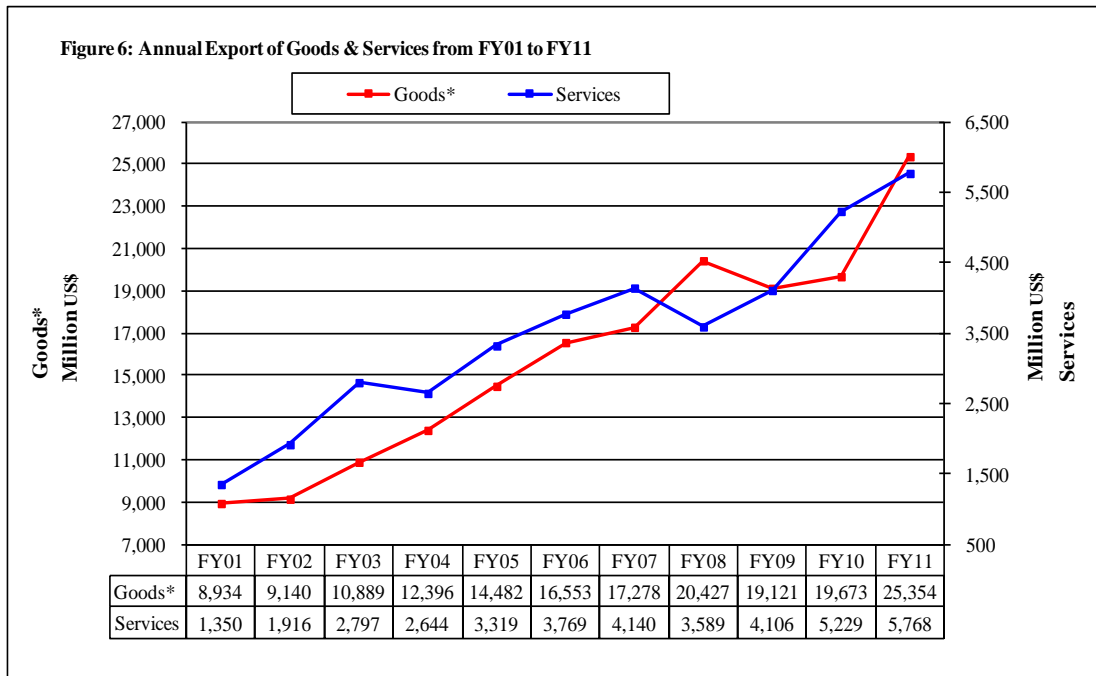


Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services (Banks) During Jul-Nov FY12
