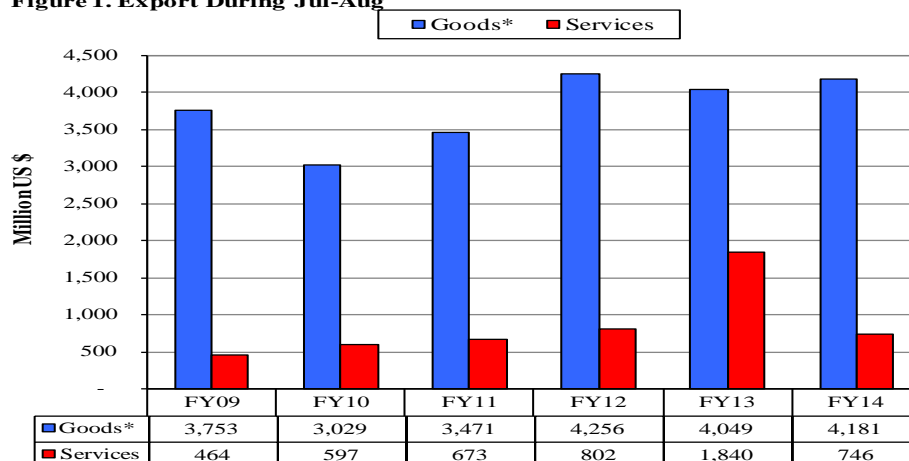

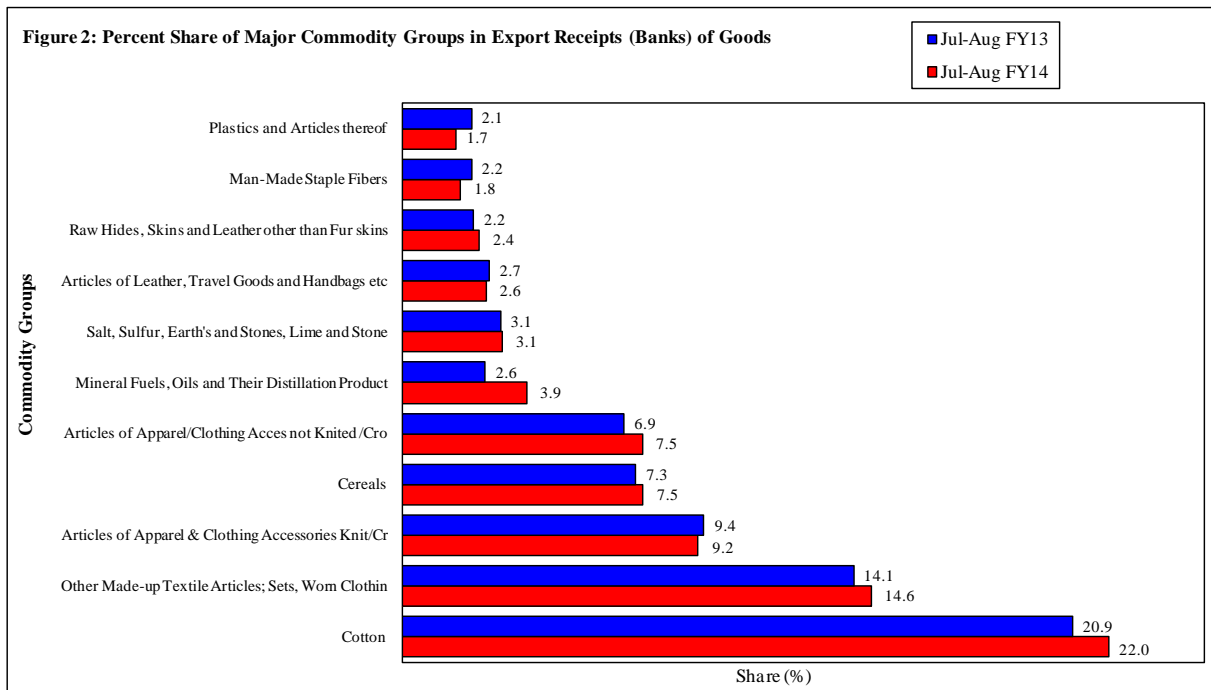


Figure 3: Export of Services

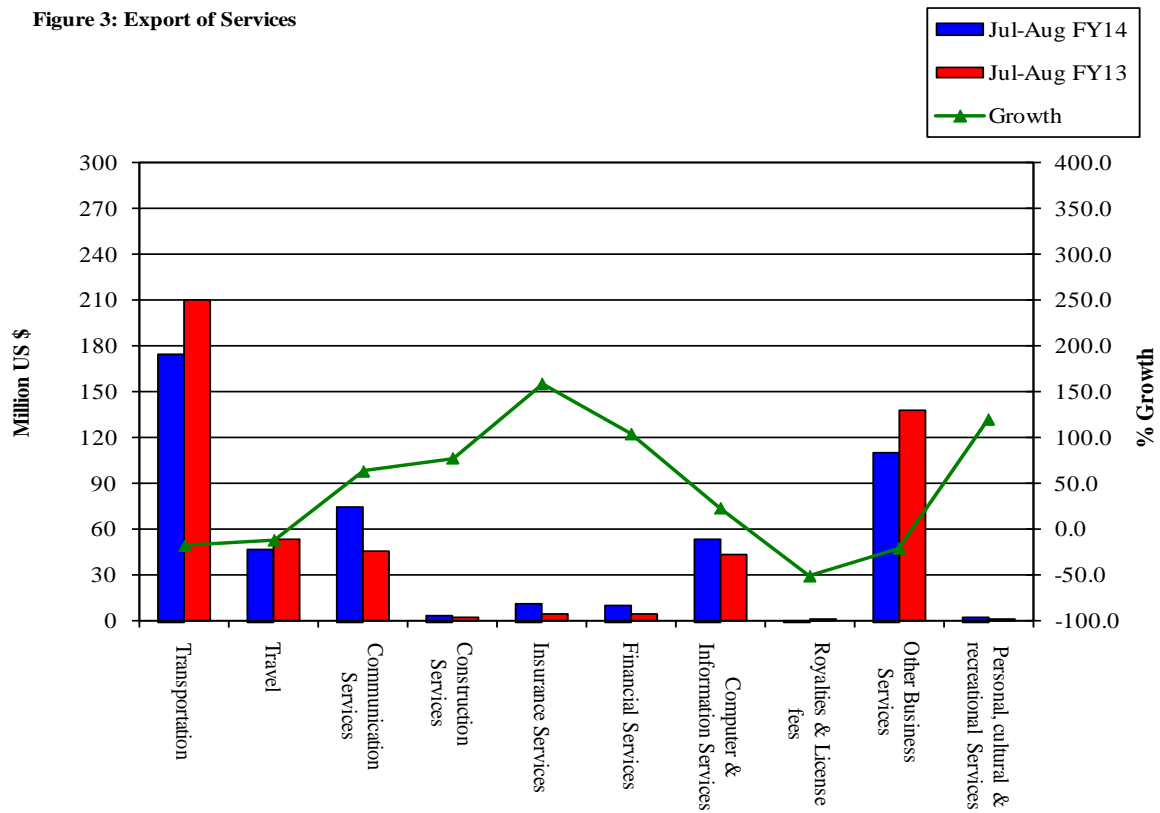
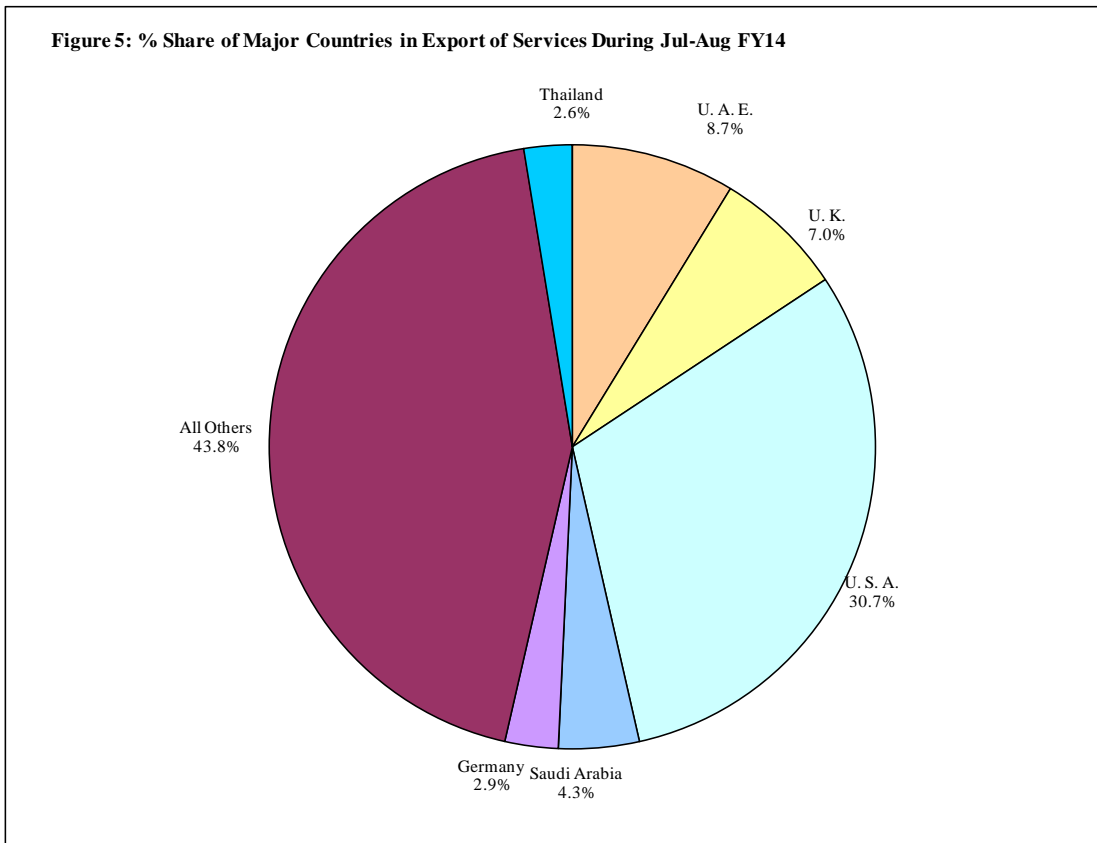
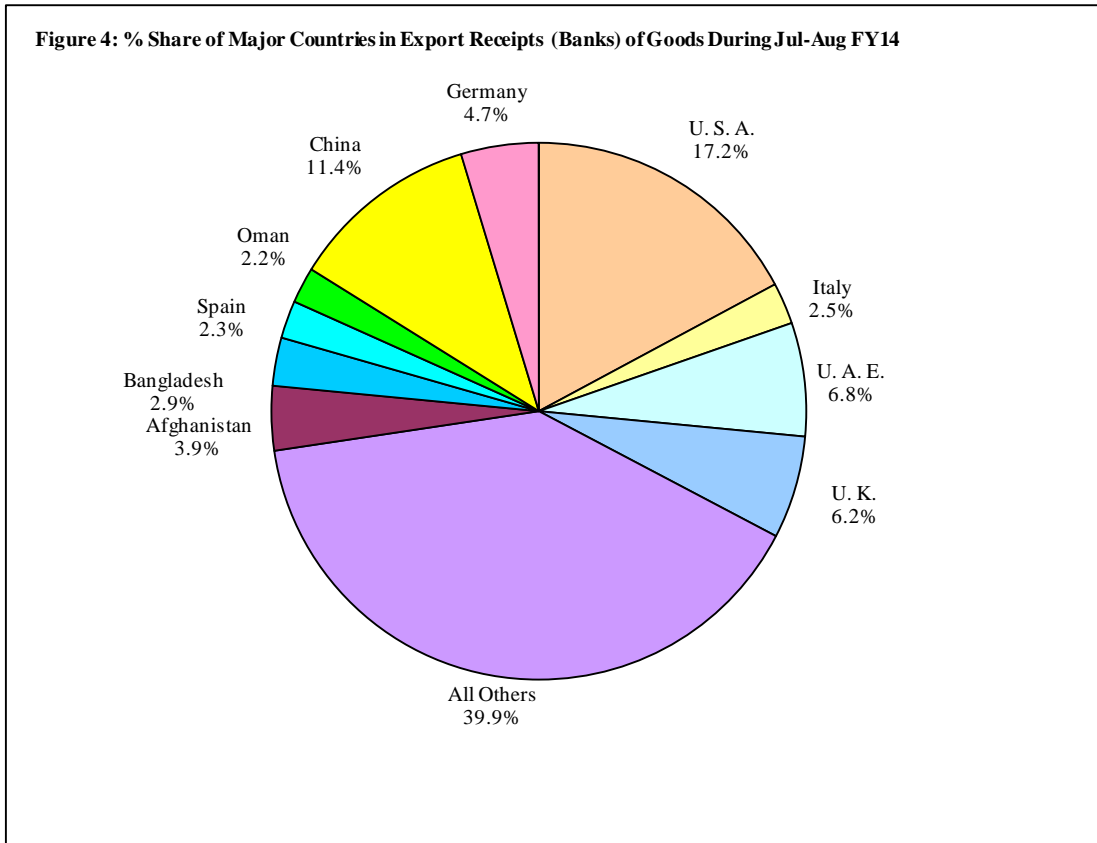
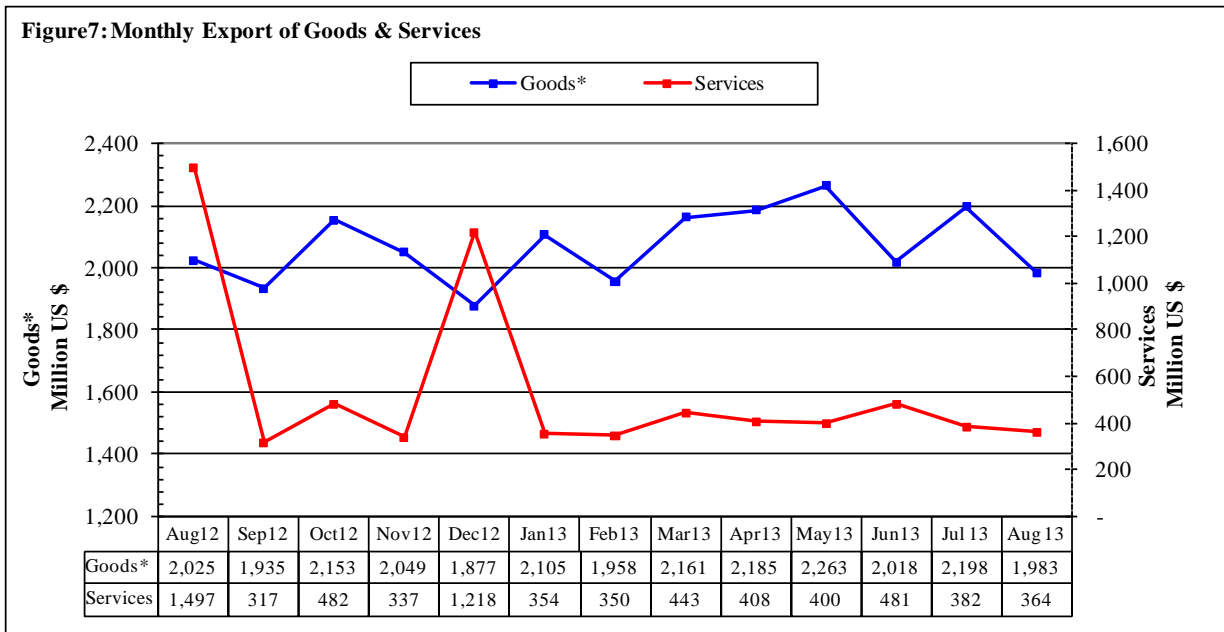
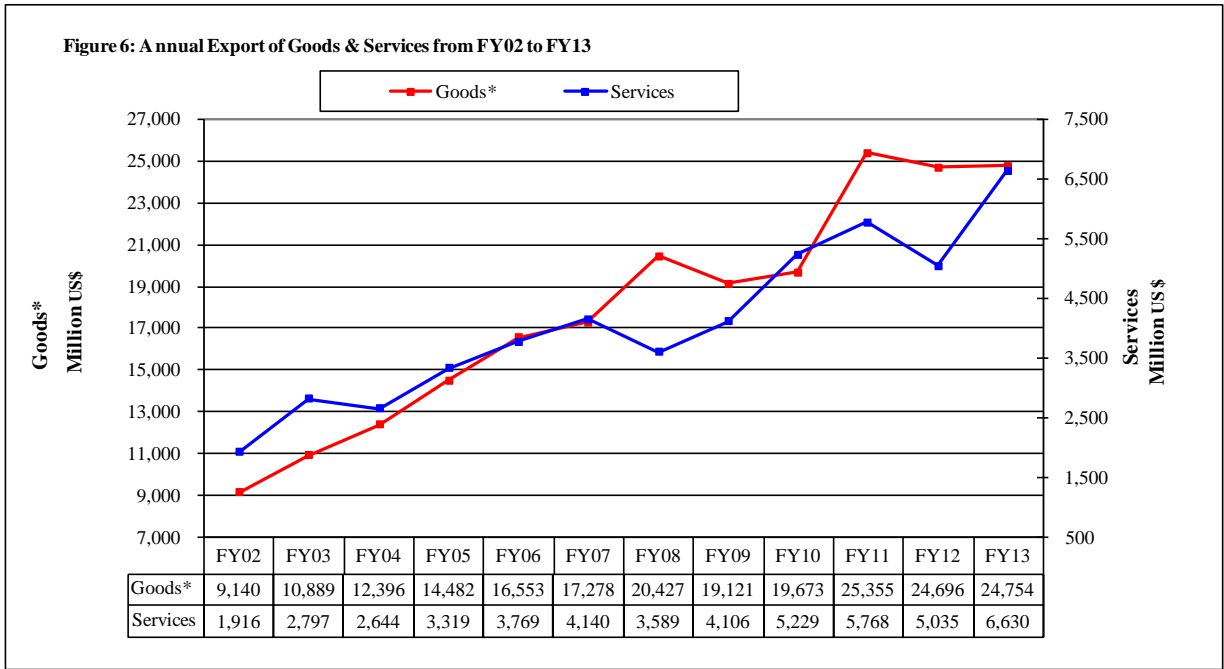
