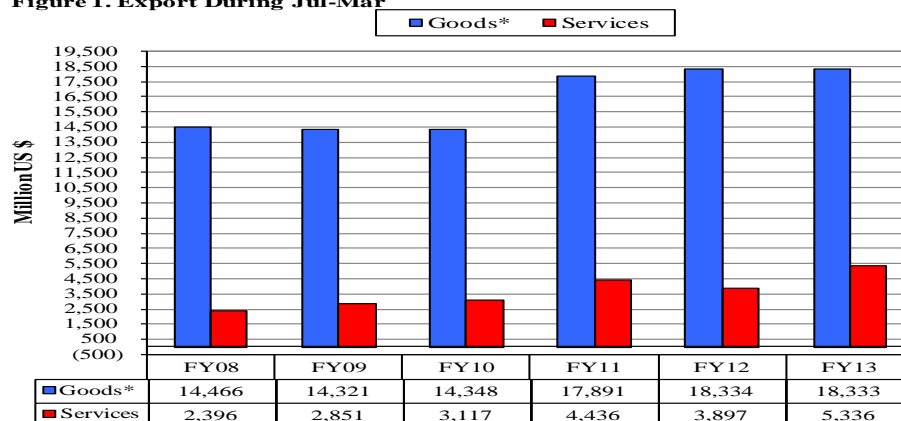

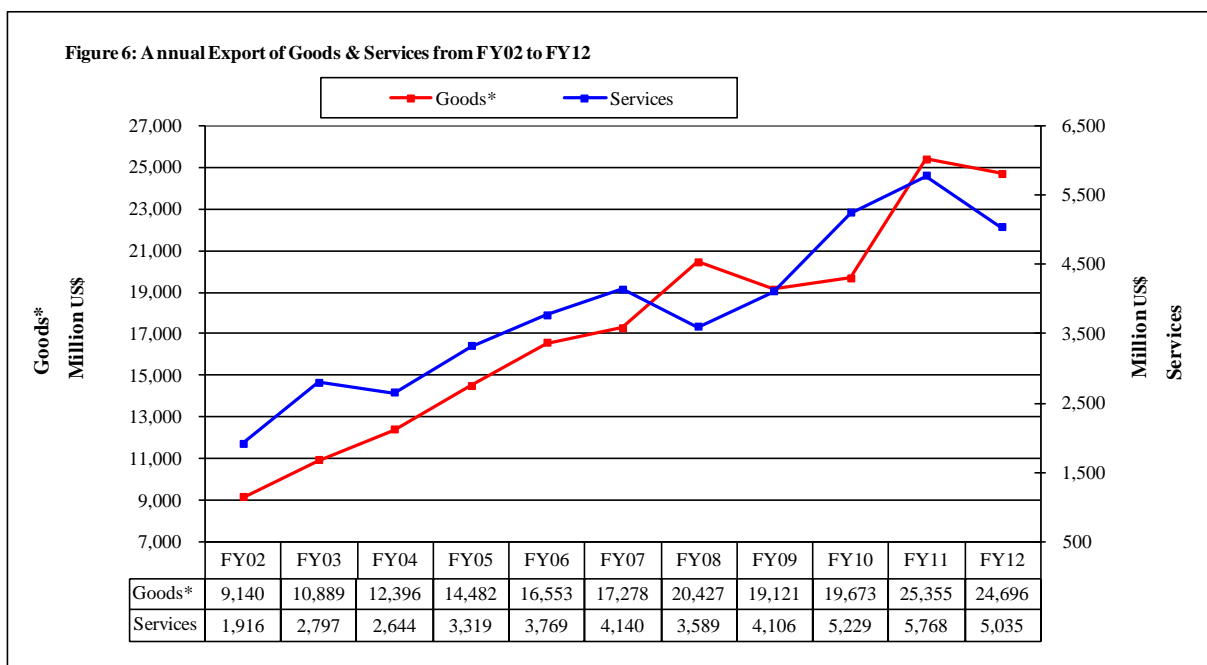
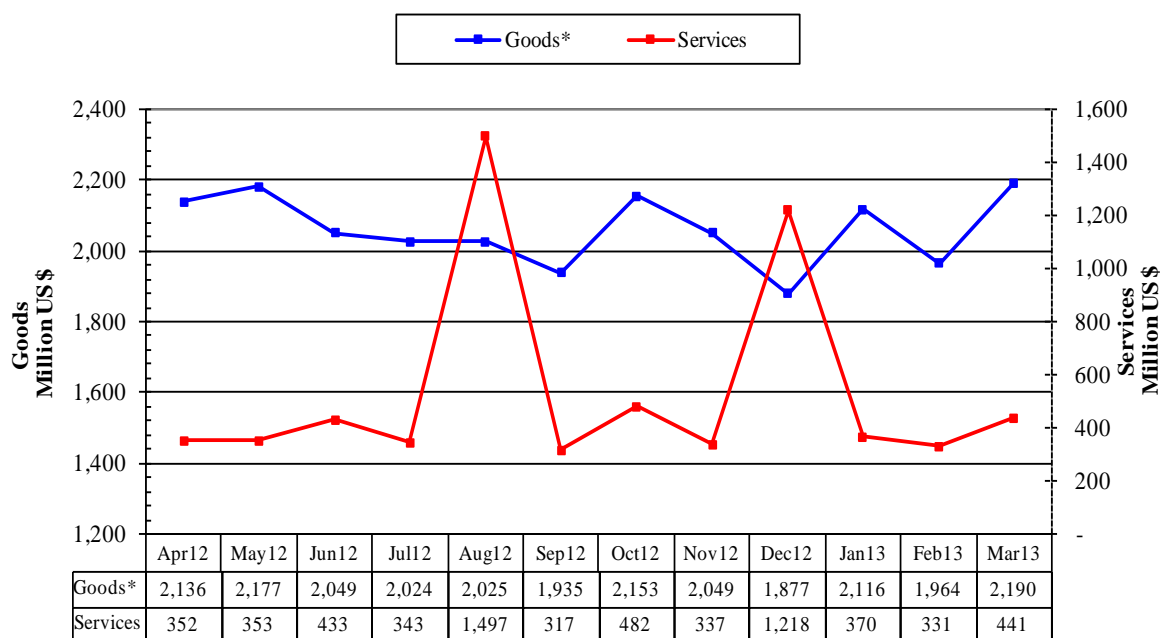


Figure7: Monthly Export of Goods & Services
