Figure 1. Export of Goods and Services during Jul-Dec

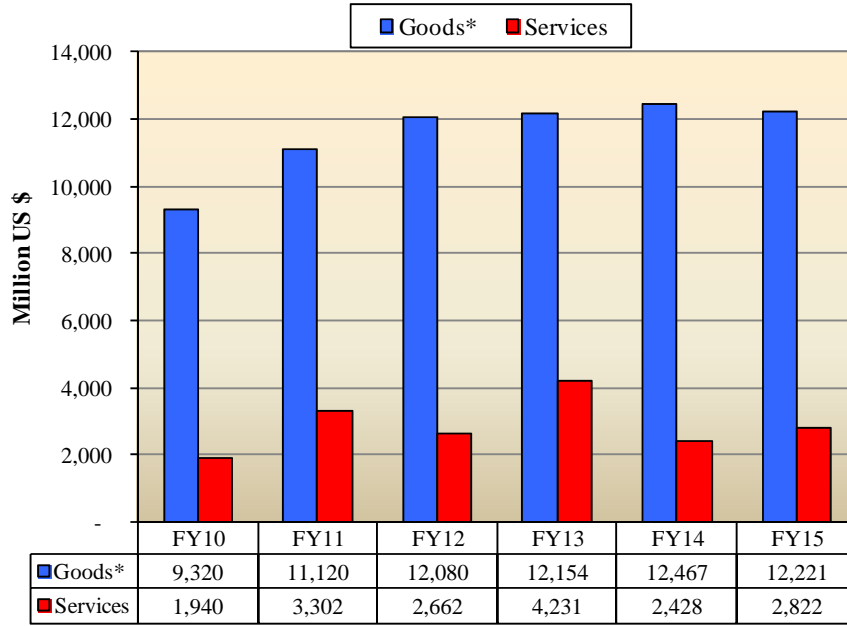
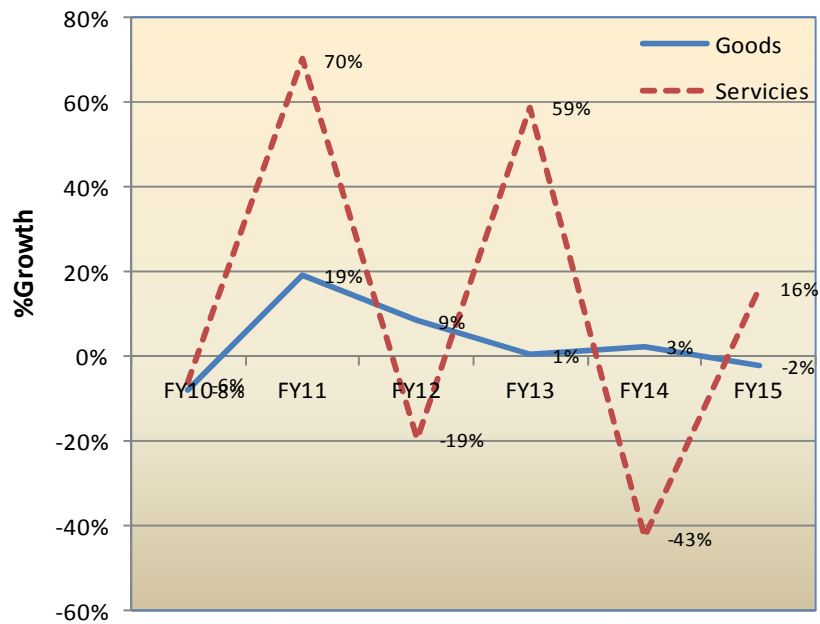


Figure 2. YOY Growth in Export of Goods and Services during Jul-Dec

Figure 2: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods

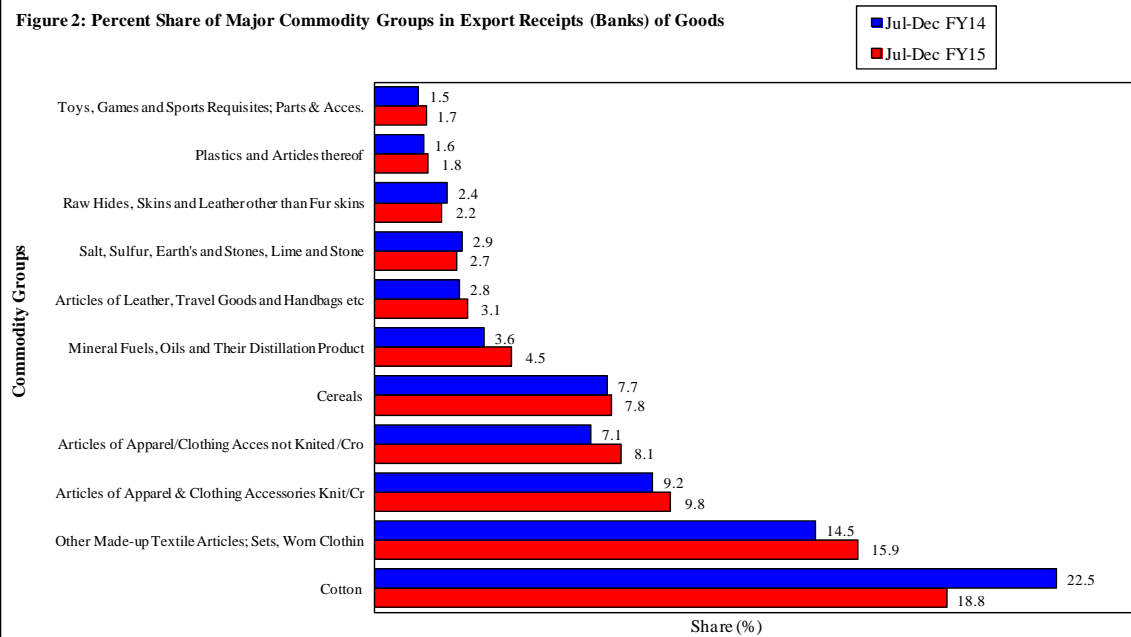
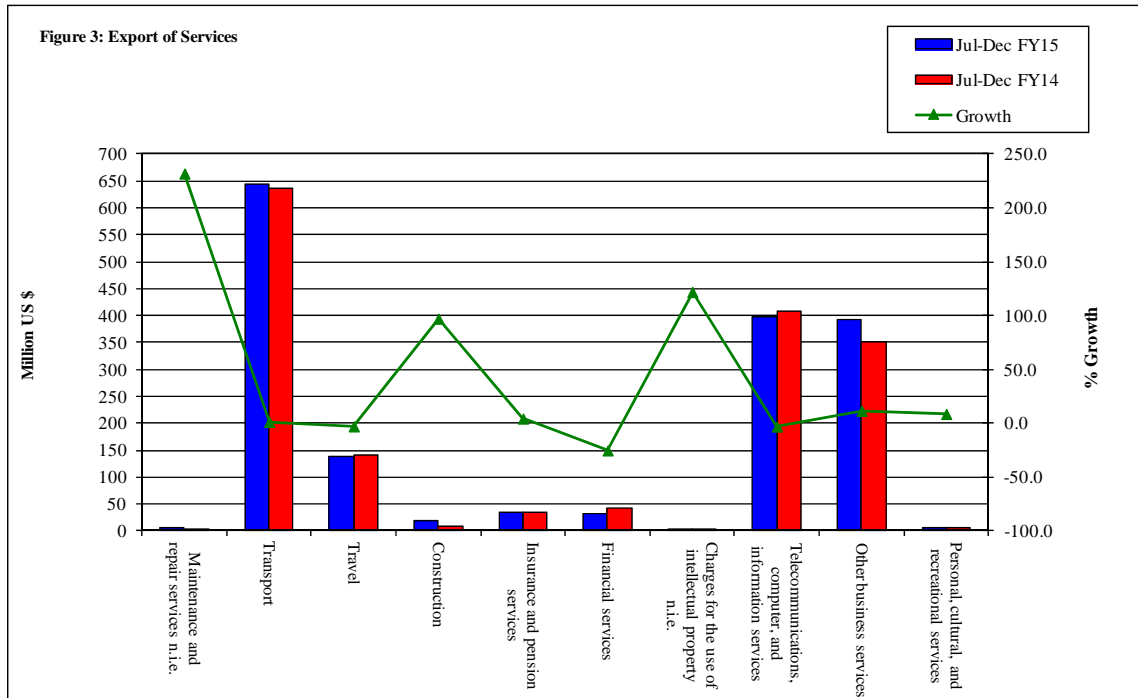


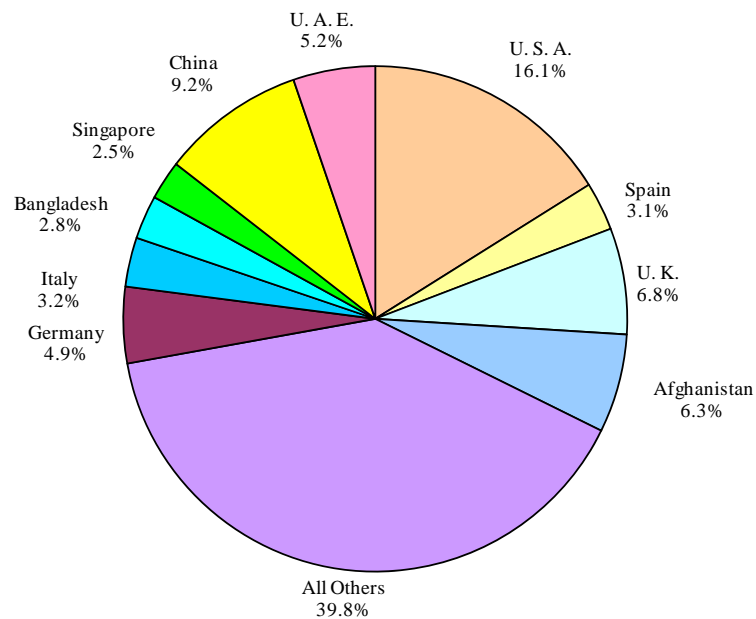
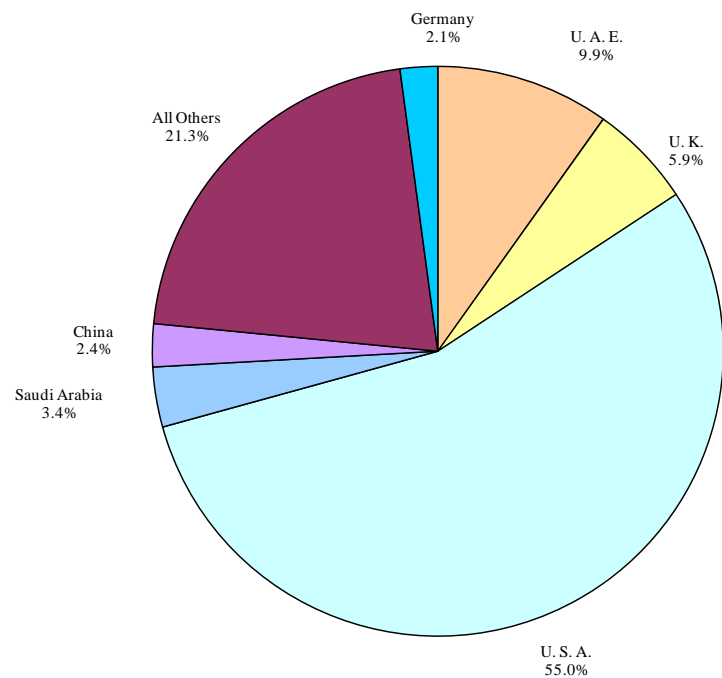
Figure 3: Export of Services

Figure 6: Annual Export of Goods &amp; Services from FY06 to FY14

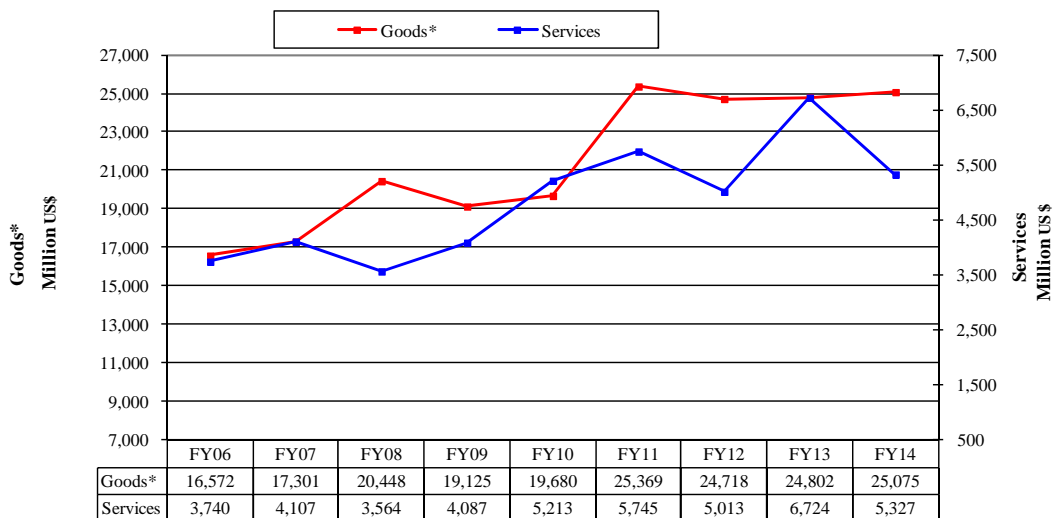
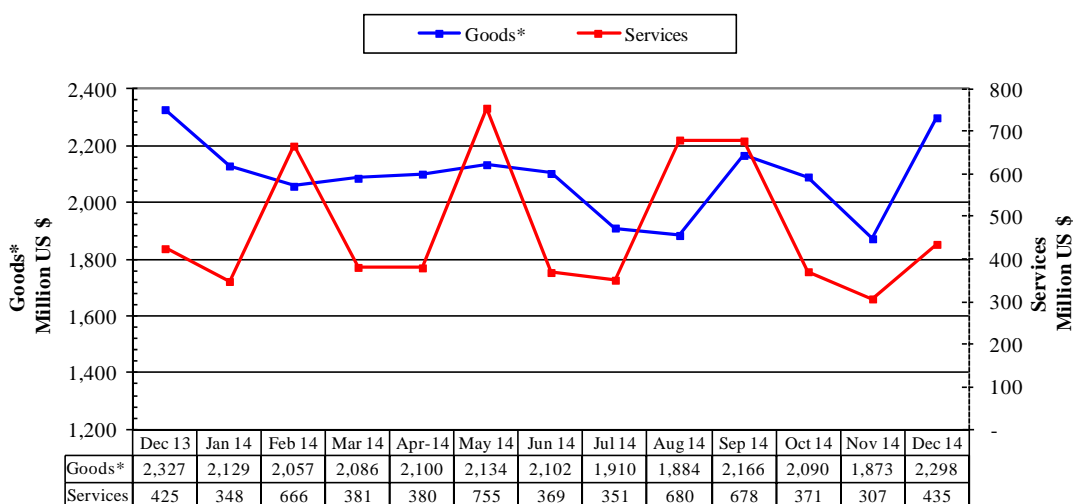


Figure 7: Monthly Export of Goods &amp; Services
