Figure 1. Export of Goods and Services during Jul-Sep

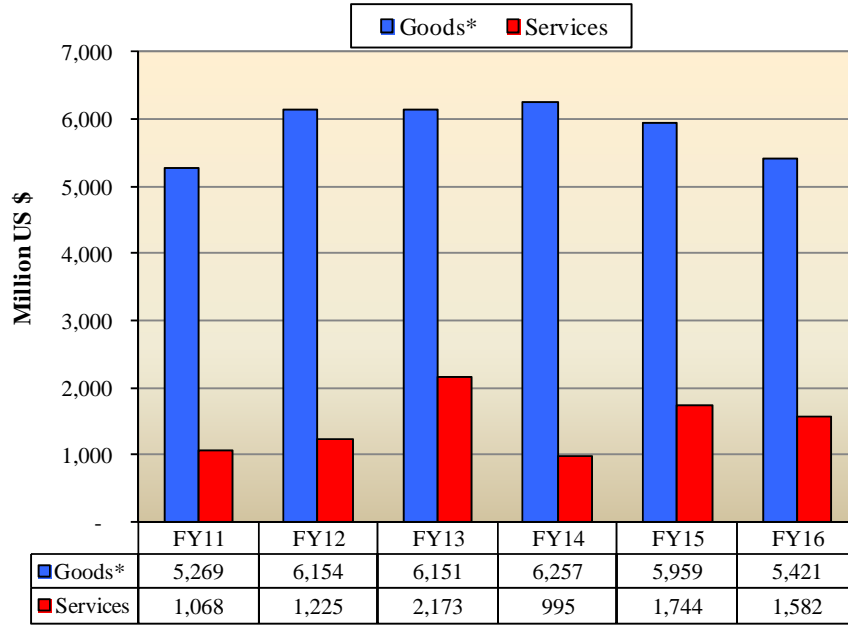
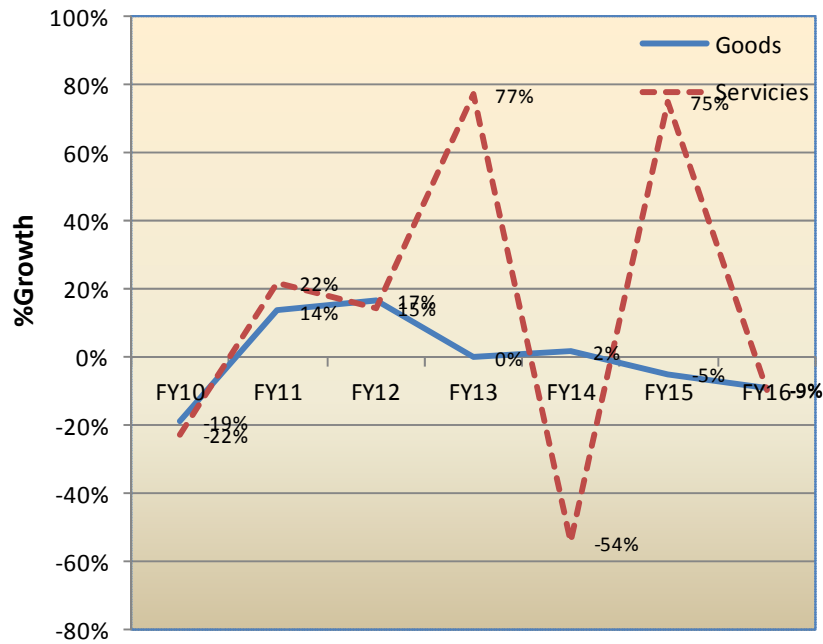


Figure 2. YOY Growth in Export of Goods and Services during Jul-Sep

Figure 2: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods

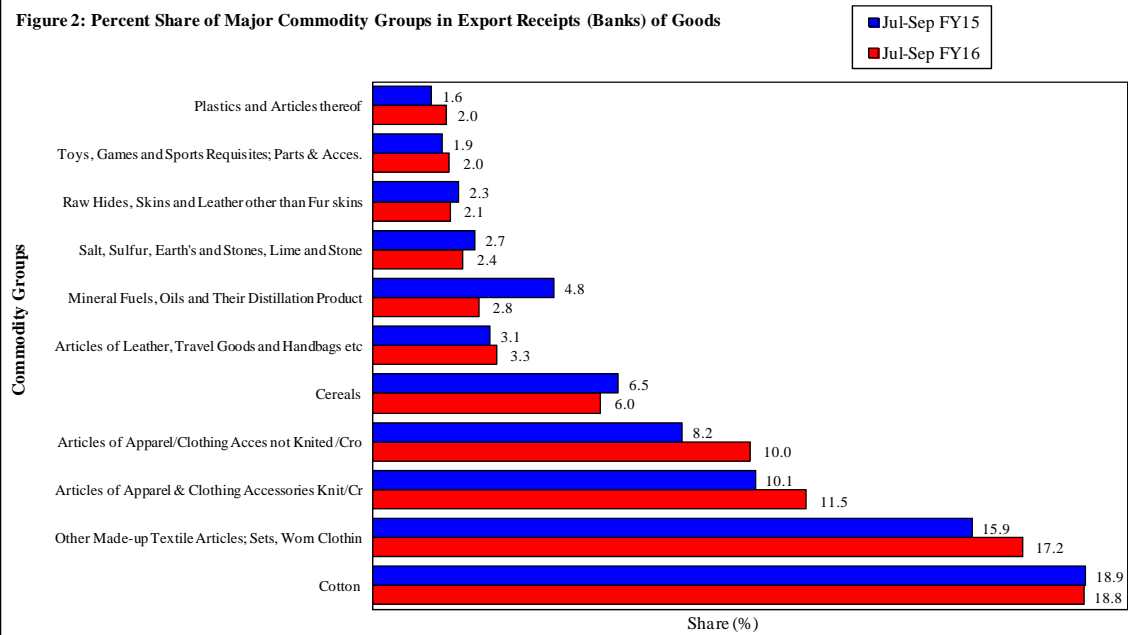


Figure 3: Export of Services

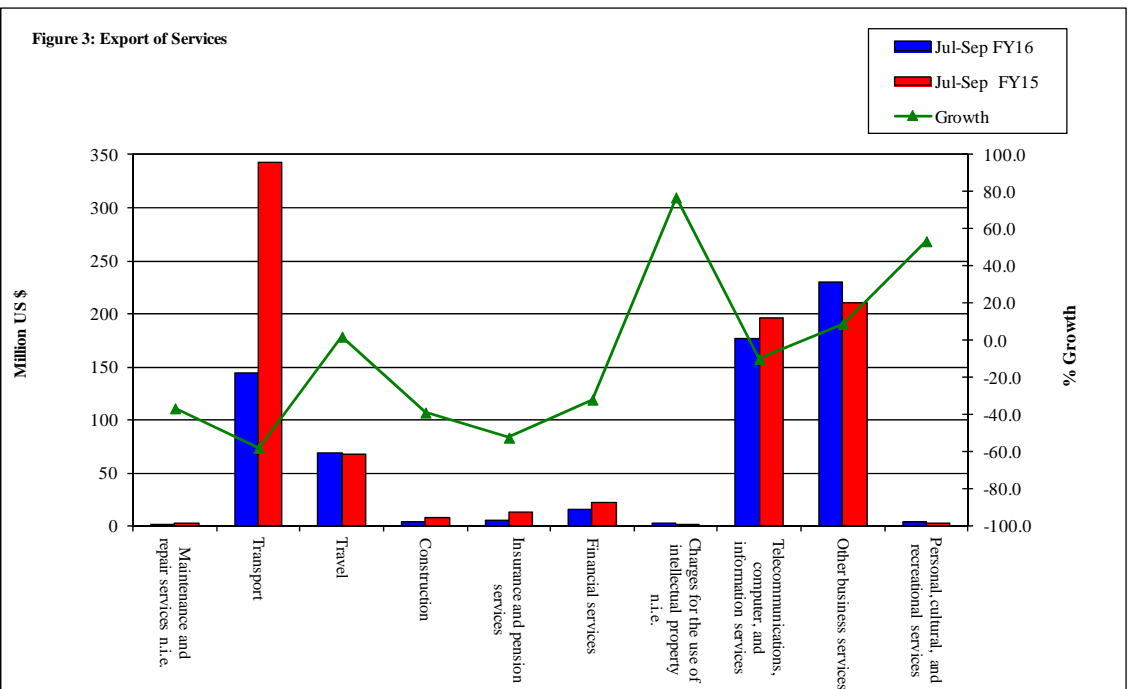
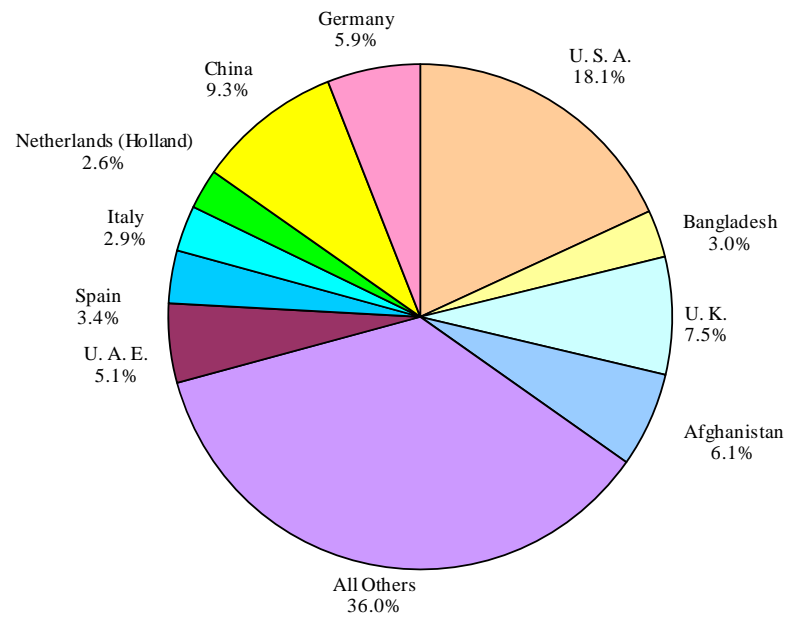
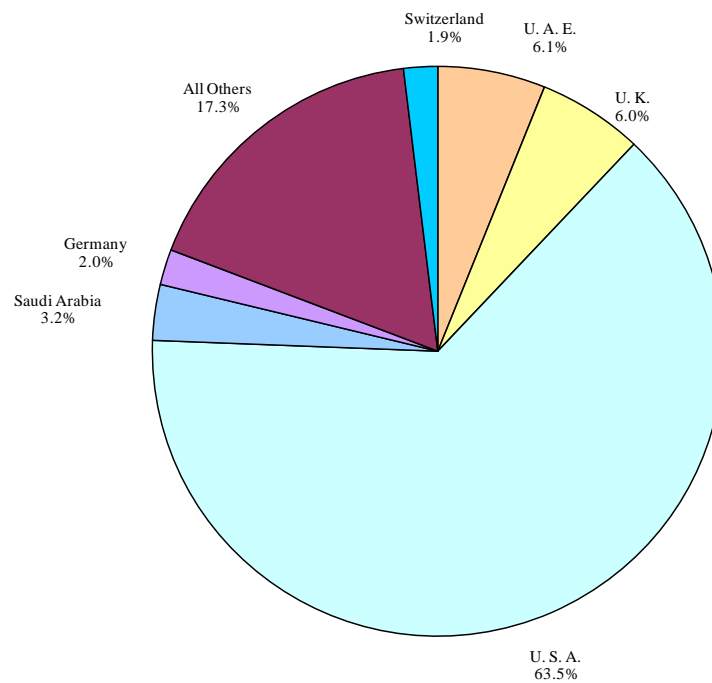


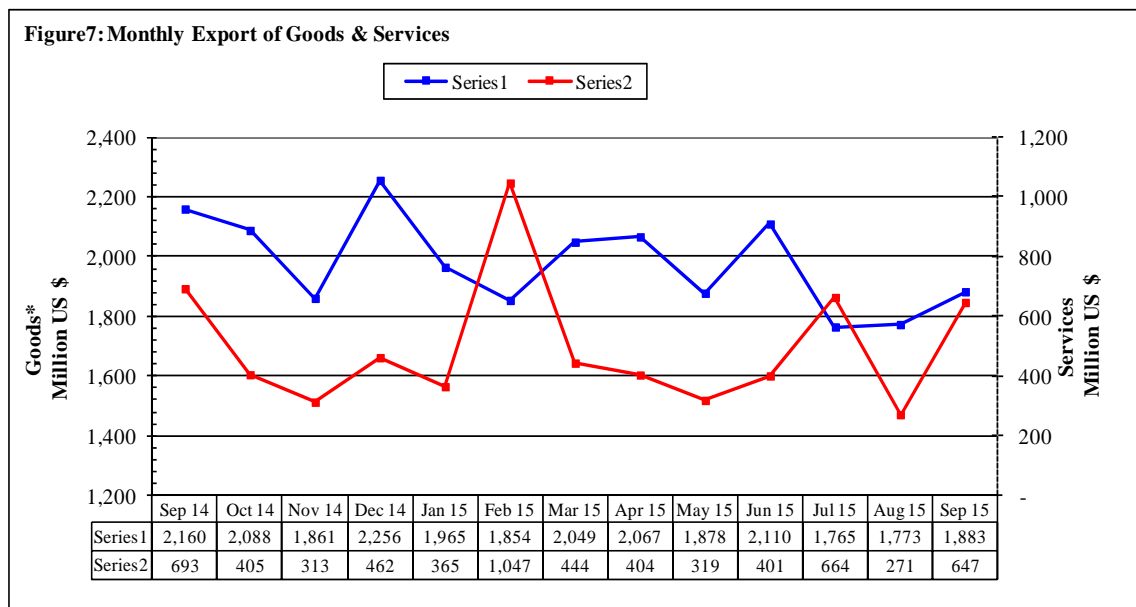
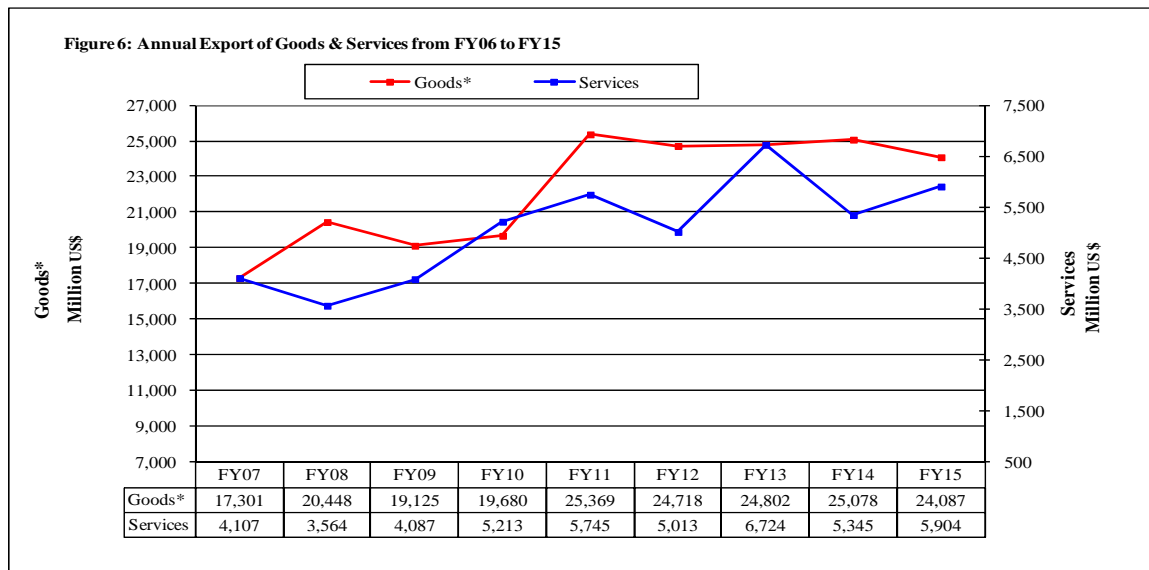
