


Figure 2: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods




Figure 3: Export of Services



Note: % Share is based on Export Receipts through Banks



**Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services During Jul-Apr FY16**

Figure 6: Annual Export of Goods & Services from FY06 to FY15





Figure7: Monthly Export of Goods & Services
