Figure 1. Export of Goods and Services during Jul-Jan

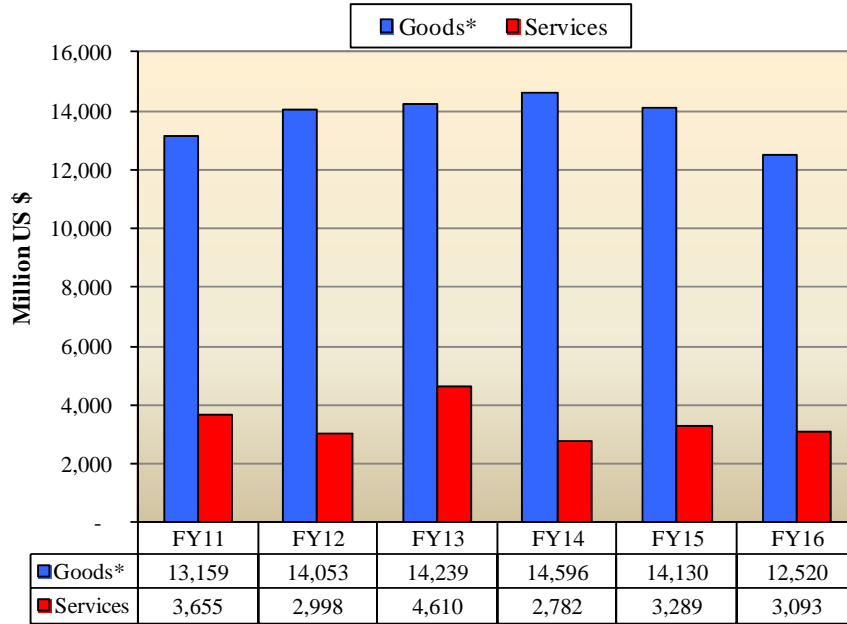
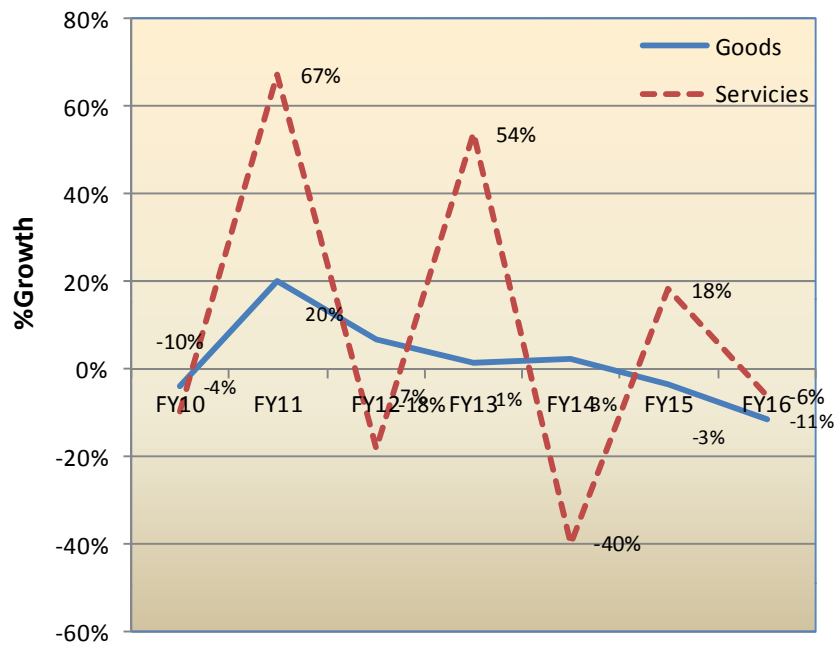


Figure 2. YOY Growth in Export of Goods and Services during Jul-Jan

Figure 2: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods

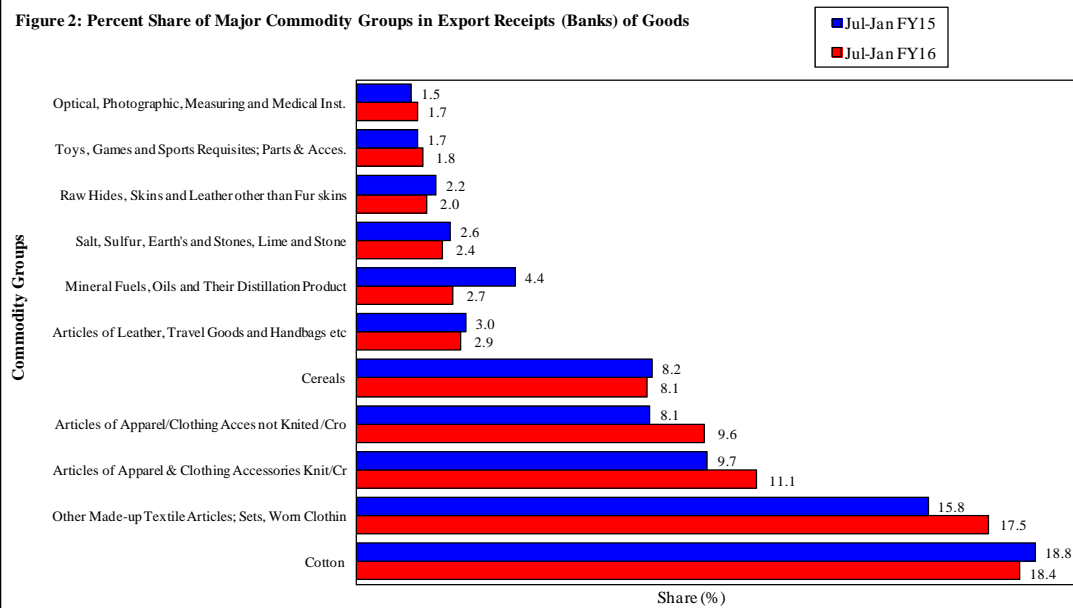


Figure 3: Export of Services

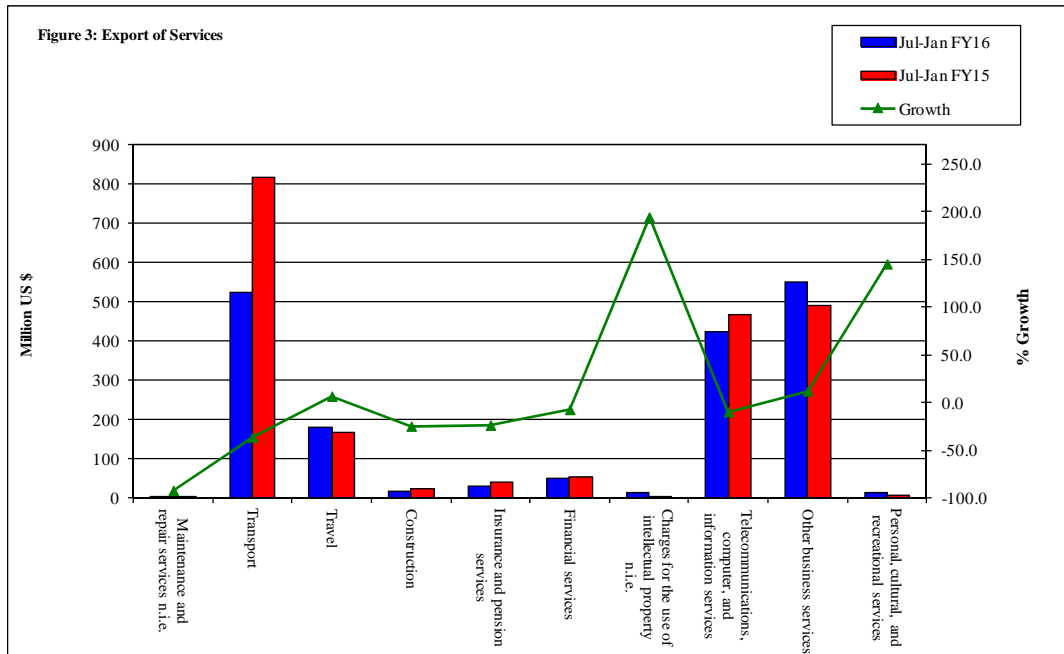
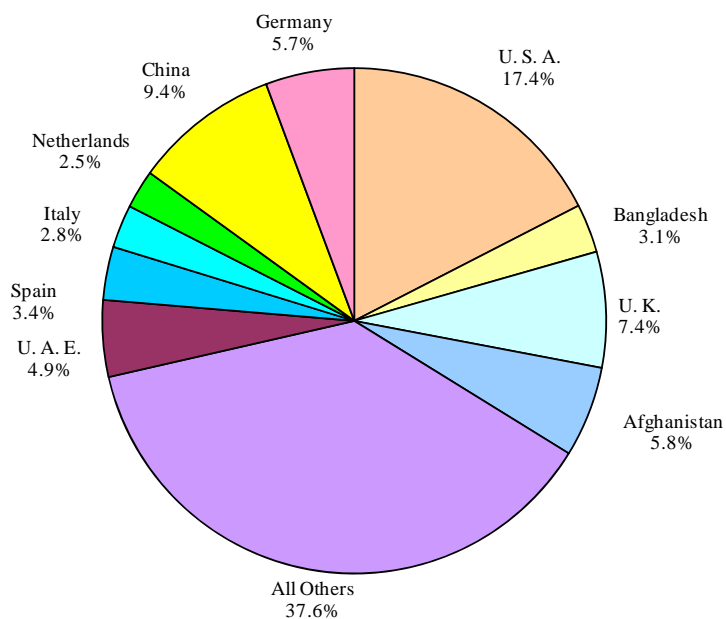
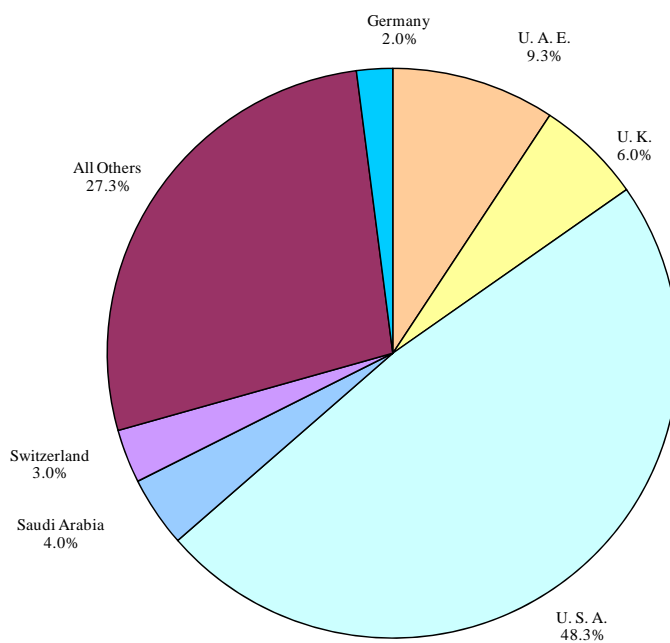

Figure6: Annual Export of Goods & Services from FY06 to FY15

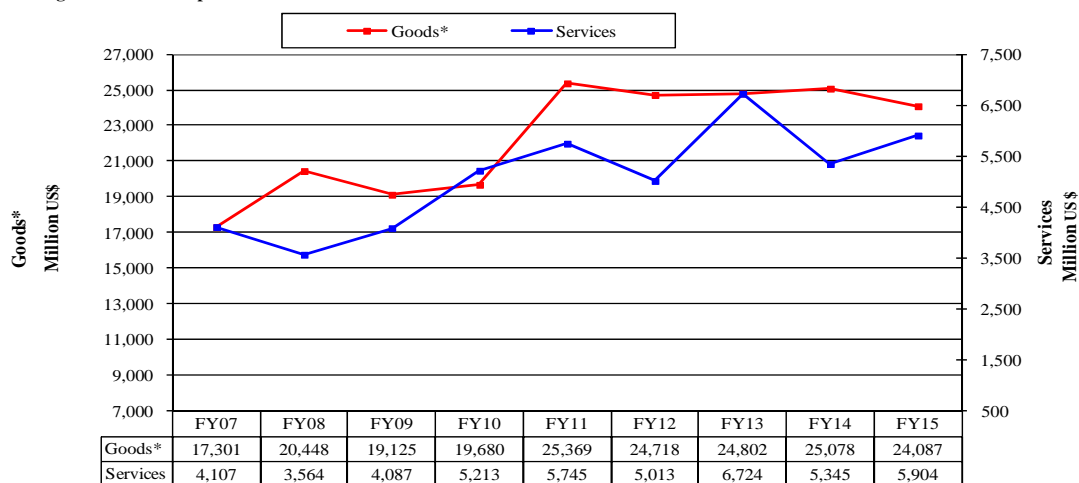
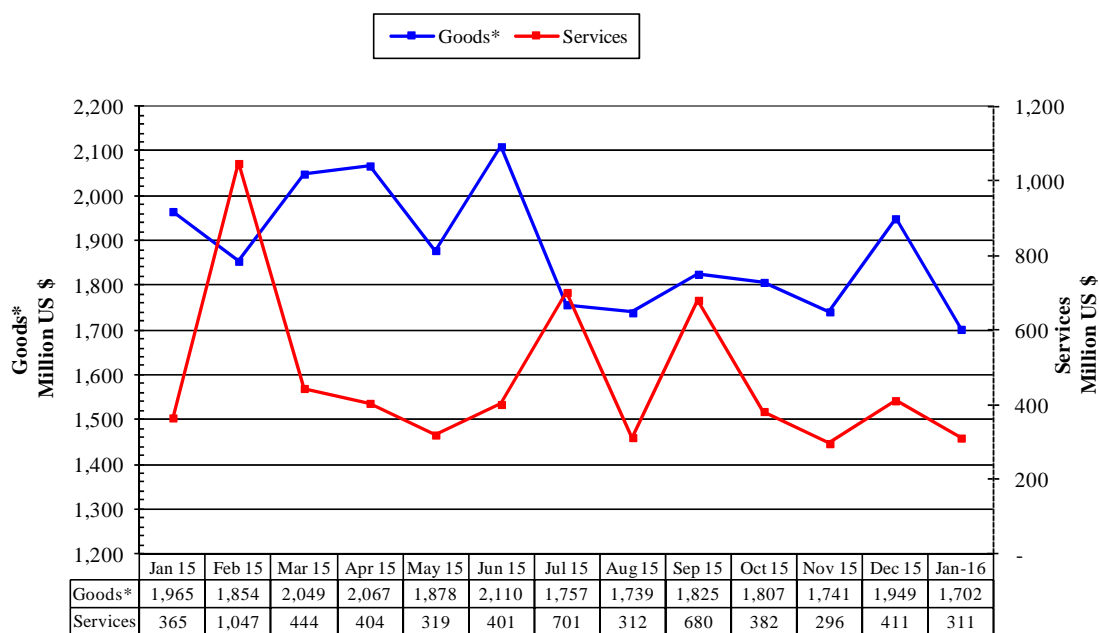


Figure7: Monthly Export of Goods & Services
