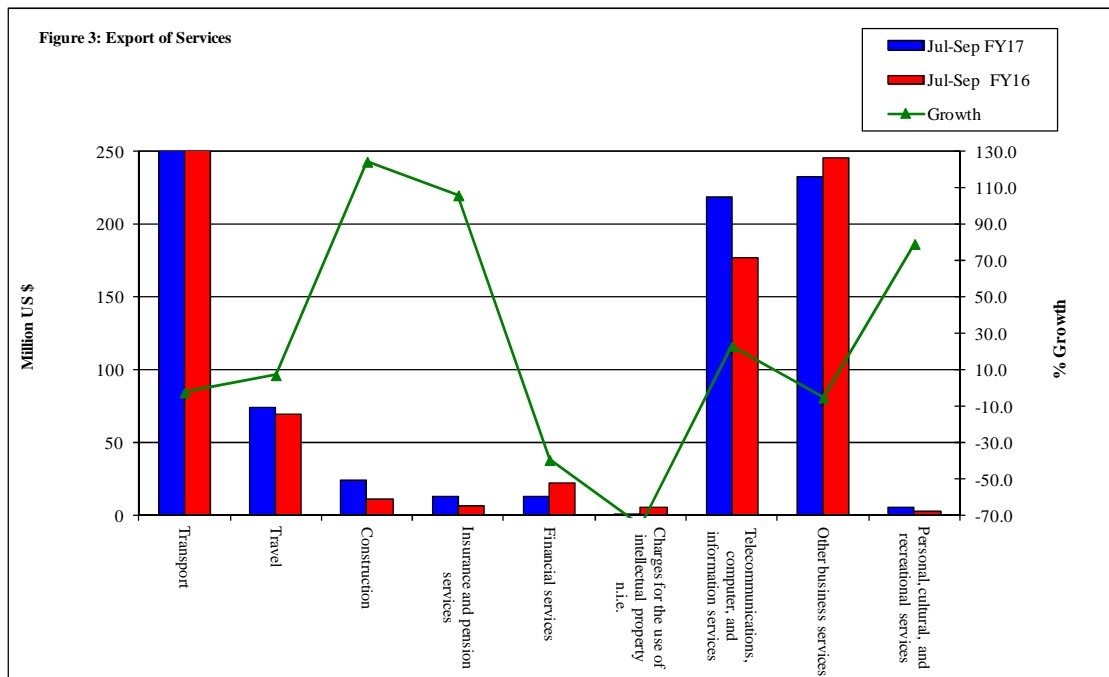
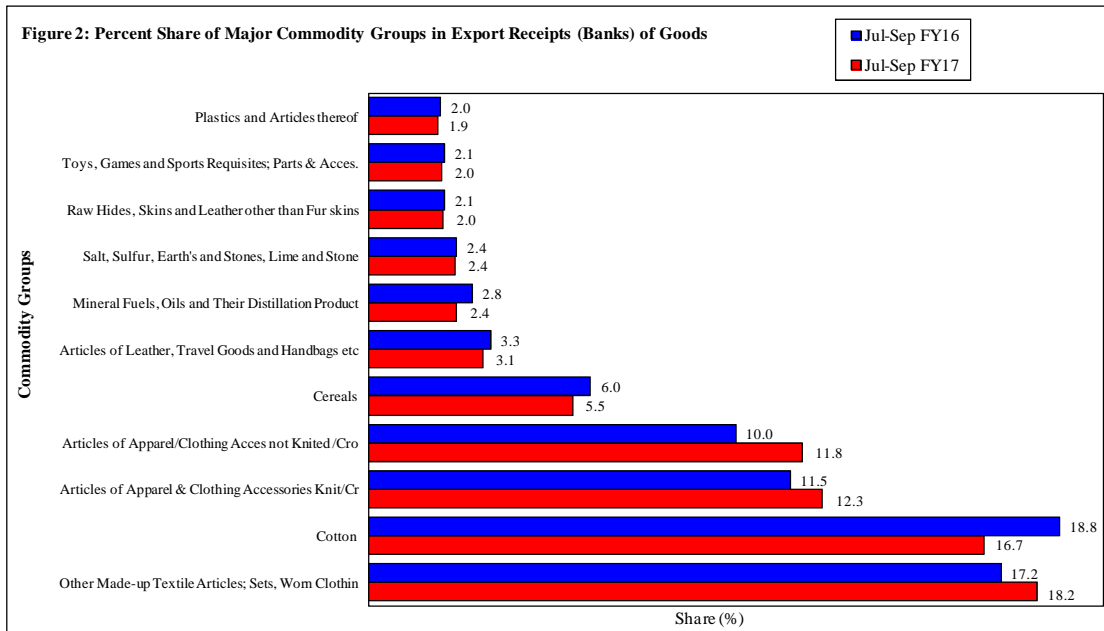

Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods During Jul-Sep FY17

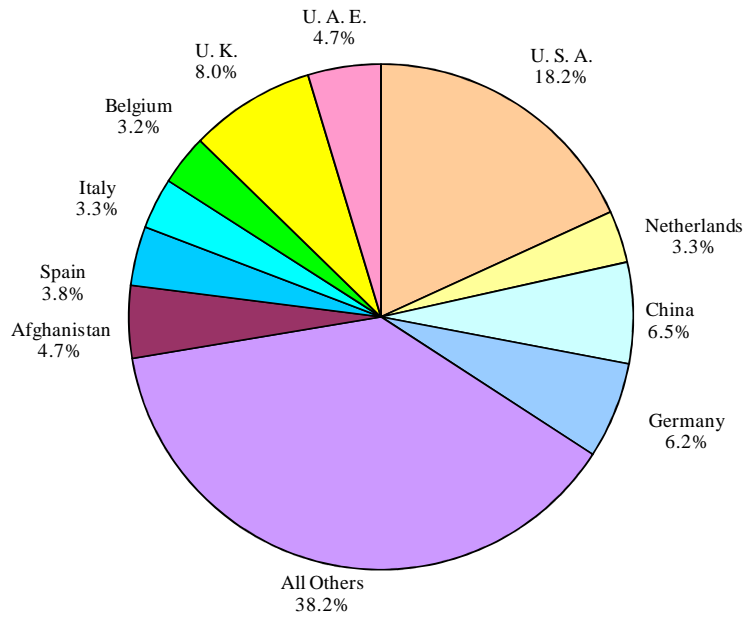
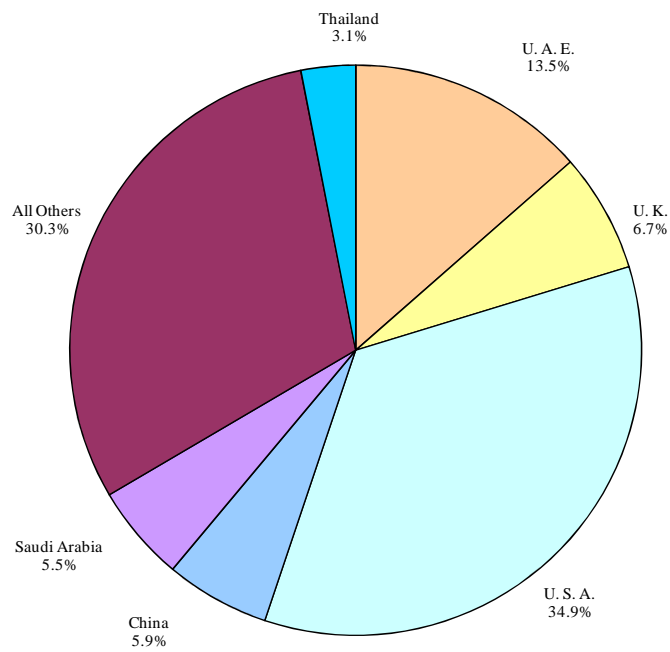
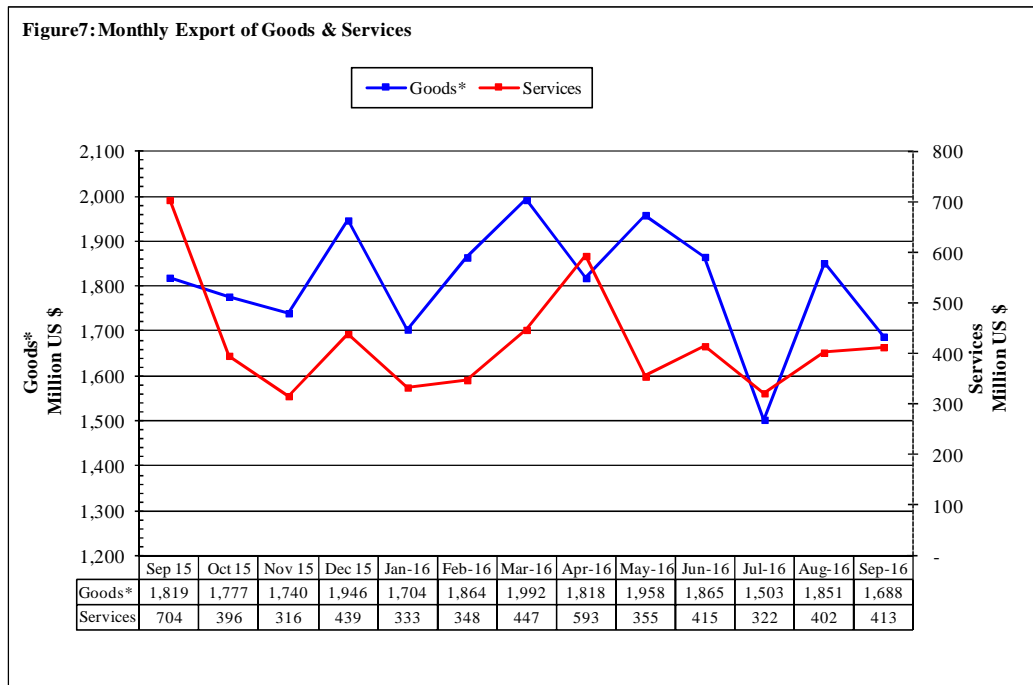
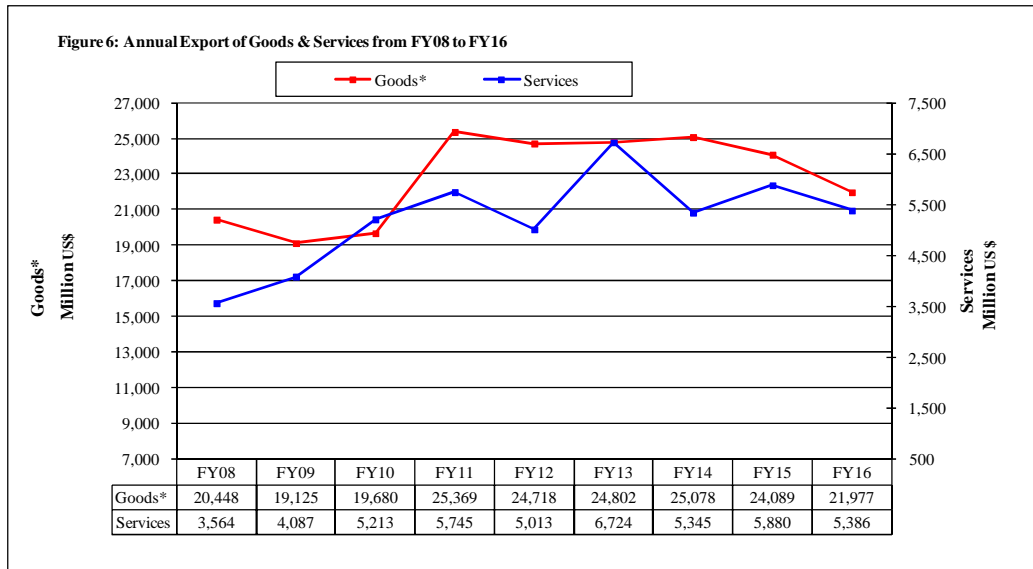


Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Export of Services During Jul-Sep FY17
