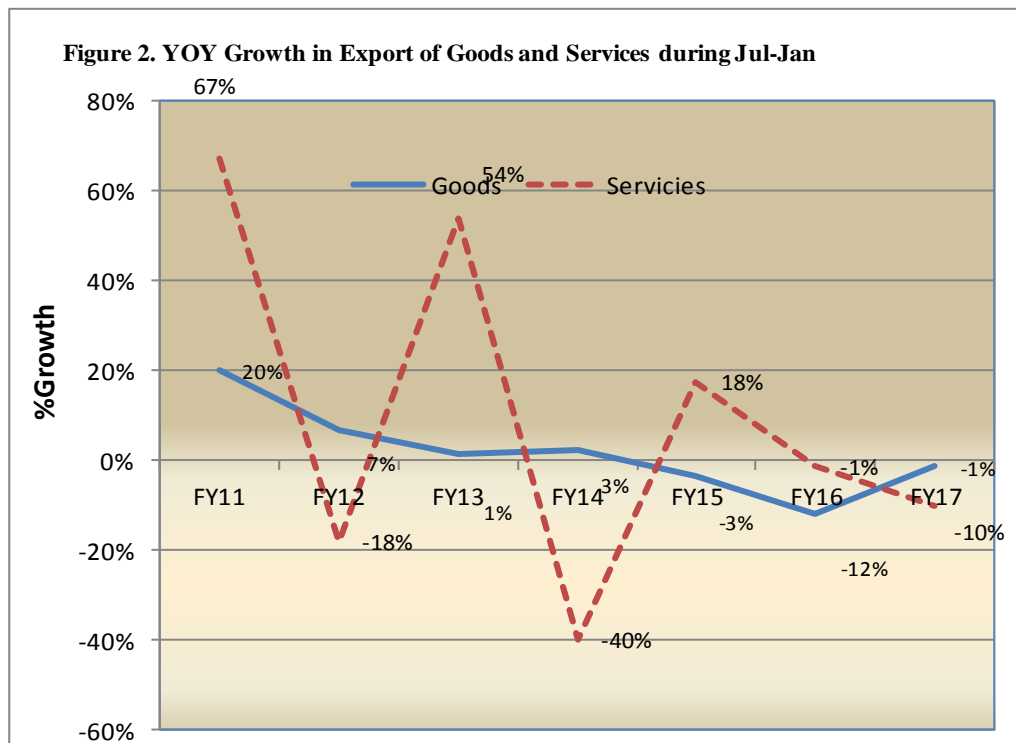
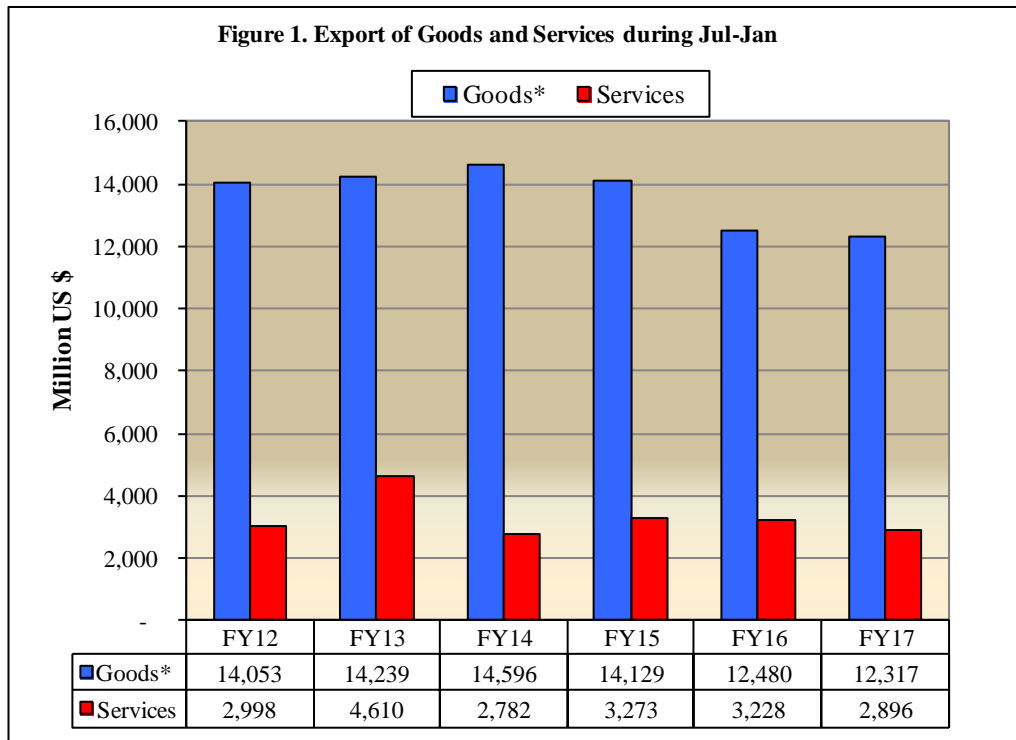

Figure 2: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Export Receipts (Banks) of Goods

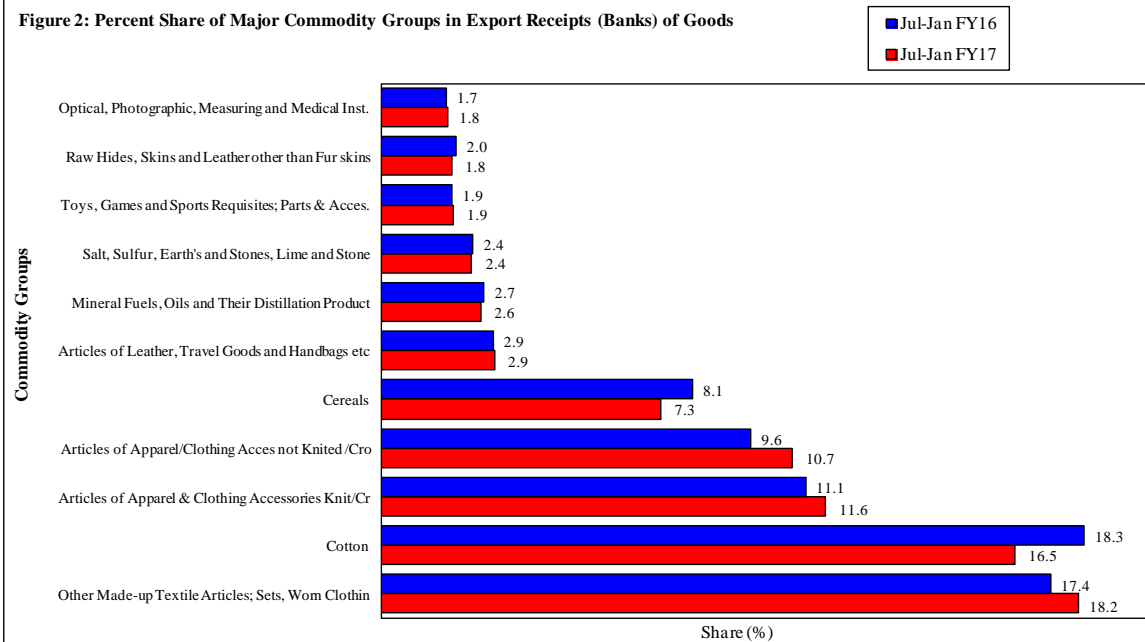


Figure 3: Export of Services

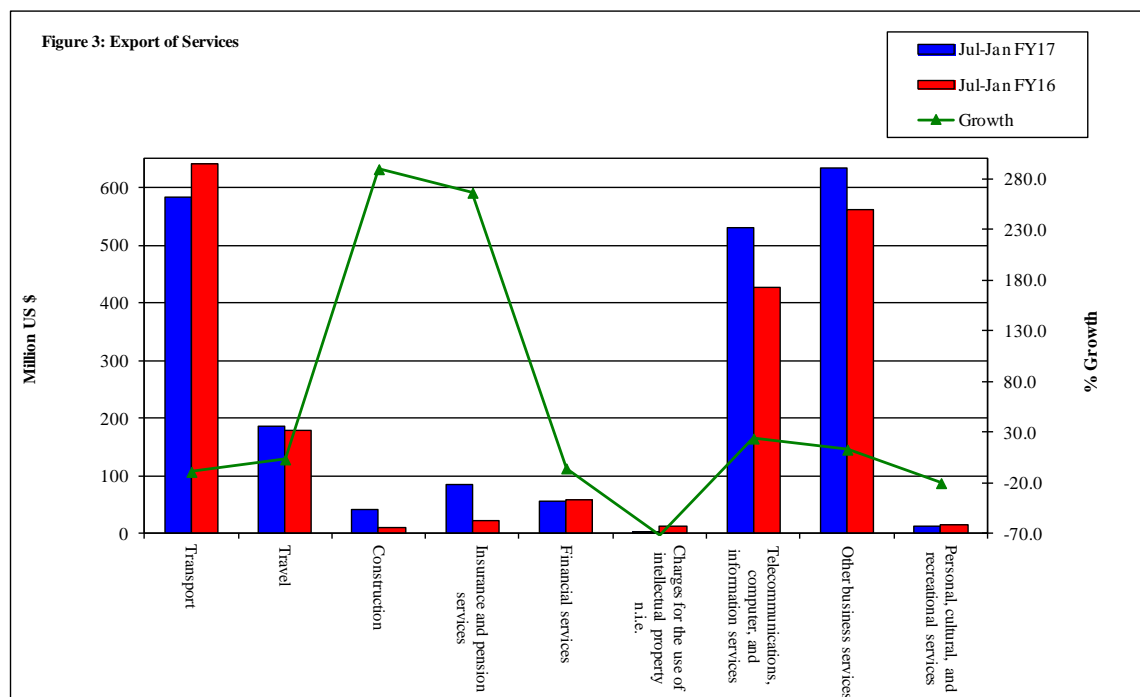
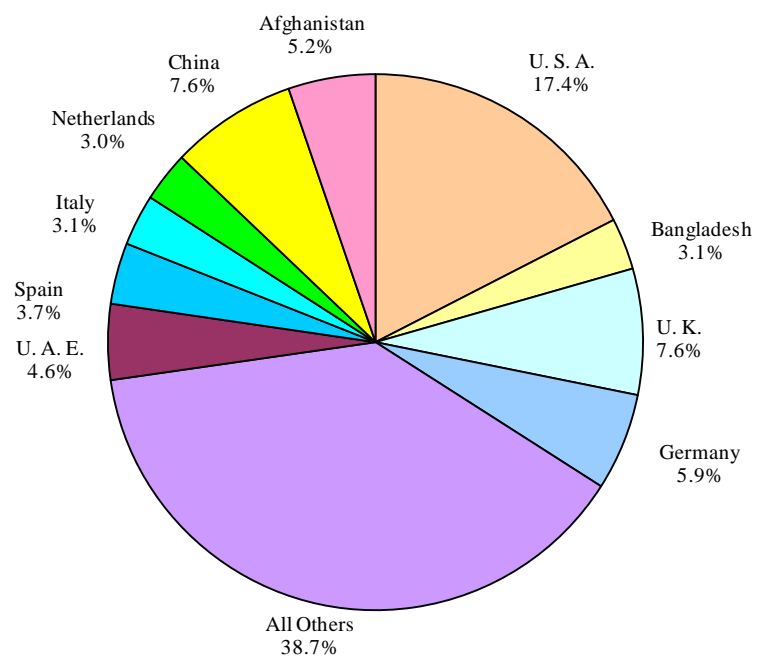
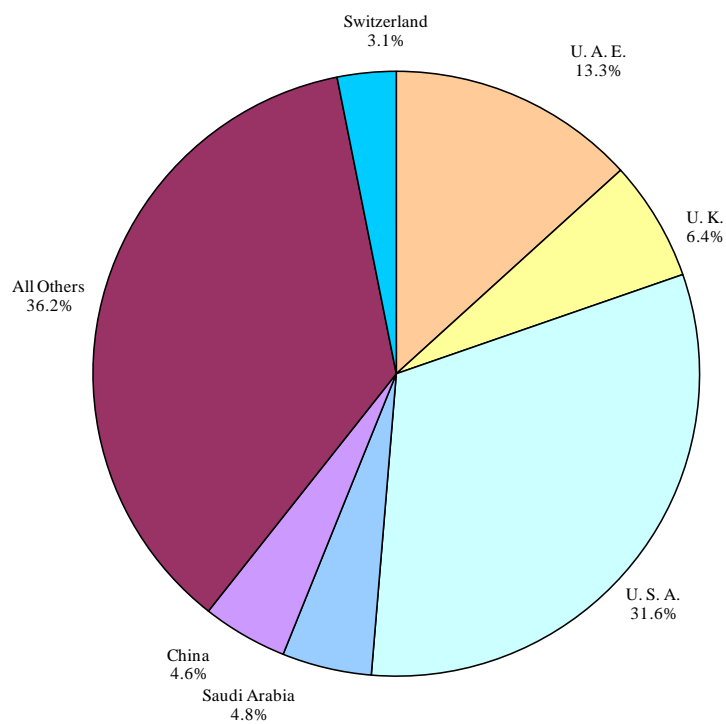

Figure 6: Annual Export of Goods & Services from FY08 to FY16

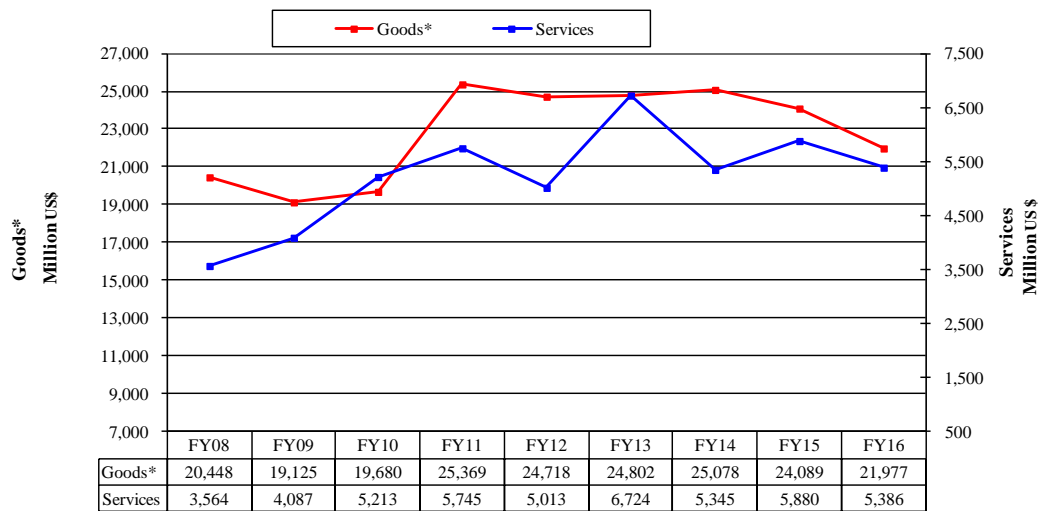
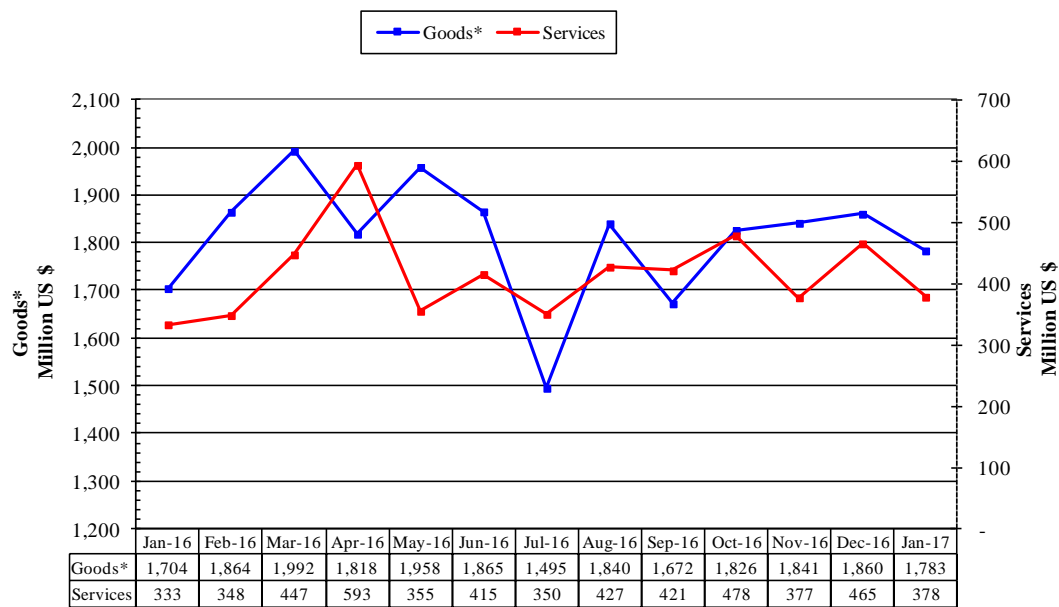


Figure7: Monthly Export of Goods & Services
