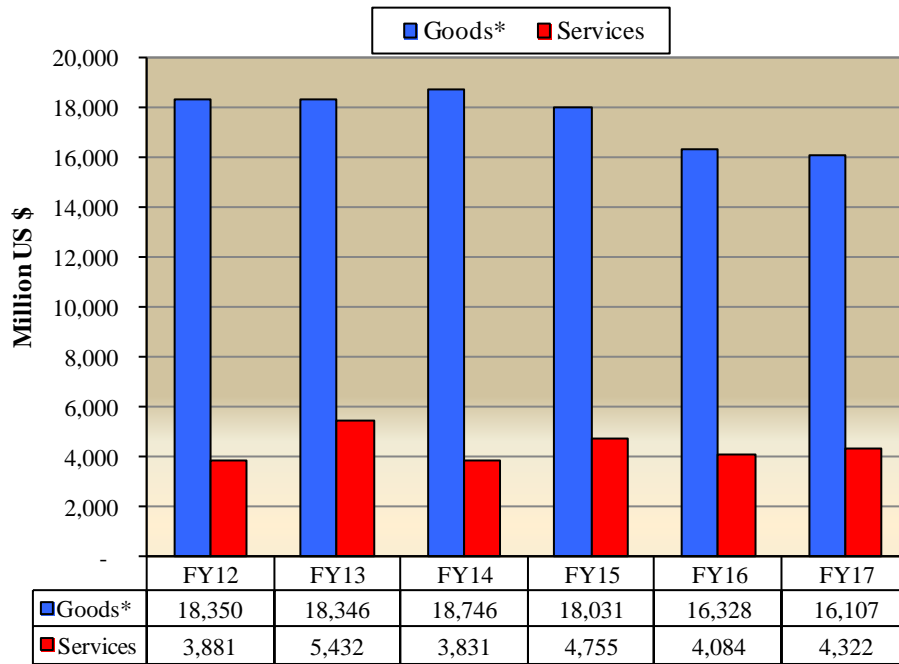
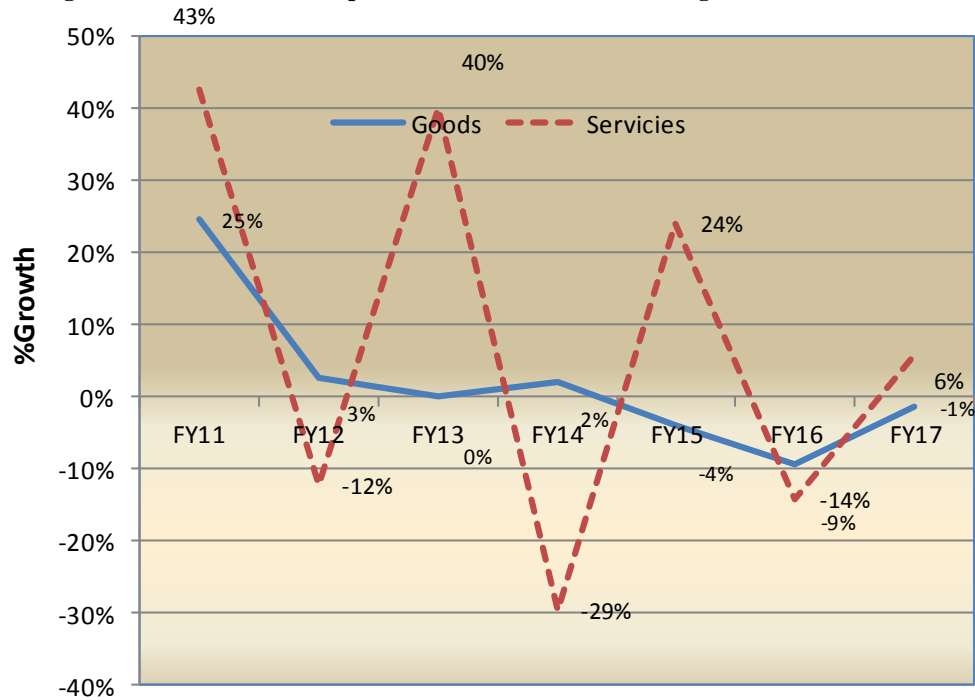

**Figure 1. Export of Goods and Services during Jul-Mar****Figure 2. YOY Growth in Export of Goods and Services during Jul-Mar**

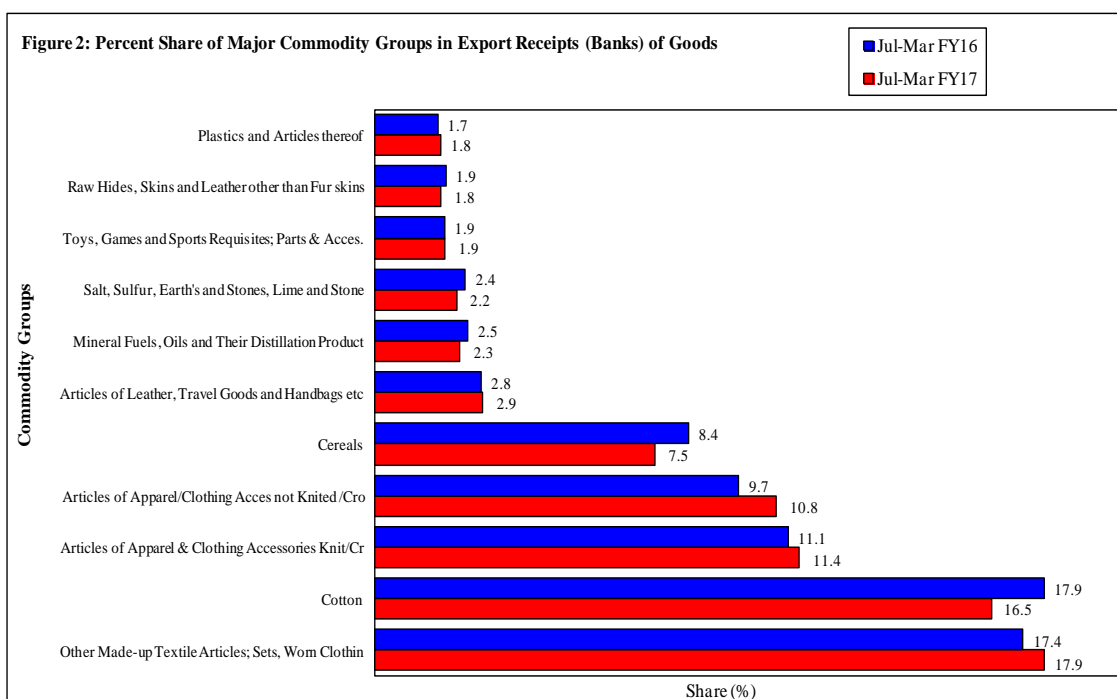
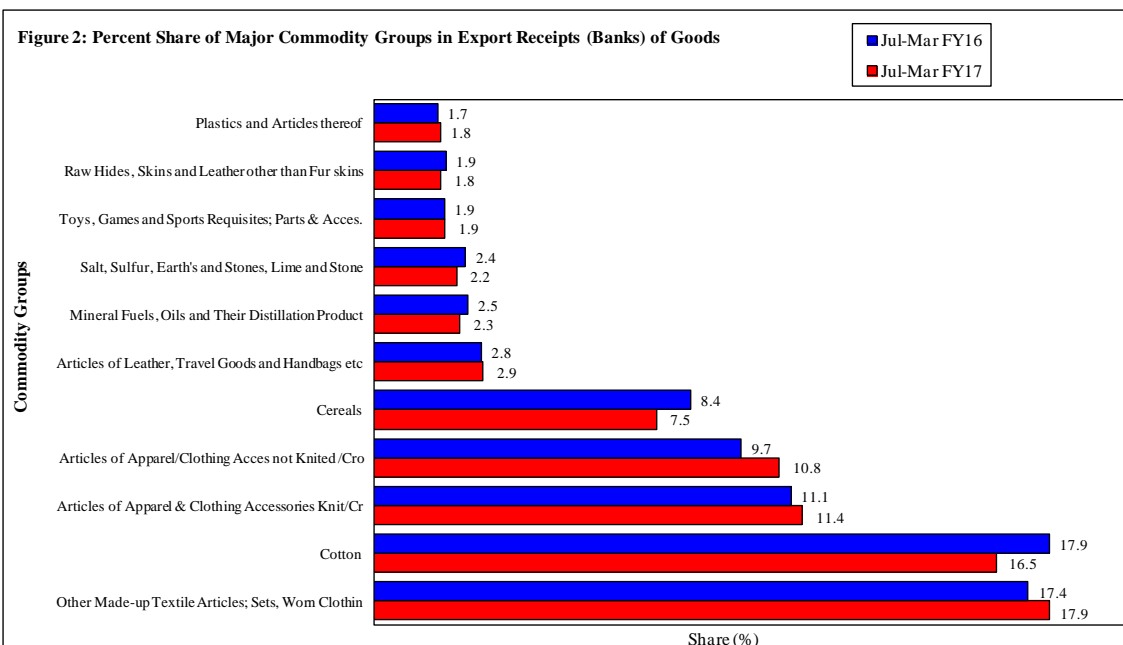

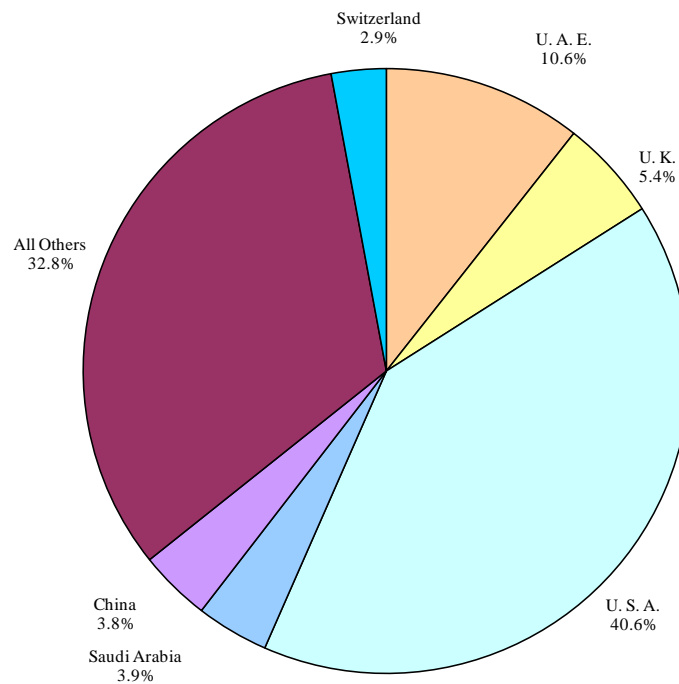
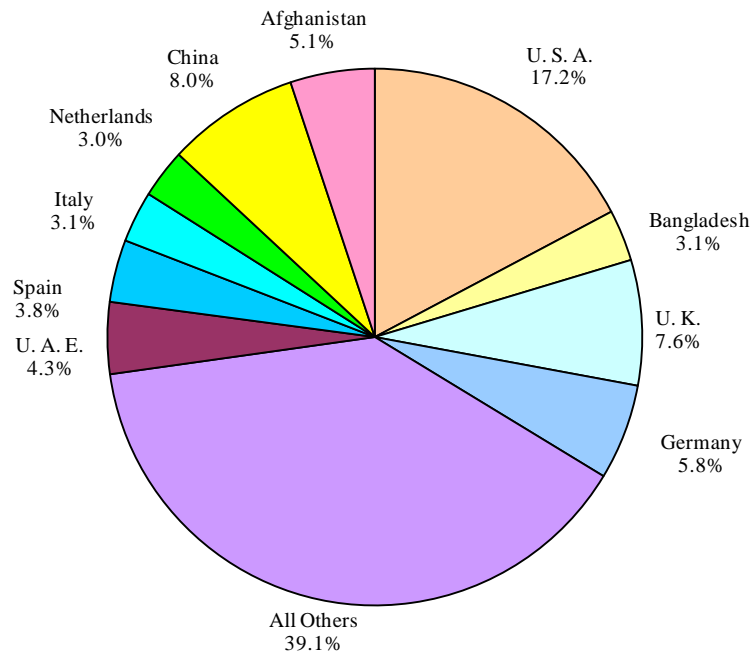

Figure 6: Annual Export of Goods &amp; Services from FY08 to FY16

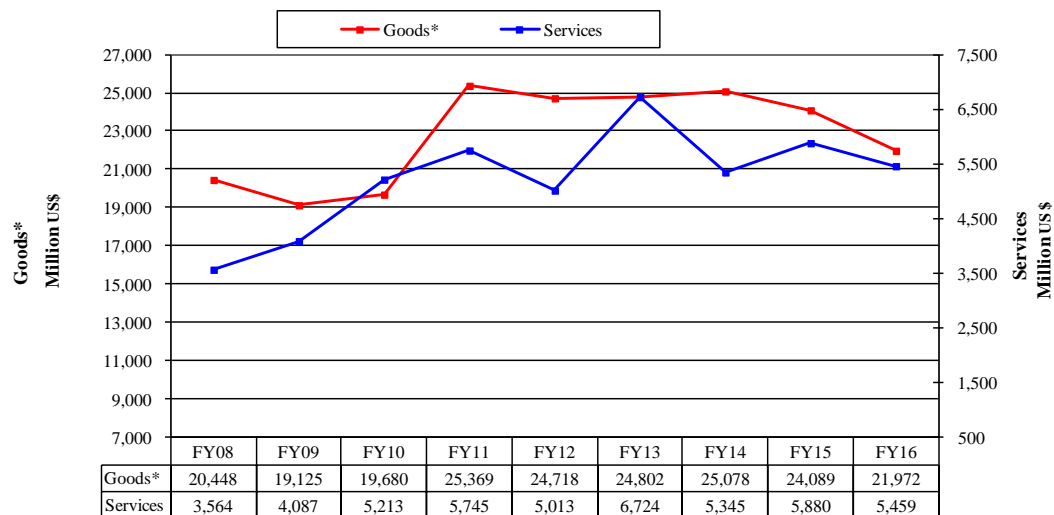
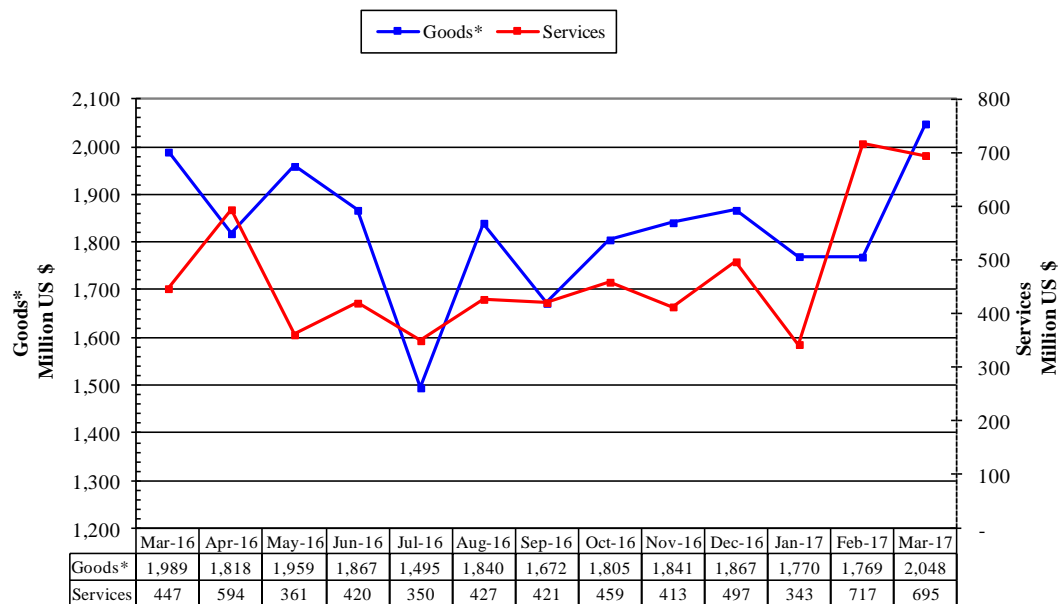


Figure7: Monthly Export of Goods &amp; Services
