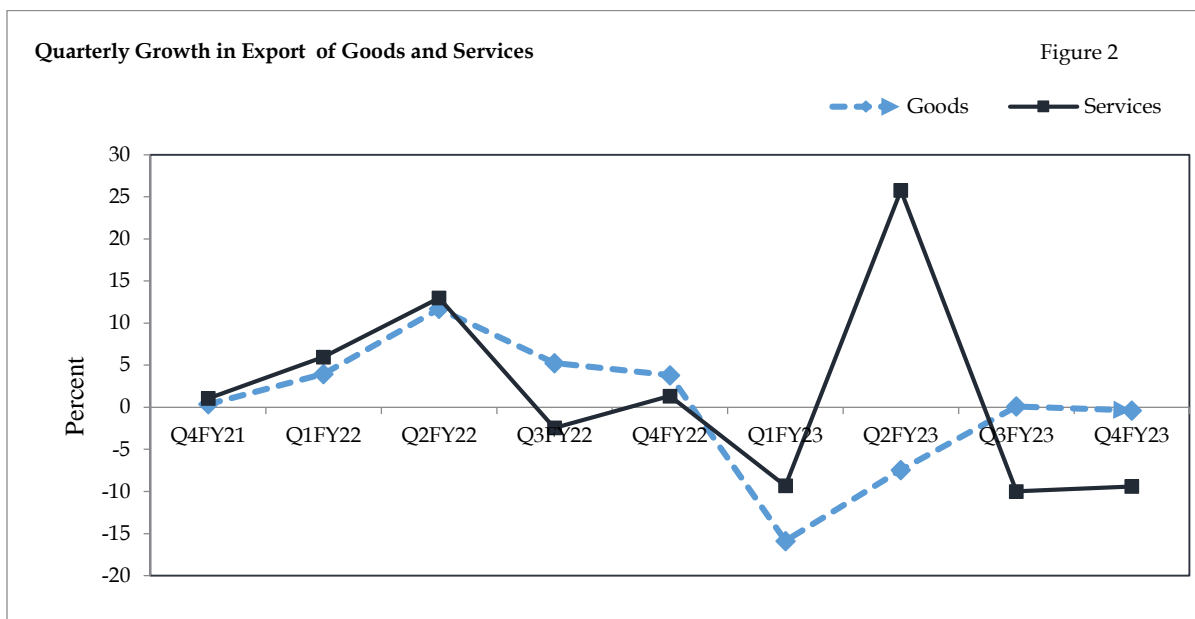
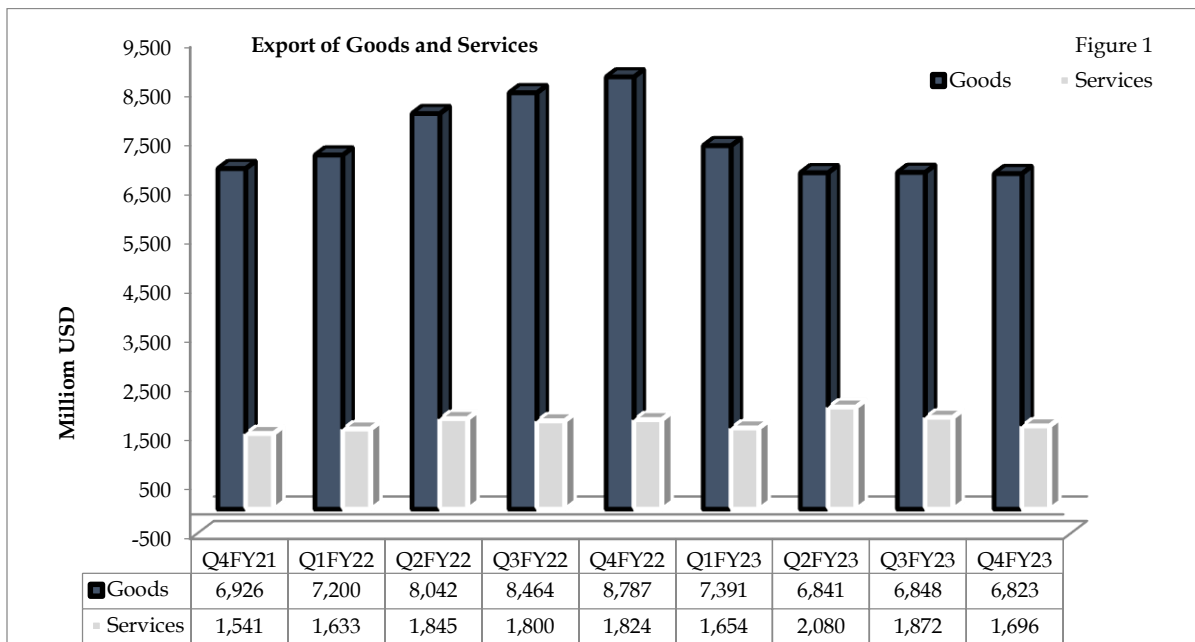

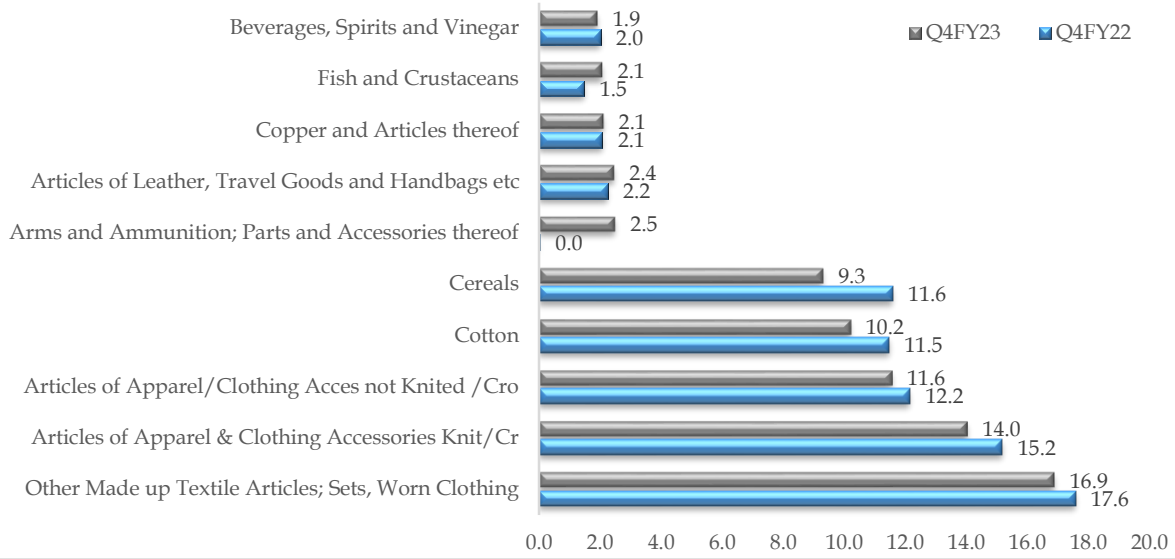


Export Receipts by Major Groups of Goods and Services
(Amount in Million)

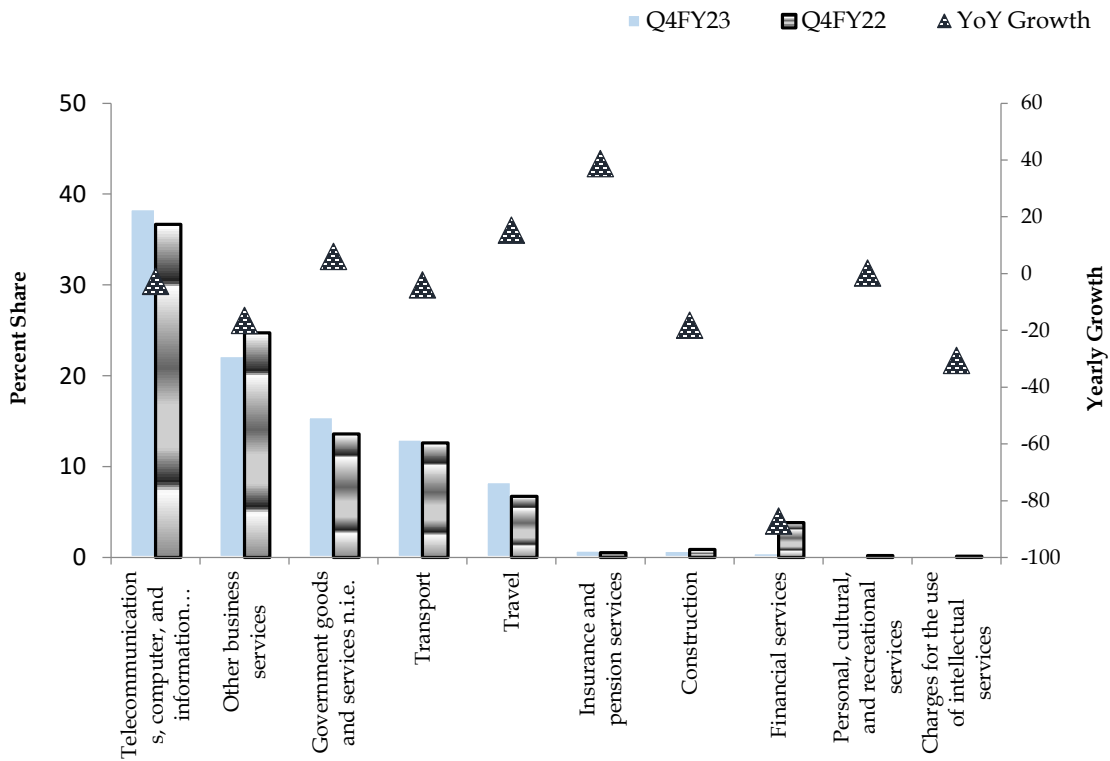

Export of Services (By Type) **Figure 4**

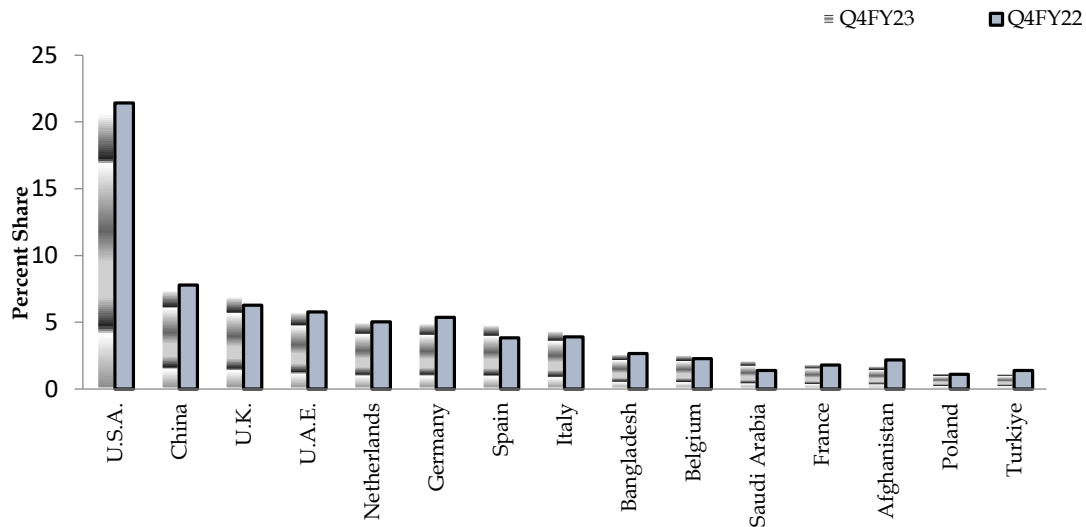

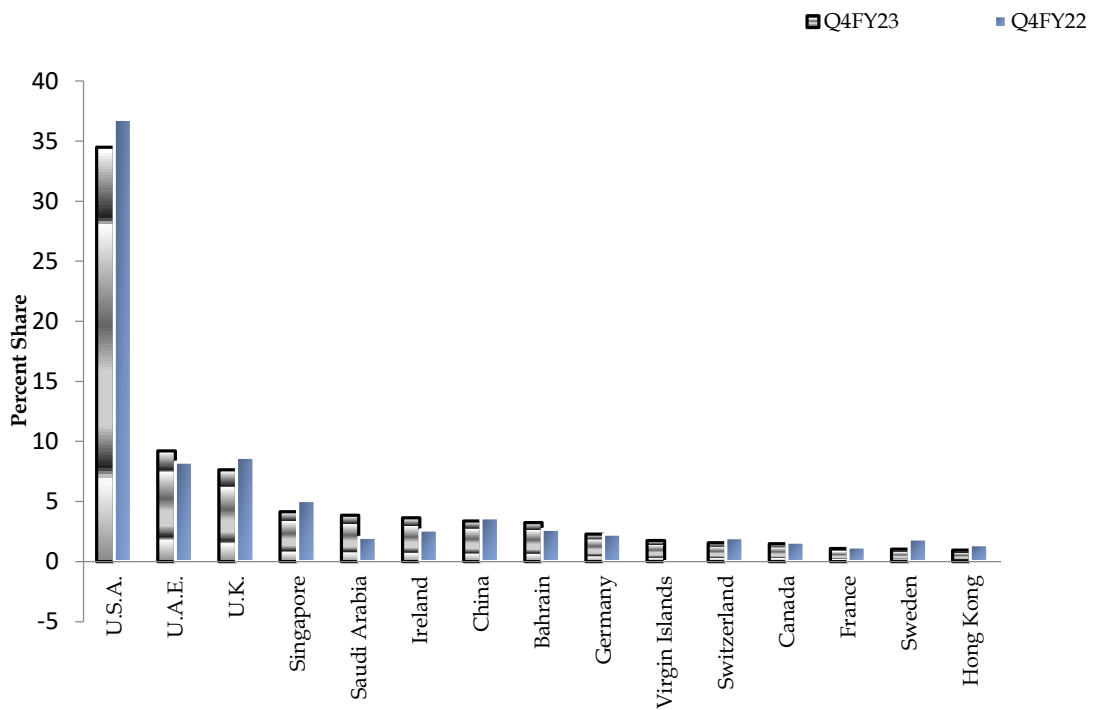

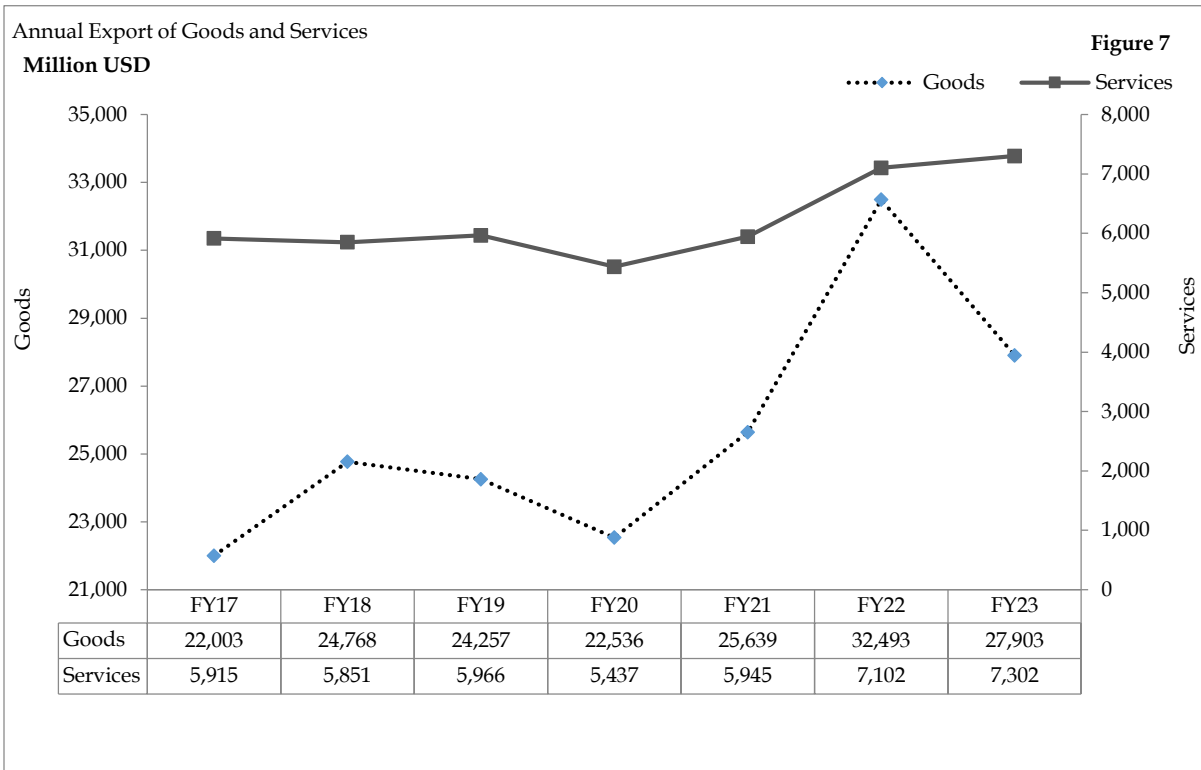
