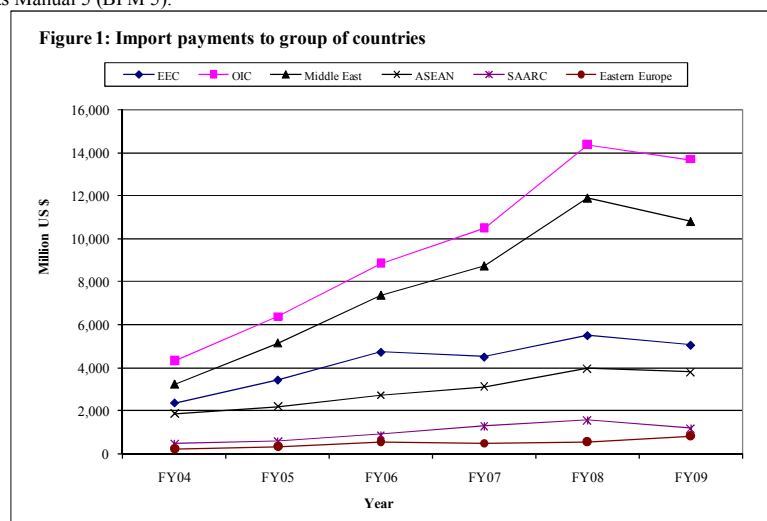

Figure 2: % Share of major commodities in import payments

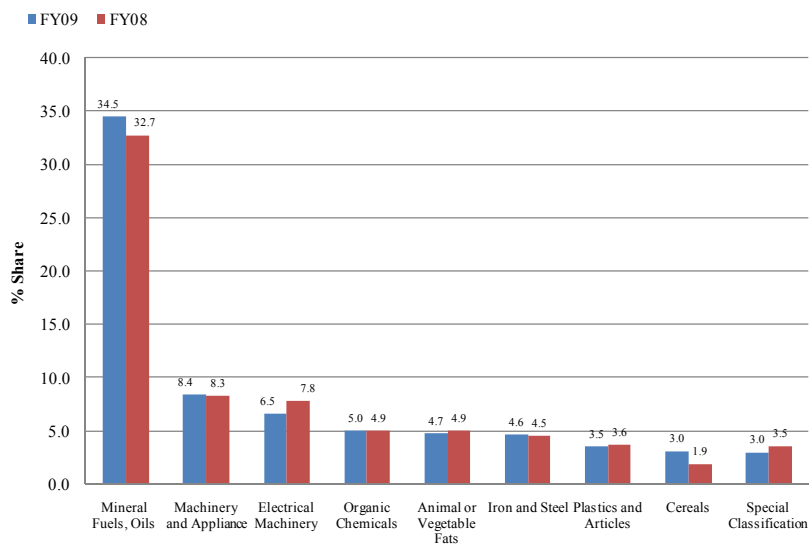

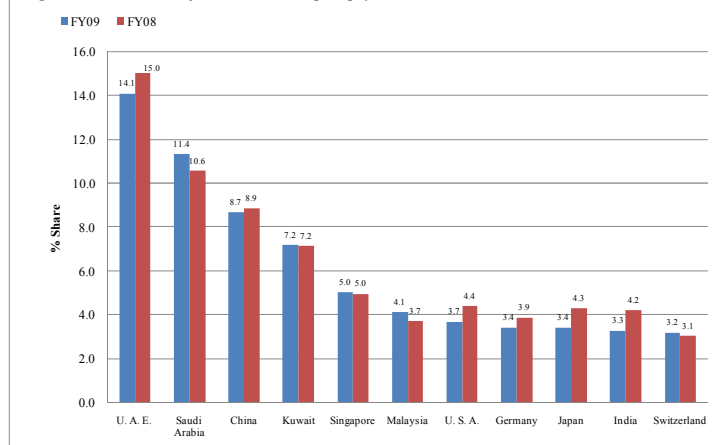
Figure 3: % Share of major countries in import payments

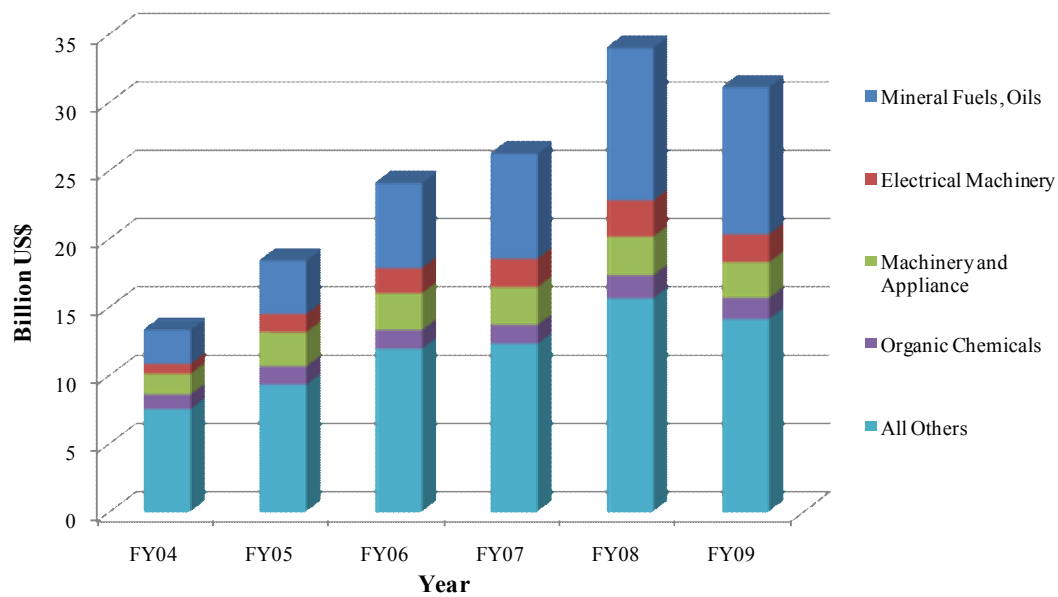
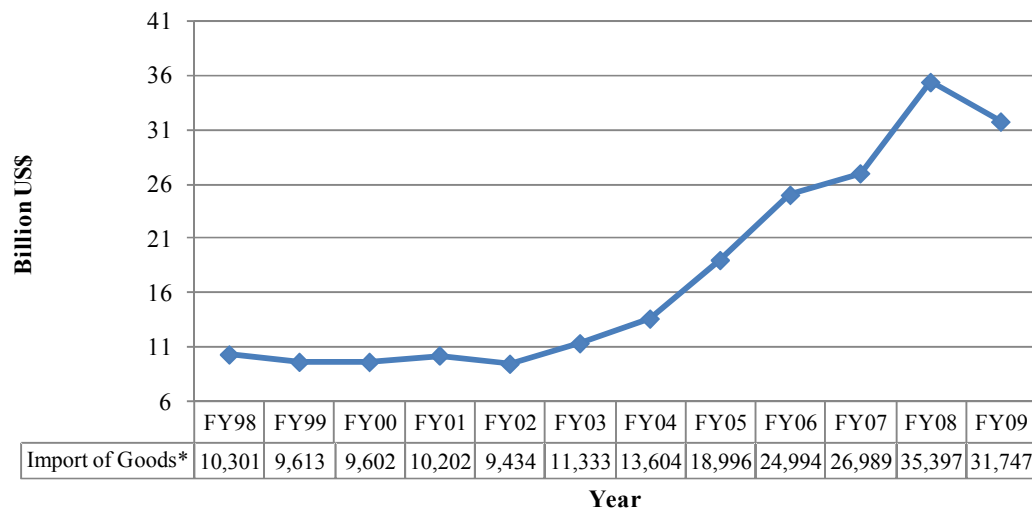
