Figure 1: Import payments to group of countries

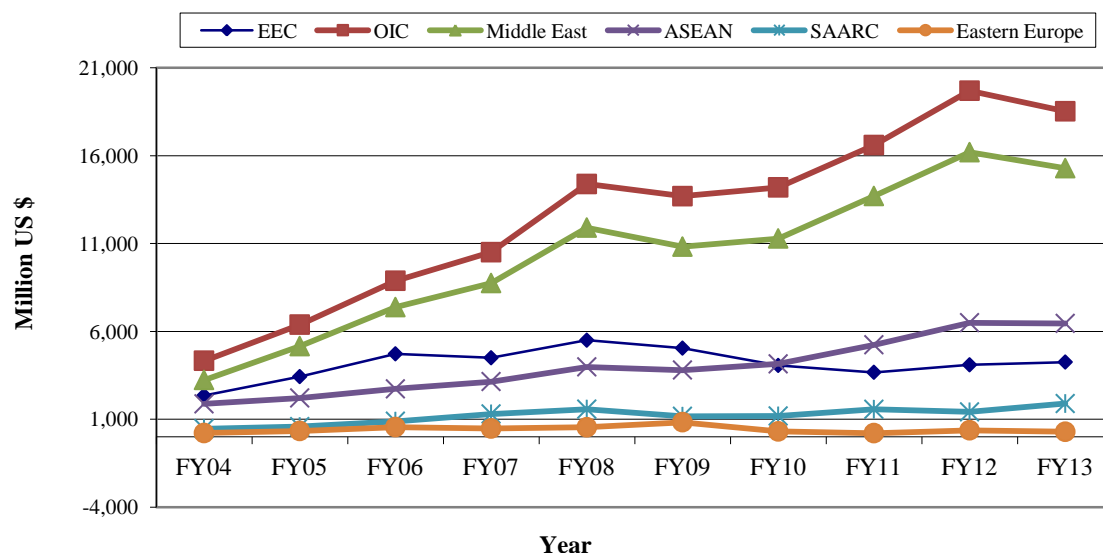

Figure2: % share of major commodities in import payments

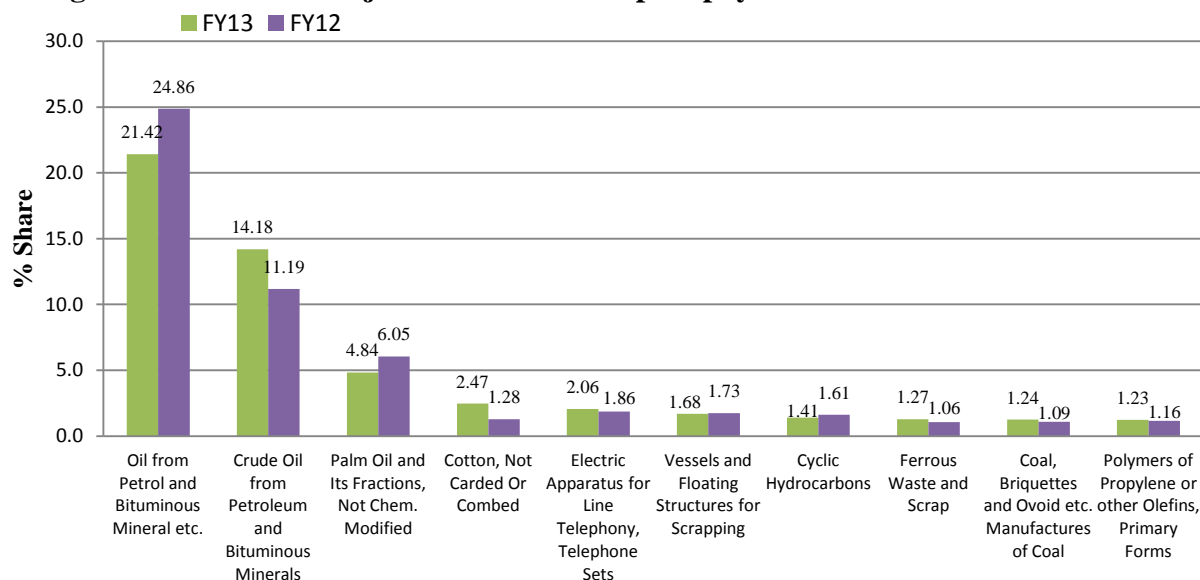

Figure 3: % Share of major Countries in import payments

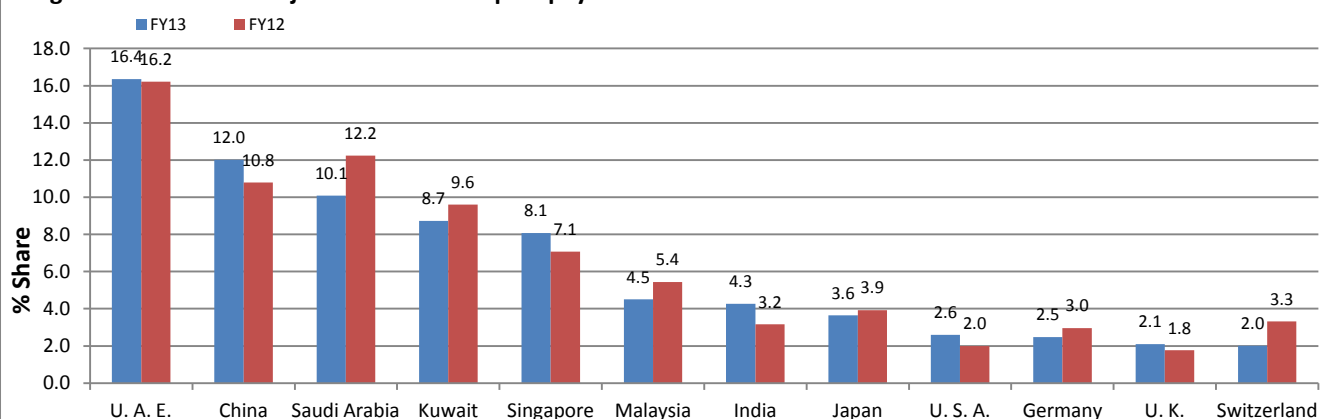

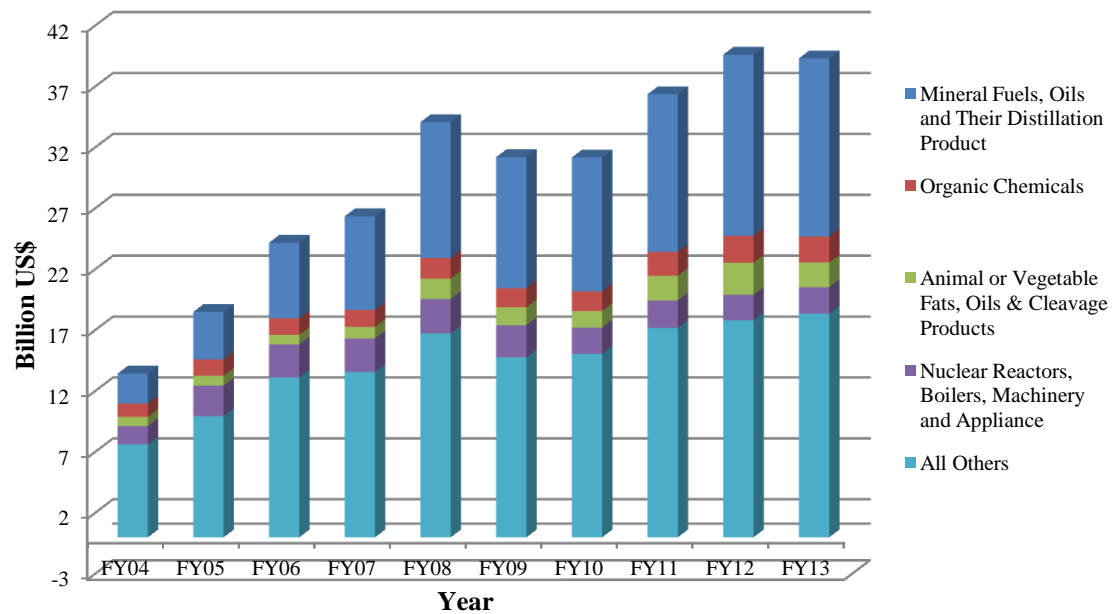

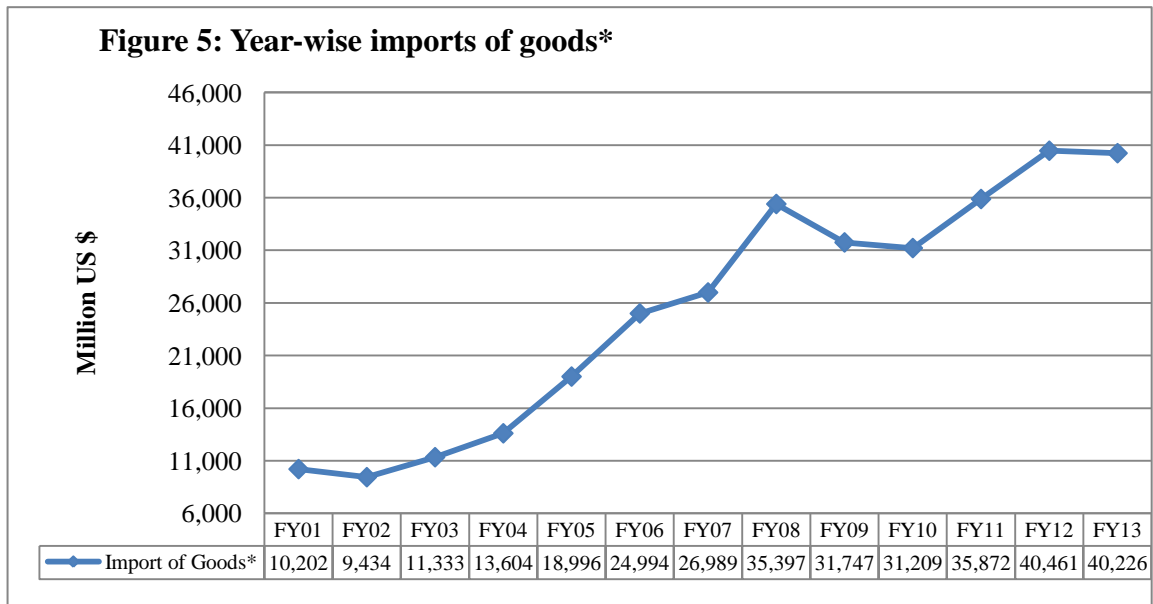
Figure 5: Year-wise imports of goods*
