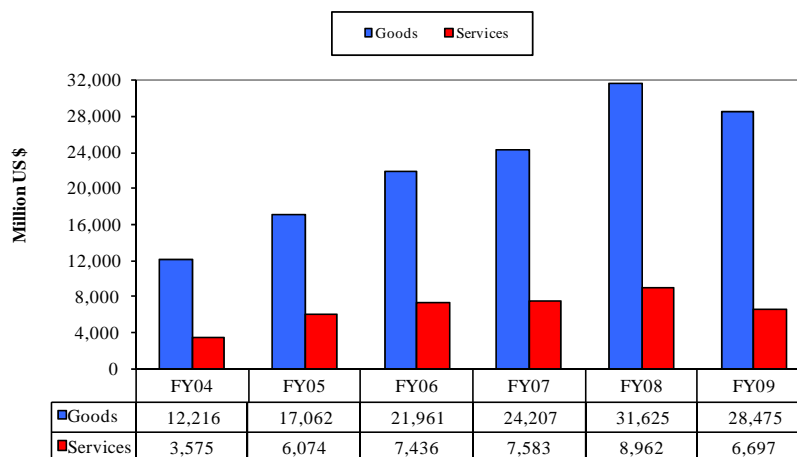
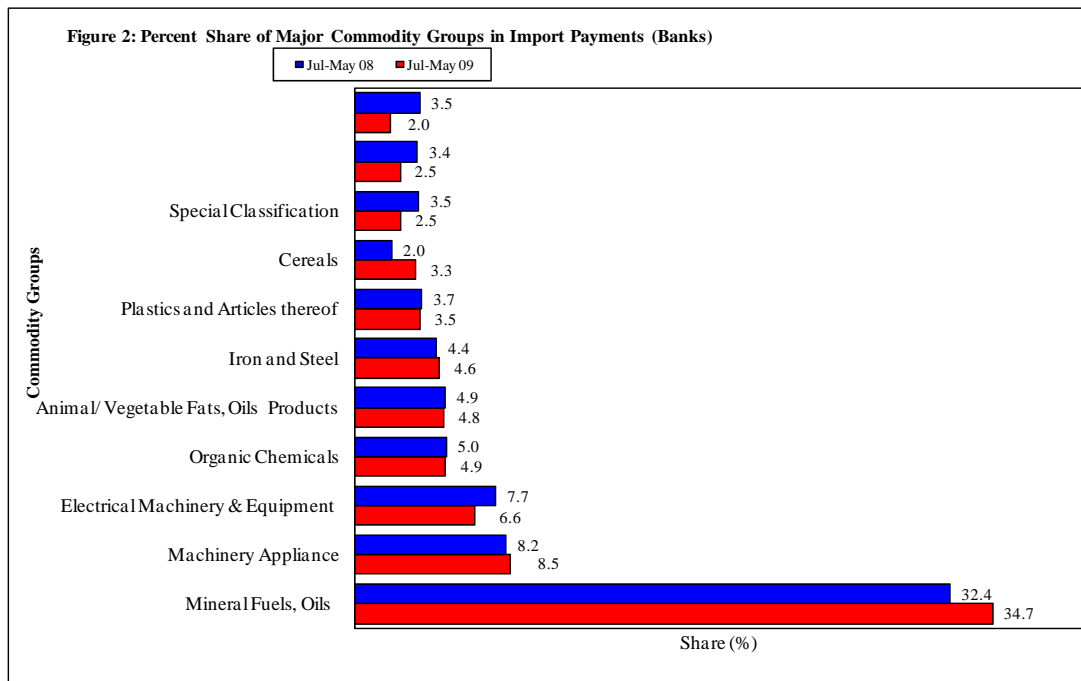
**Figure 1. Import During Jul-May 2009**

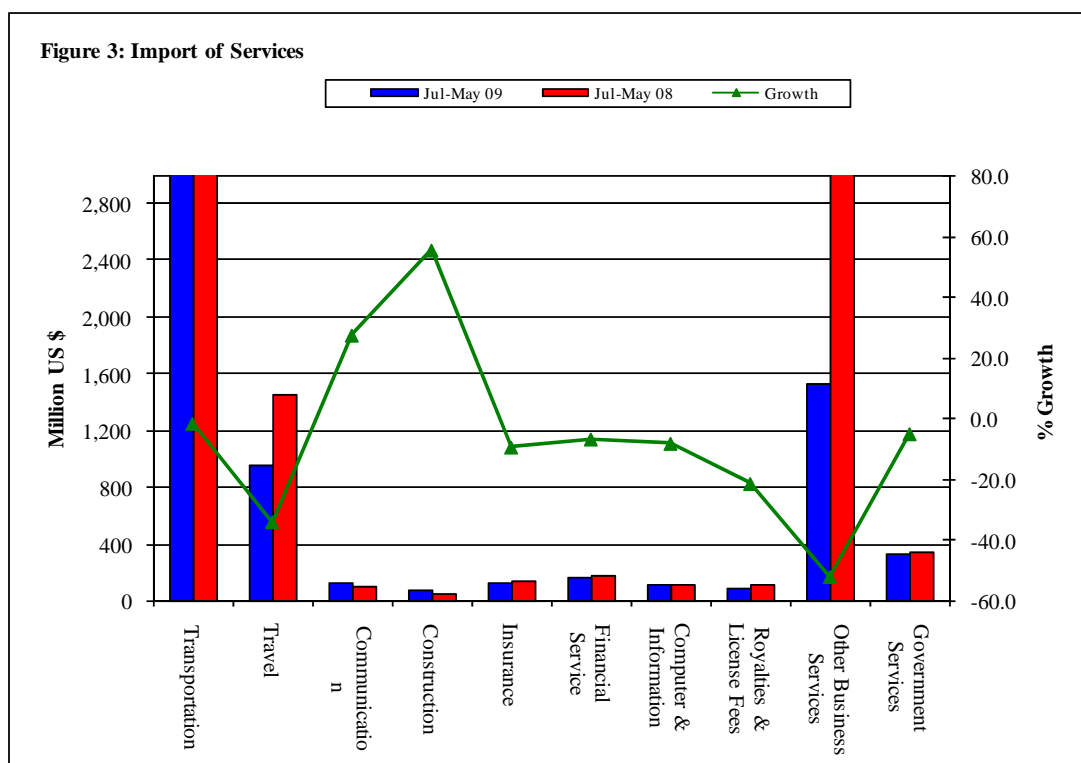
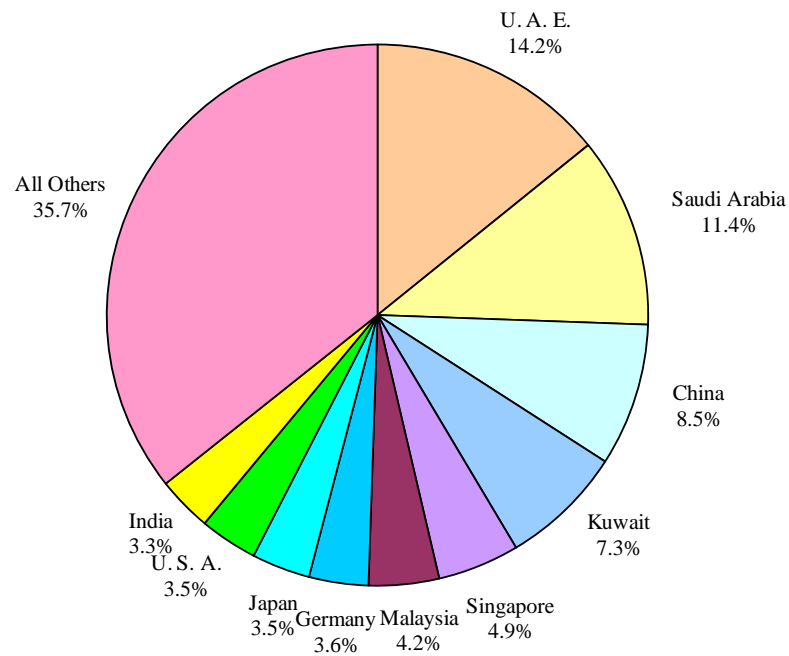

Note: % Share is based on Import Payments through Banks

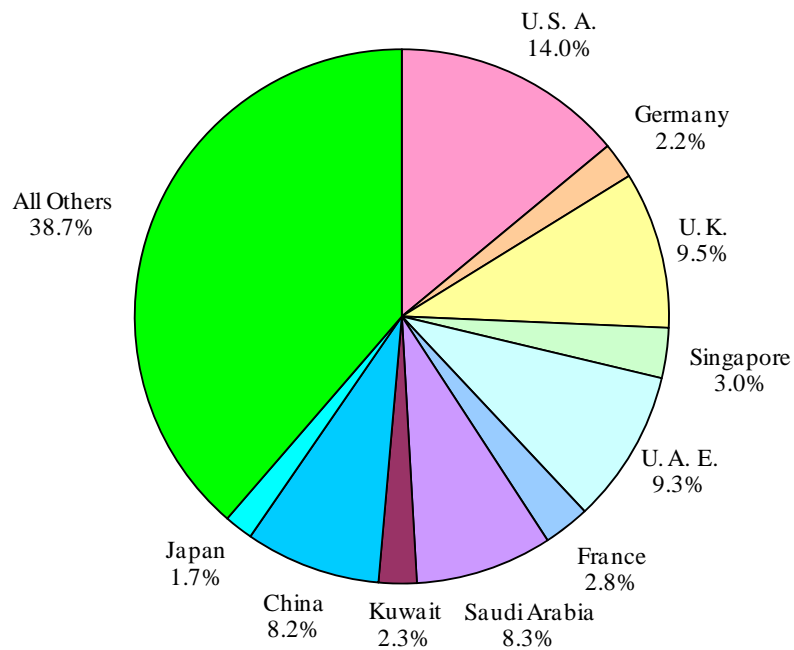
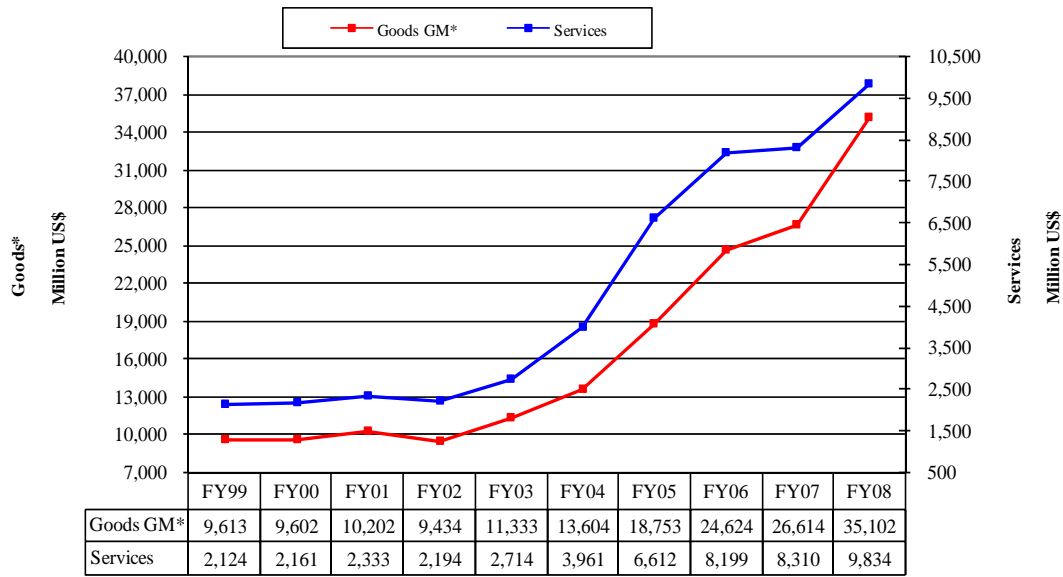
**Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Import of Services During Jul-May 2009**
