

Figure 1. Import During Jul-Feb






Note: % Share is based on Import Payments through Banks


Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Import of Services During Jul-Feb FY10

Figure 6: Annual Import of Goods & Services from FY00 to FY09




Figure 7: Monthly Imports of Goods & Services
