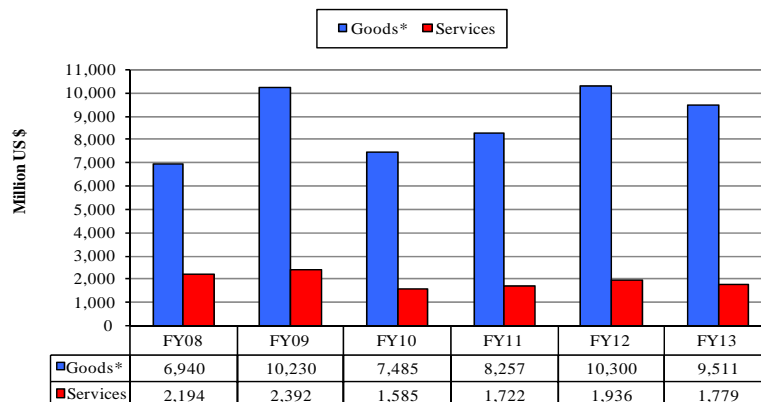

Figure 1. Import During Jul-Sep

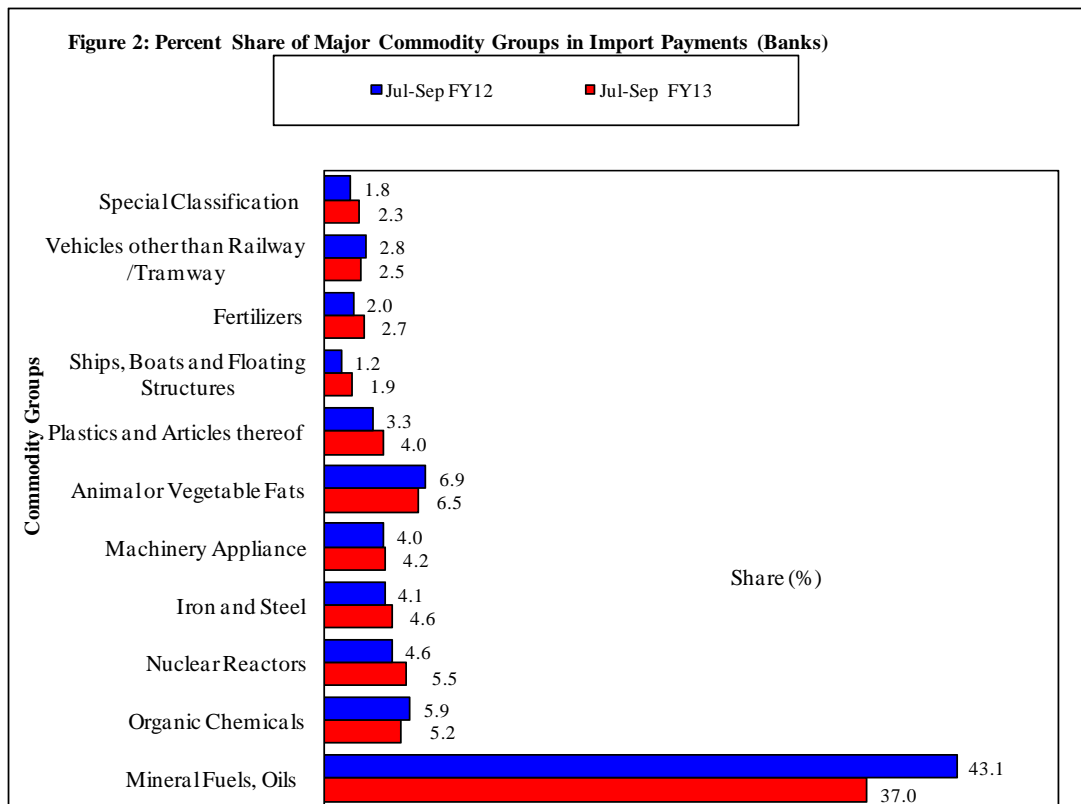

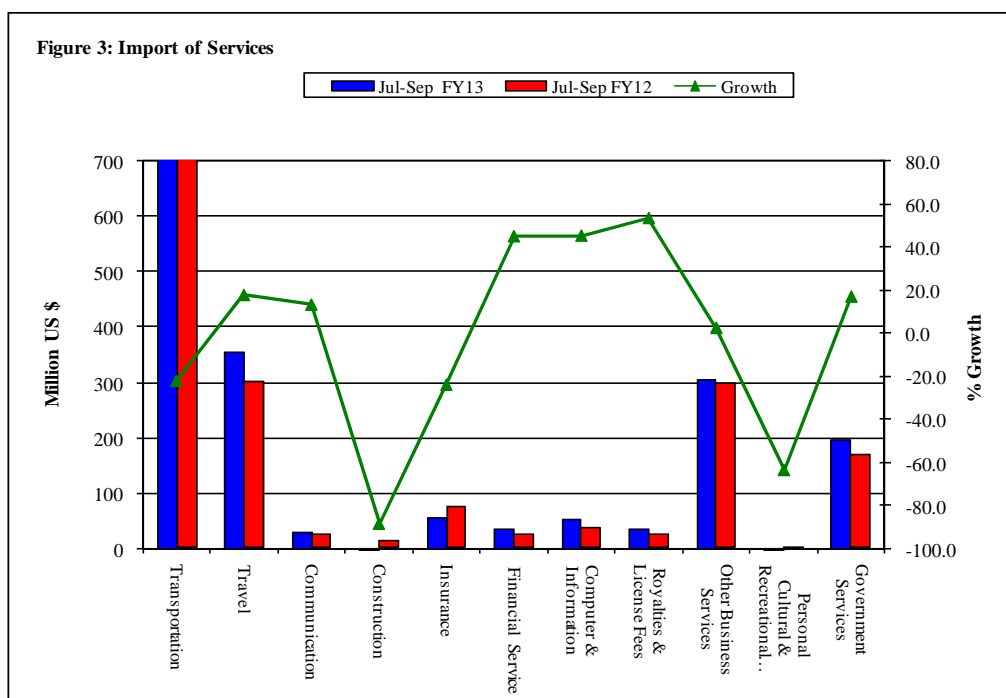
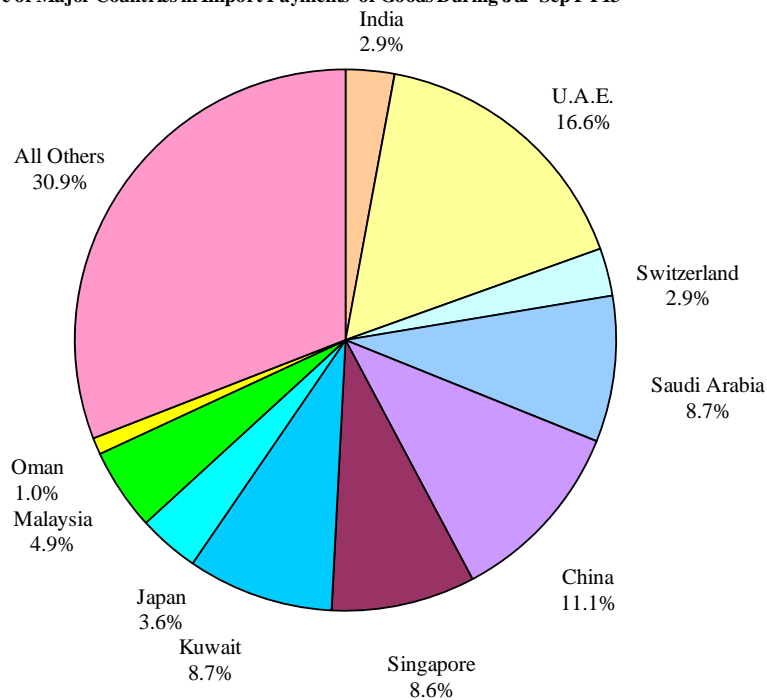
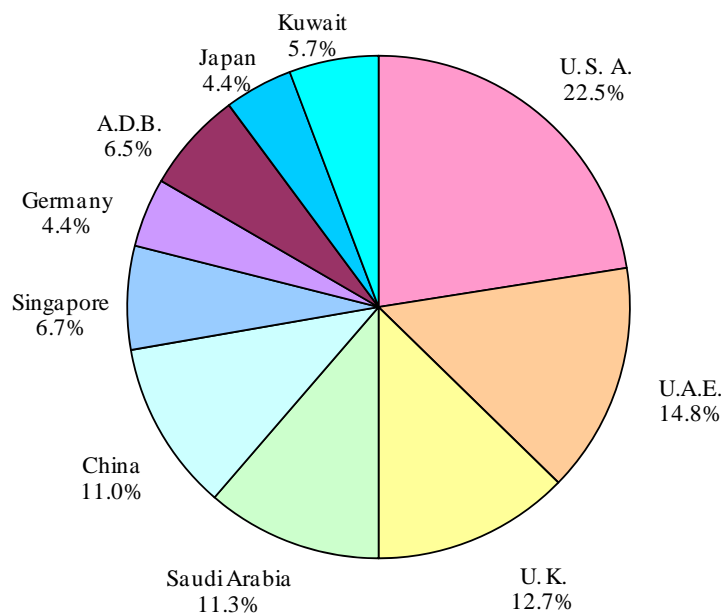


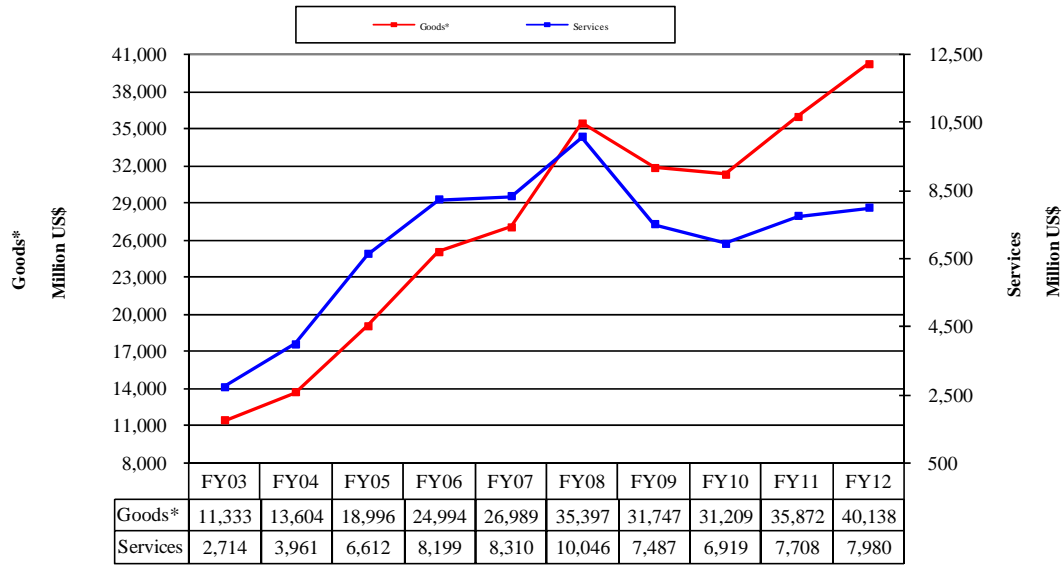
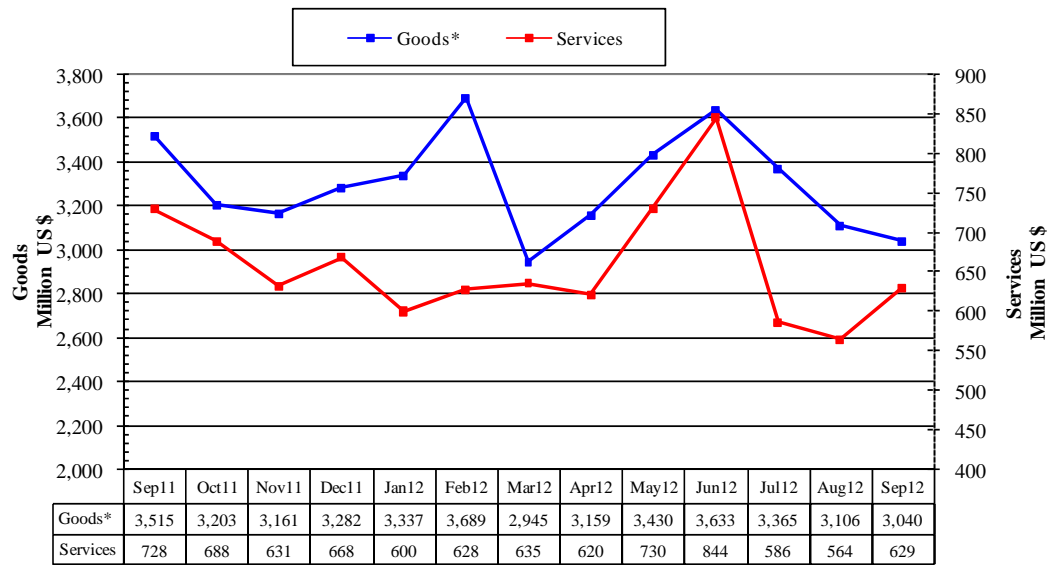
