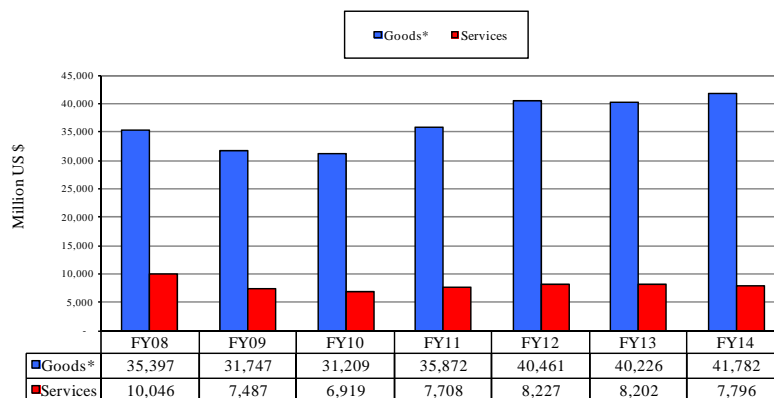

Figure 1. Import During July-Jun



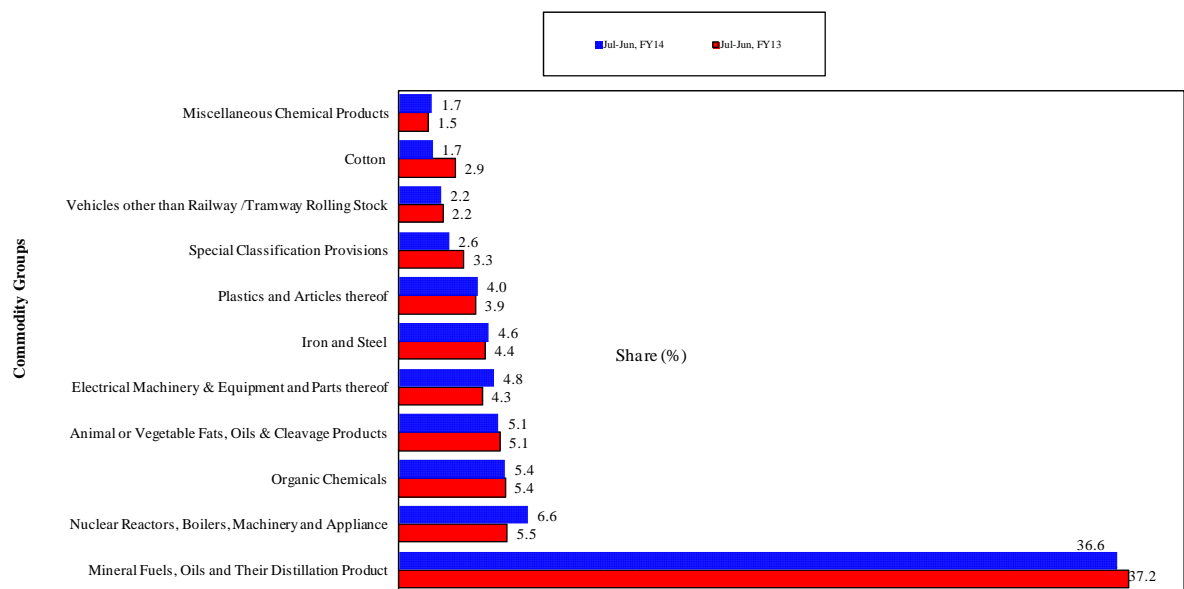

Figure 3: Import of Services

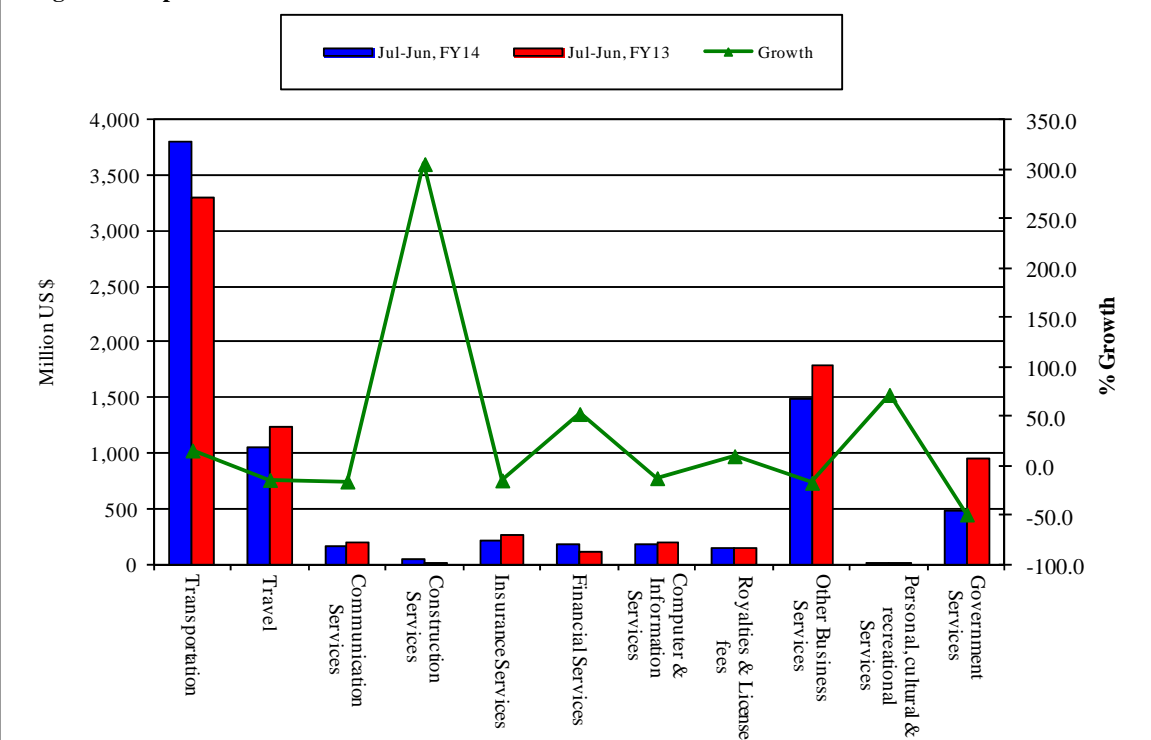

Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Import of Services During July-June FY14

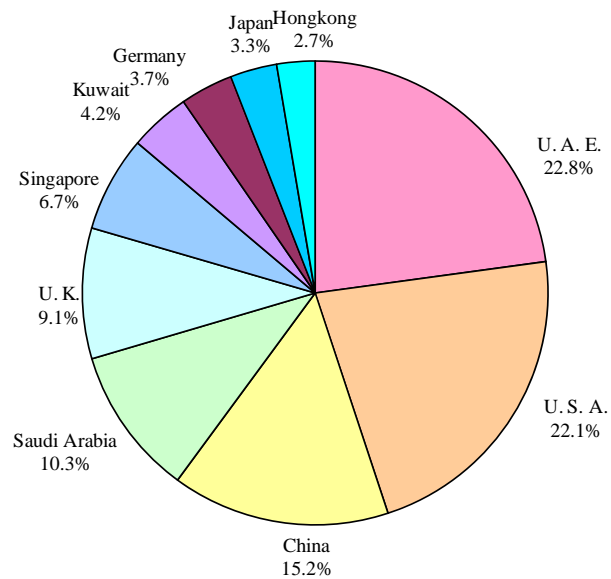
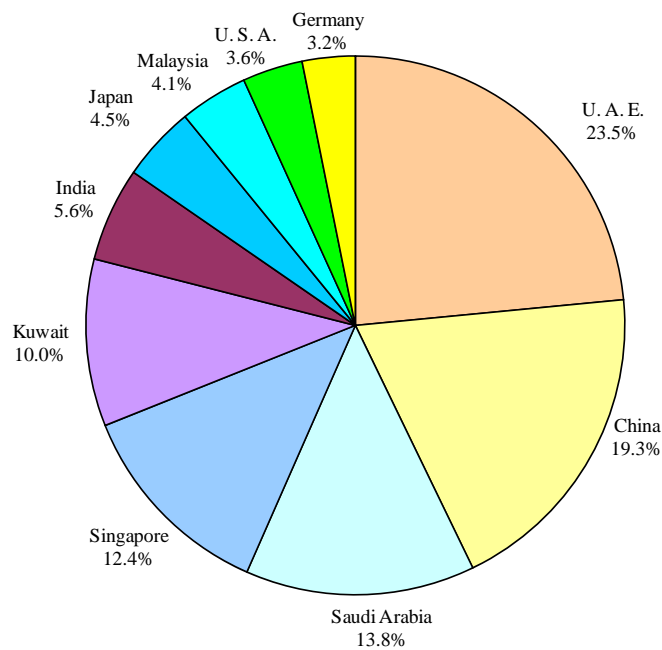


Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Import Payments of Goods During July - June FY14

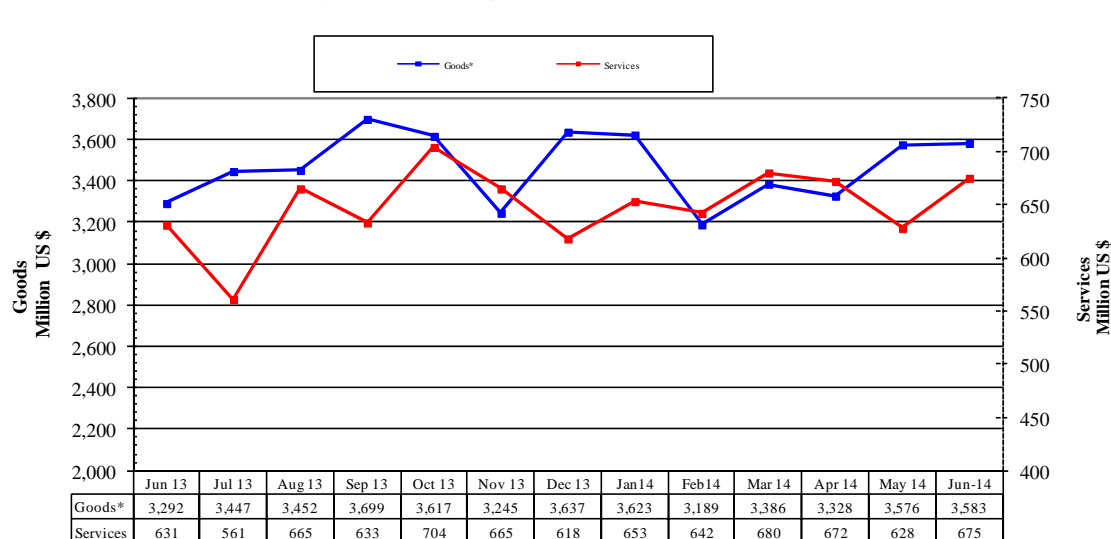
