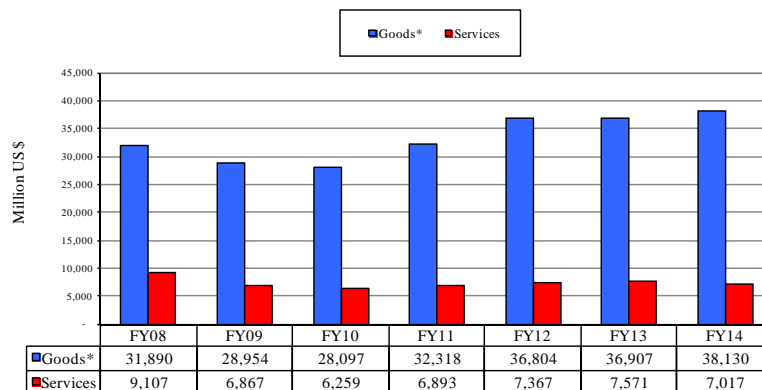

Figure 1. Import During July-May

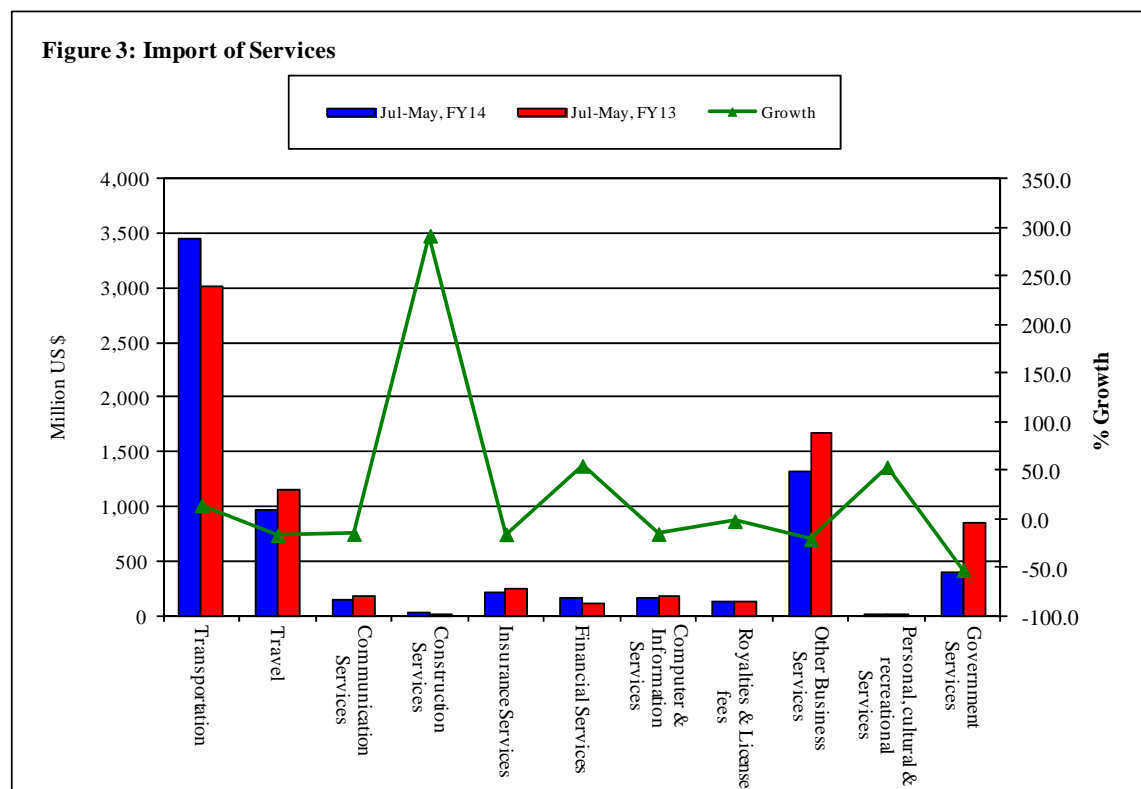
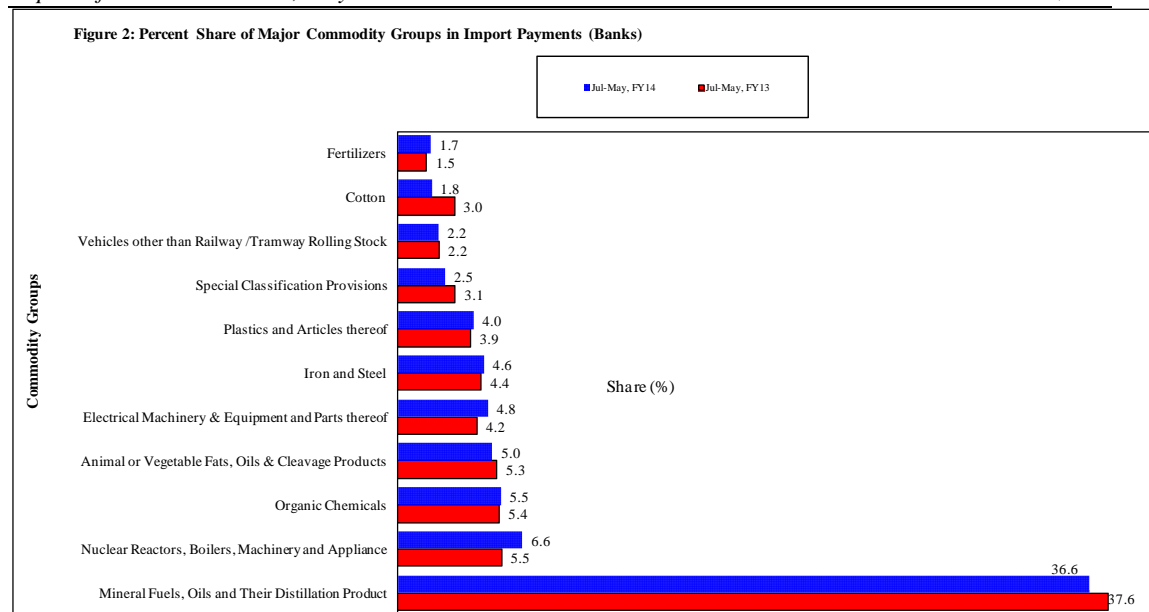

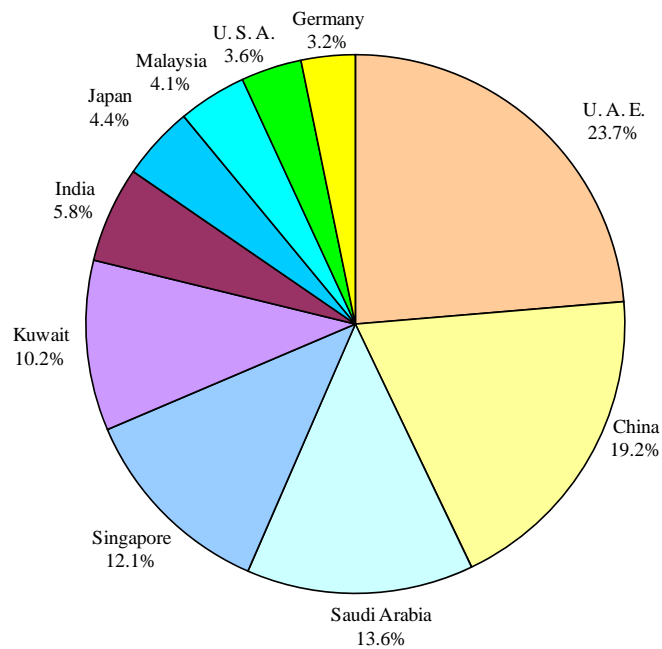
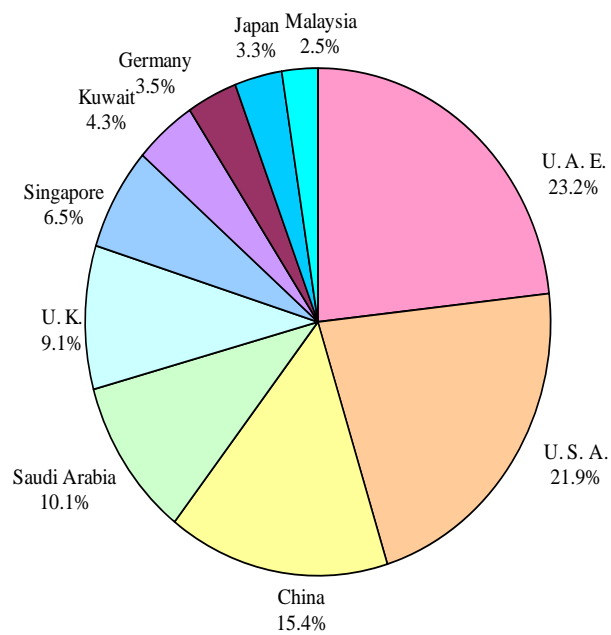

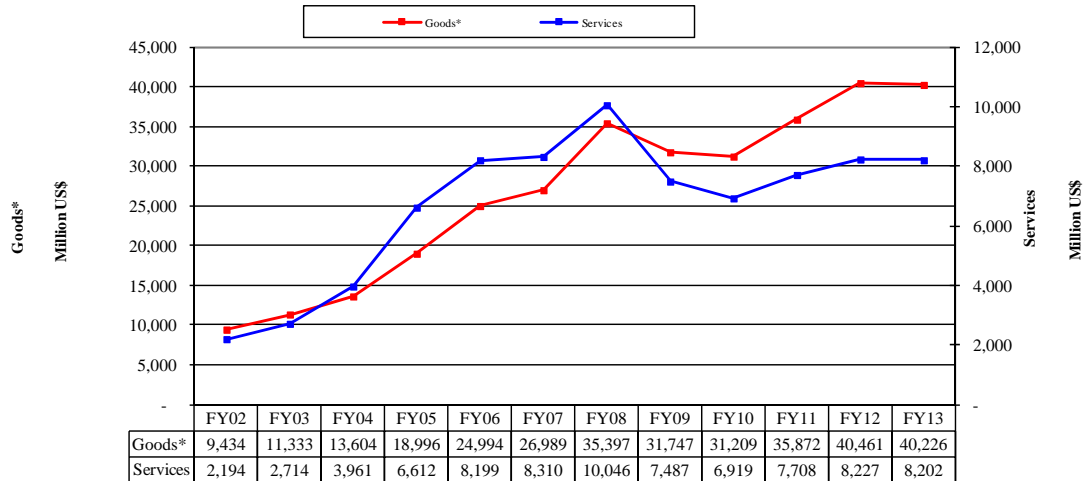
**Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Import Payments of Goods During July - May FY14****Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Import of Services During July-May FY14**
