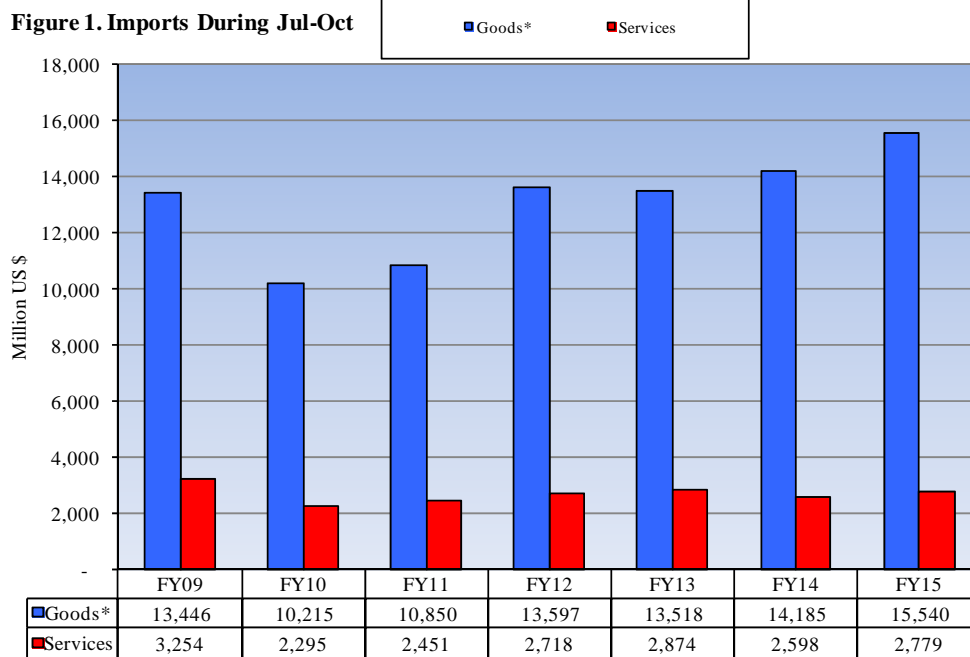
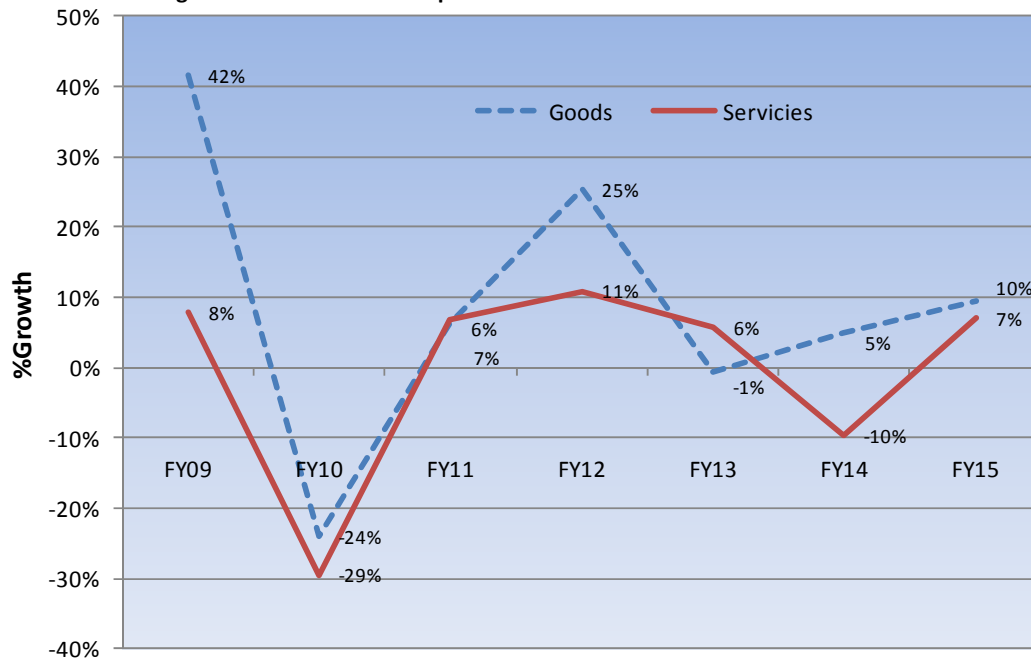
Figure 1. Imports During Jul-Oct**Figure 2: YOY Growth in Imports of Goods & Services**

Figure 3: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Imports Payments (Banks)

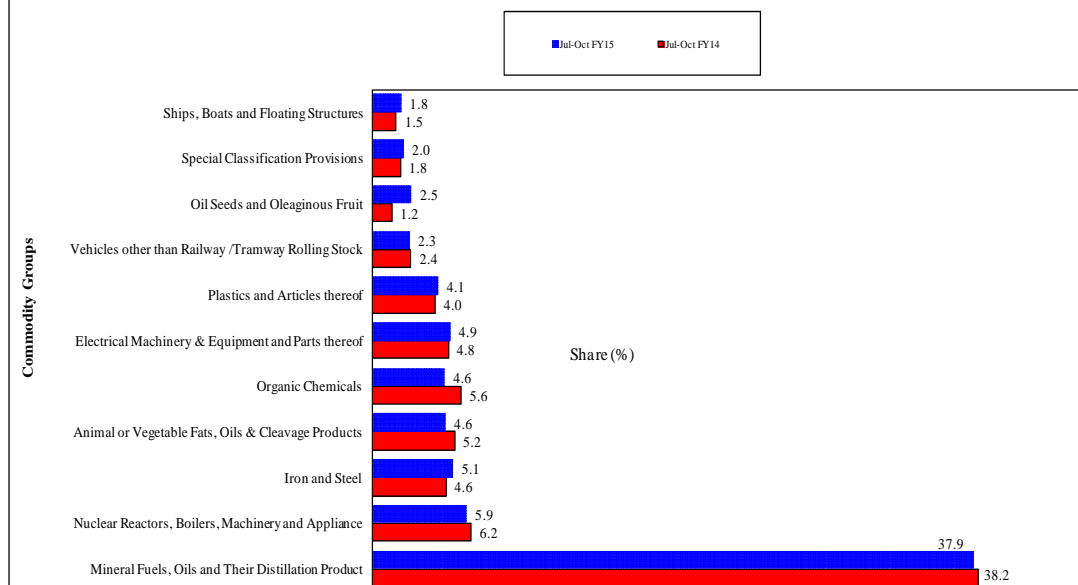
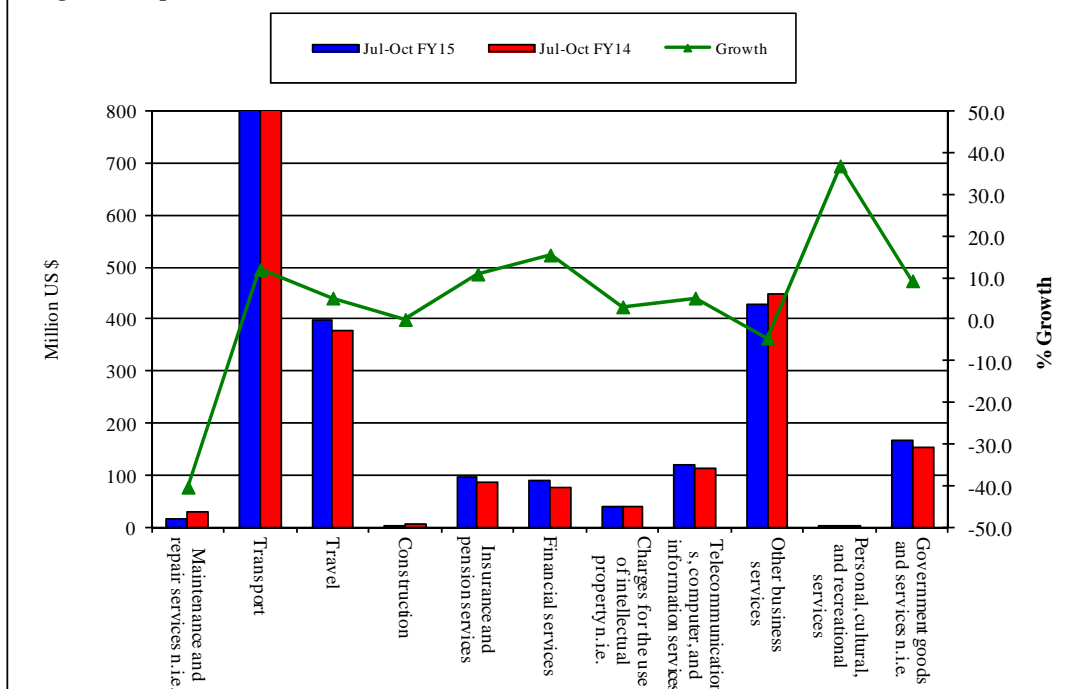


Figure 4: Imports of Services

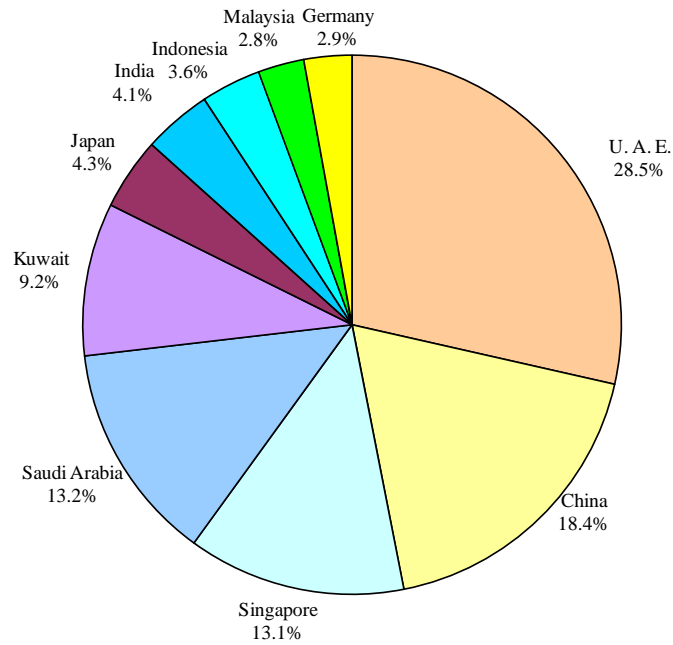
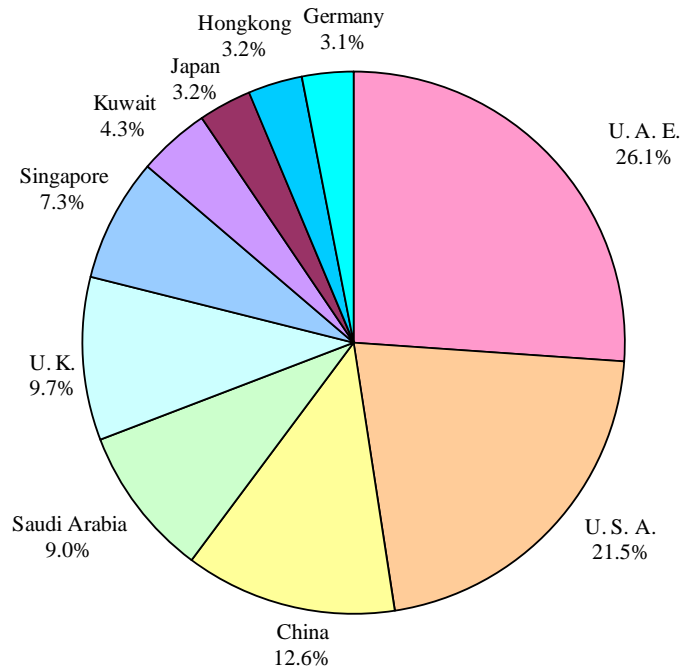

Figure 7: Annual Imports of Goods & Services from FY06 to FY14

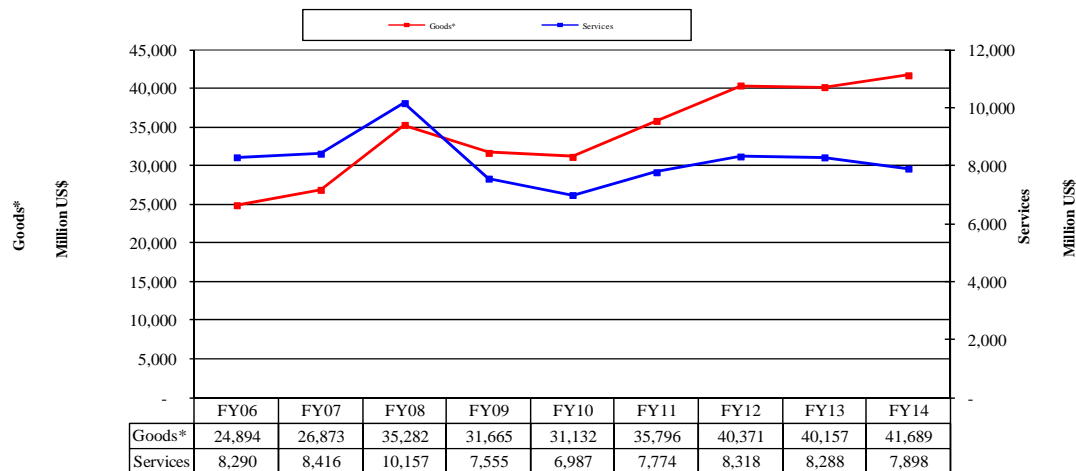
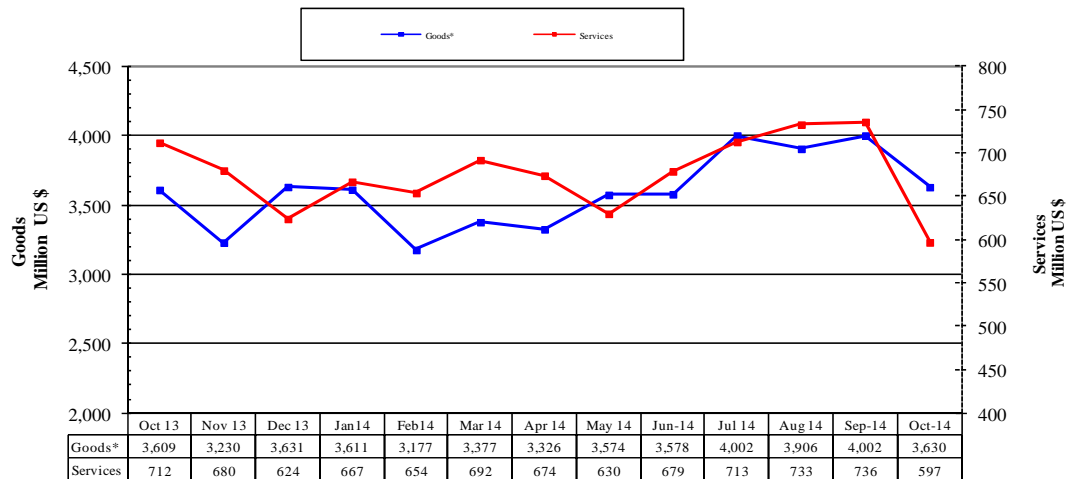


Figure 8: Monthly Imports of Goods & Services
