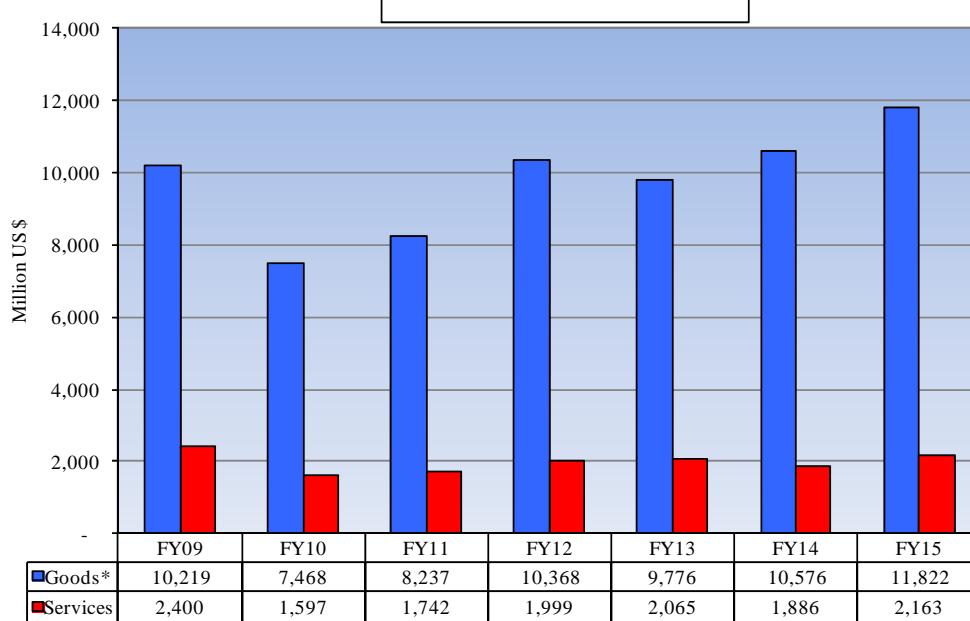
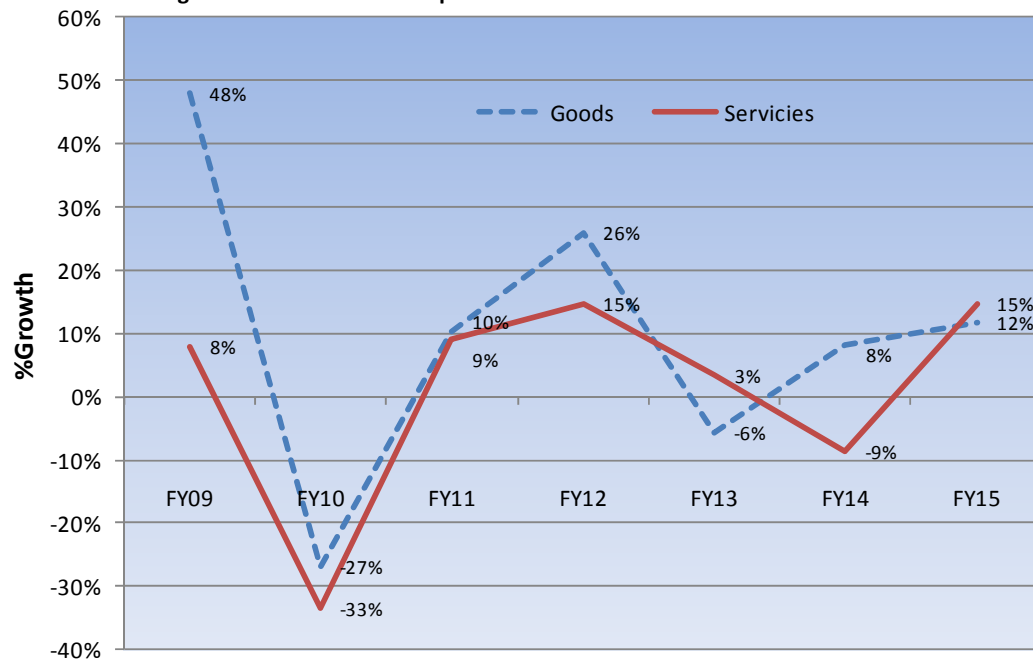
Figure 1. Import During Jul-Sep**Figure 2: YOY Growth in Import of Goods & Services**

Figure 2: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Import Payments (Banks)

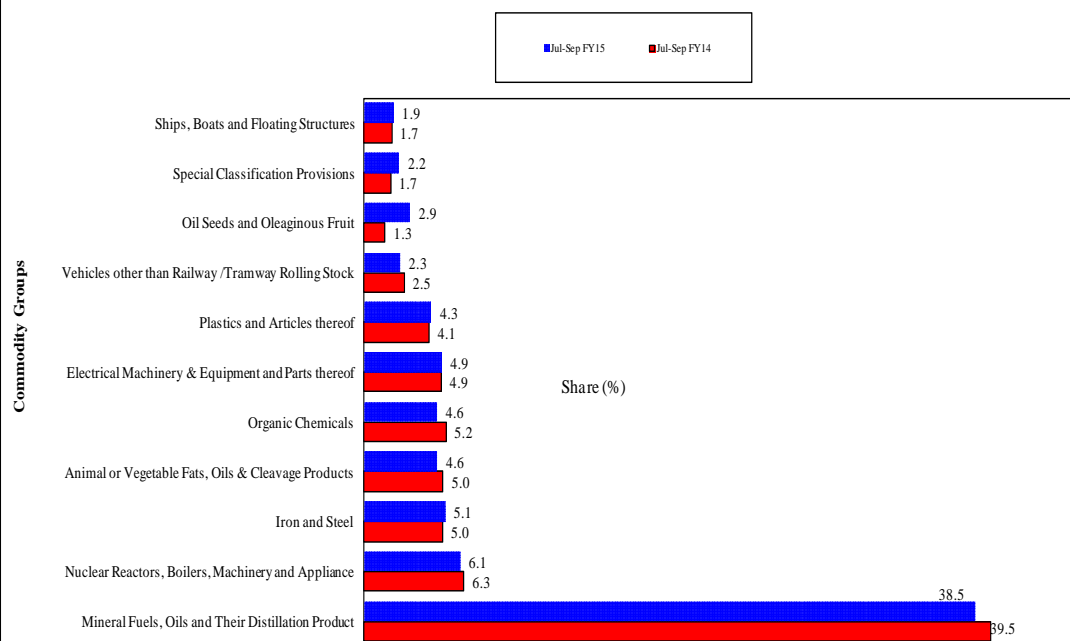
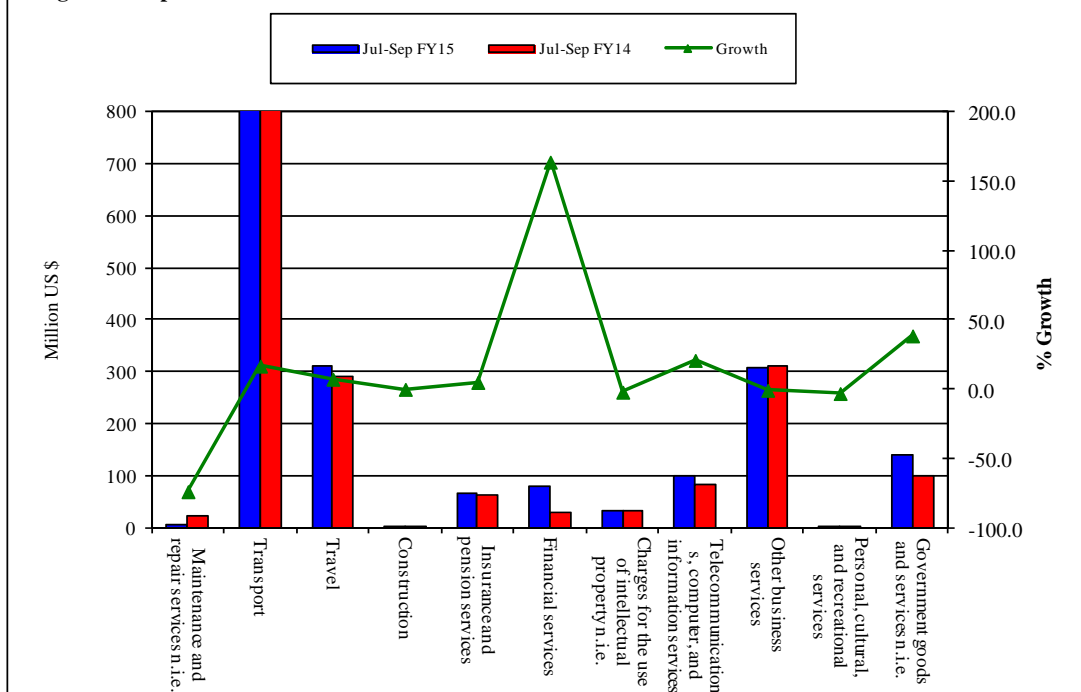


Figure 3: Import of Services

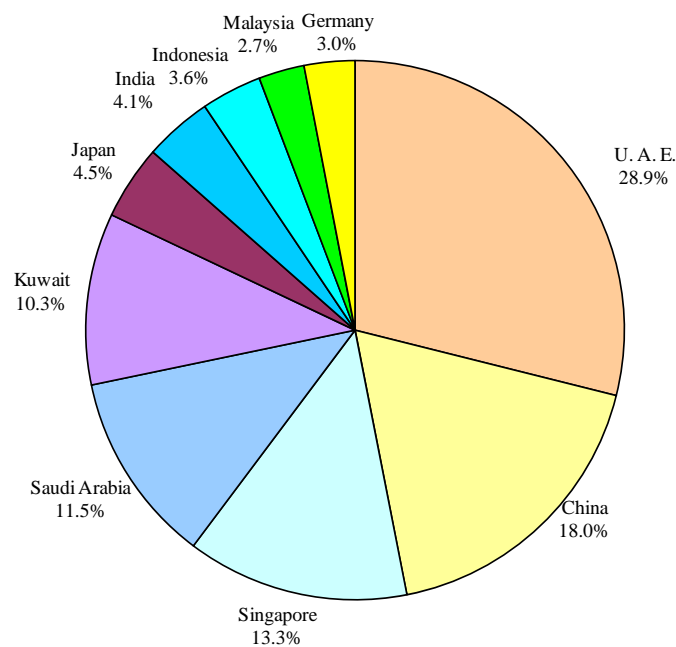
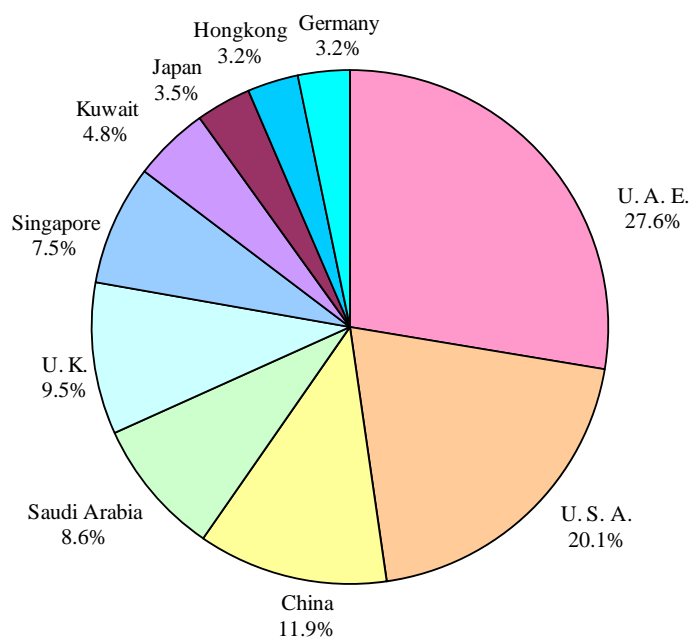

Figure 6: Annual Import of Goods & Services from FY06 to FY14

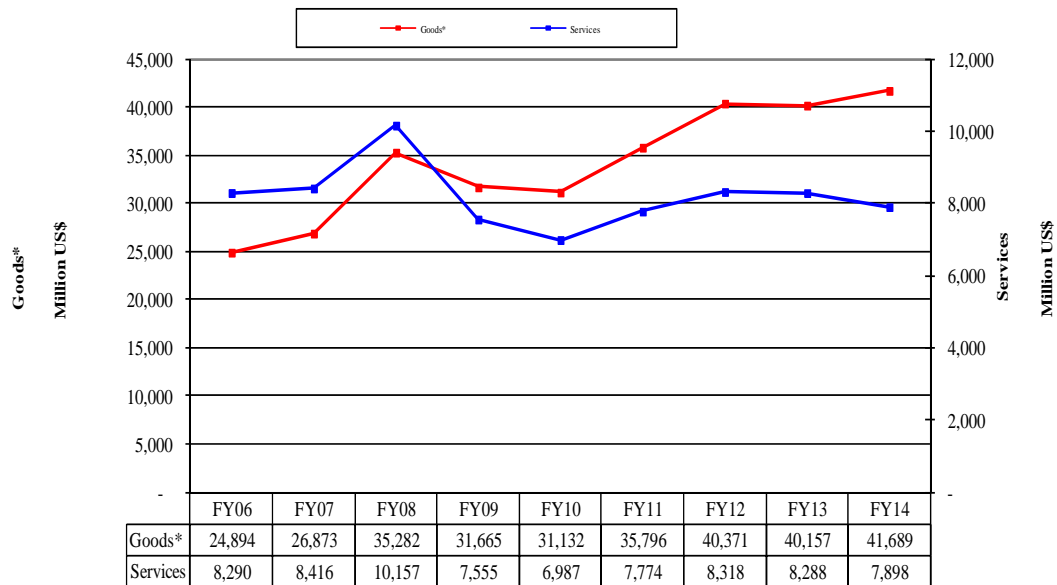
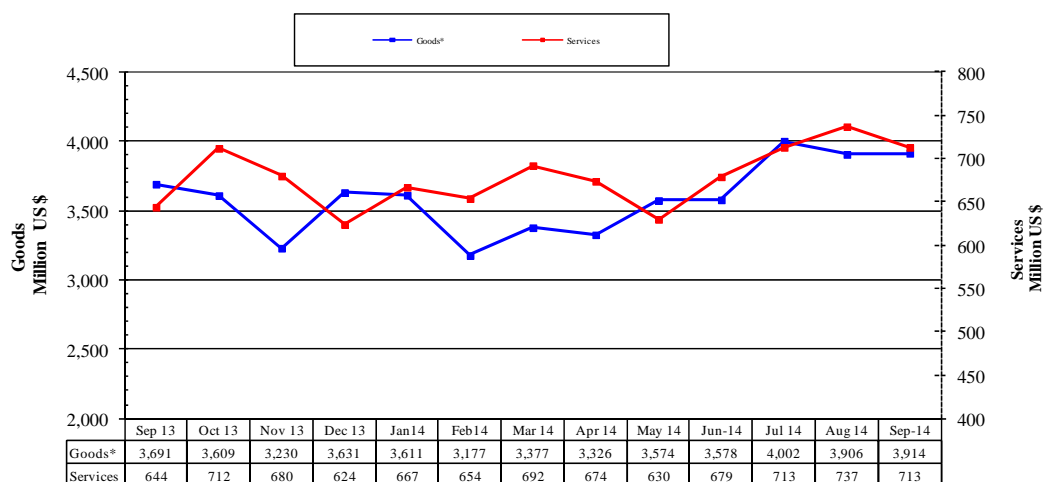


Figure 7: Monthly Imports of Goods & Services
