Figure 1. Imports During Jul-Apr

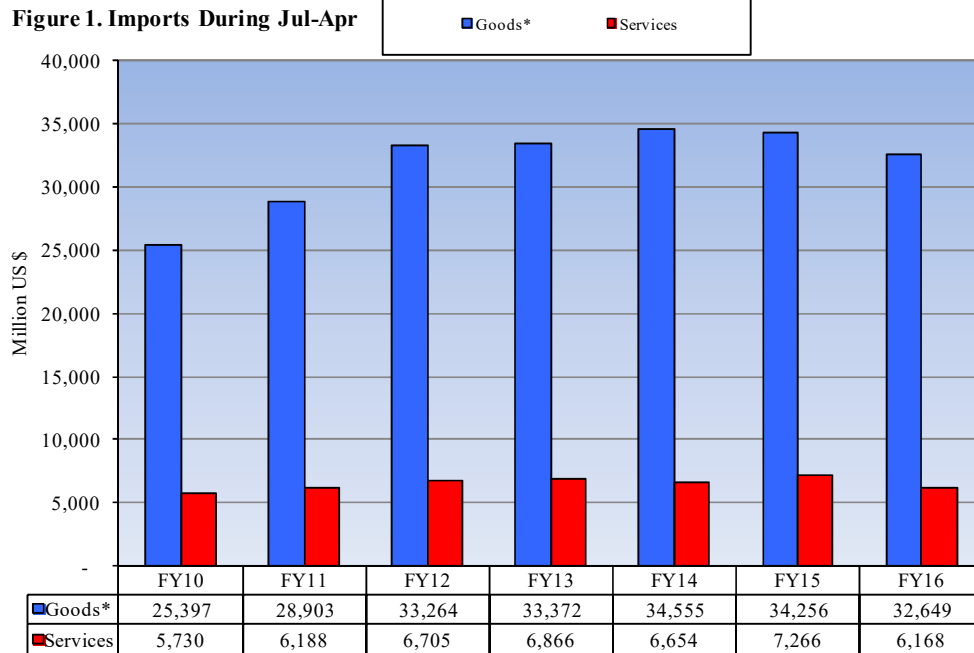


Figure 2: YOY Growth in Imports of Goods &amp; Services

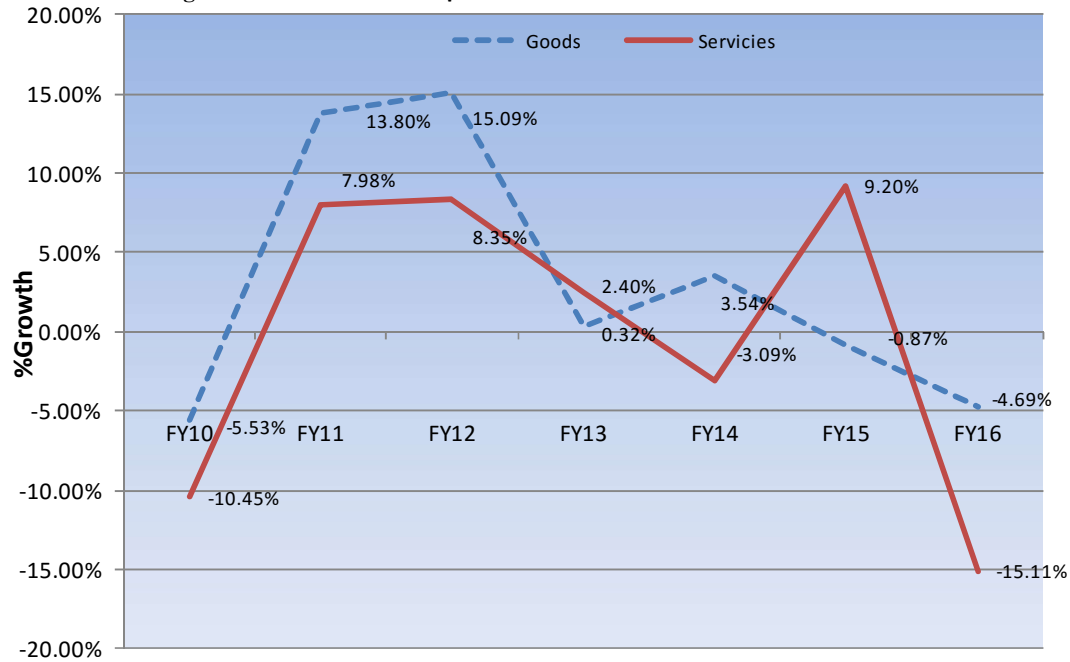

Figure3: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Imports Payments (Banks)

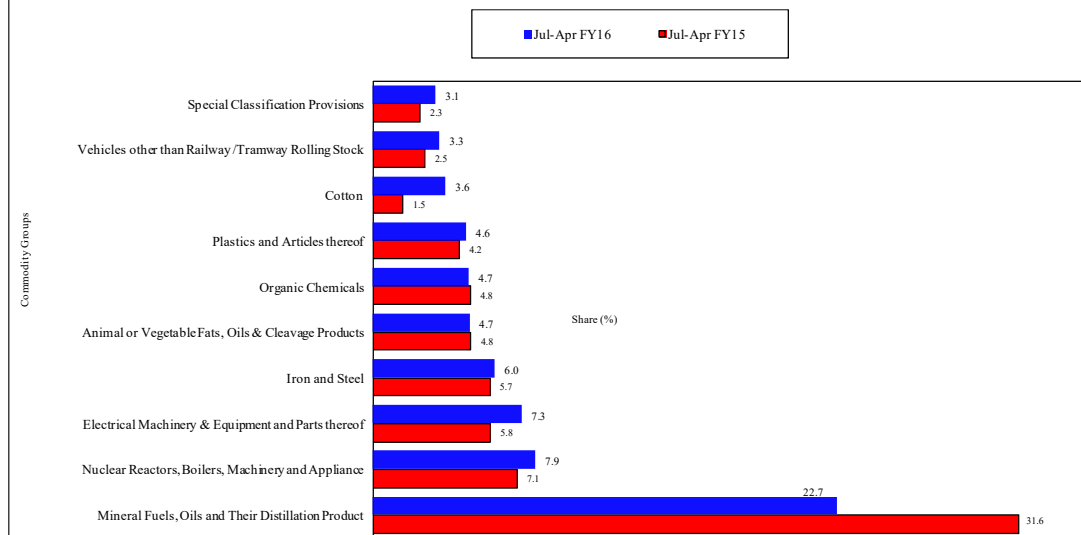
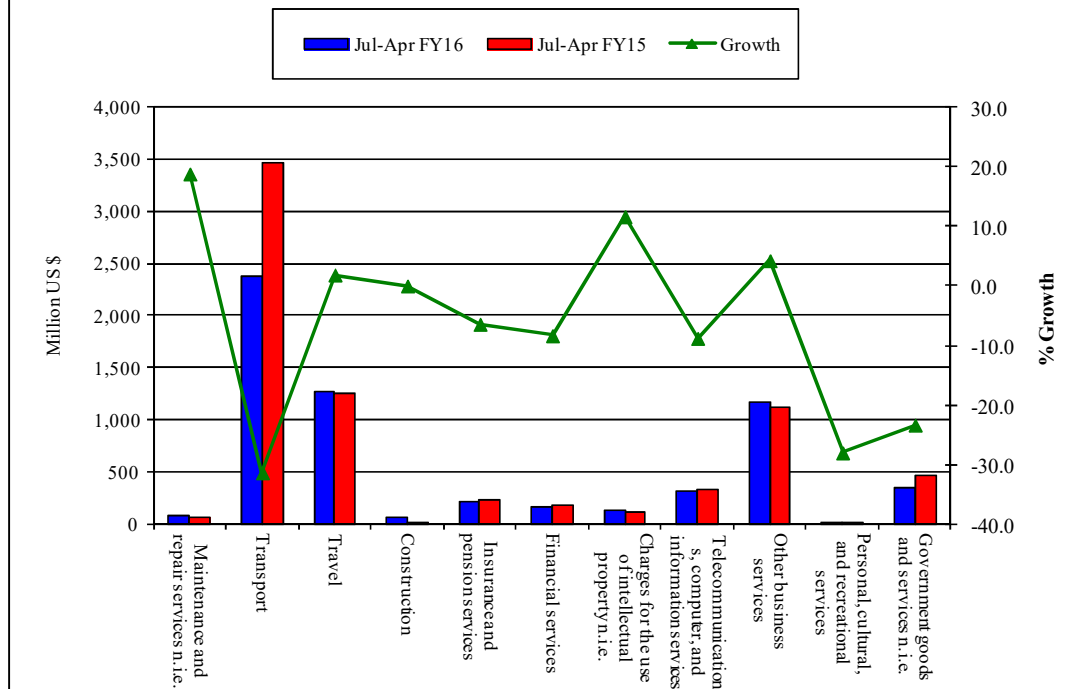


Figure4: Imports of Services

Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Imports Payments of Goods During Jul-Apr FY16

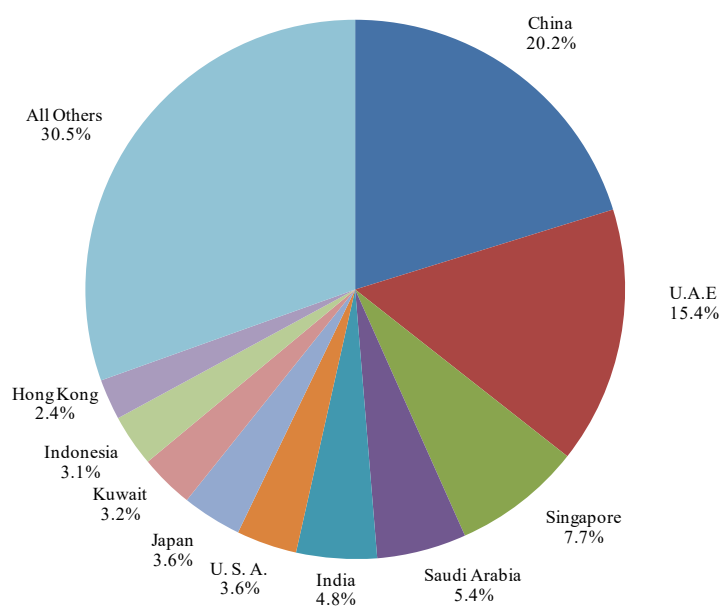
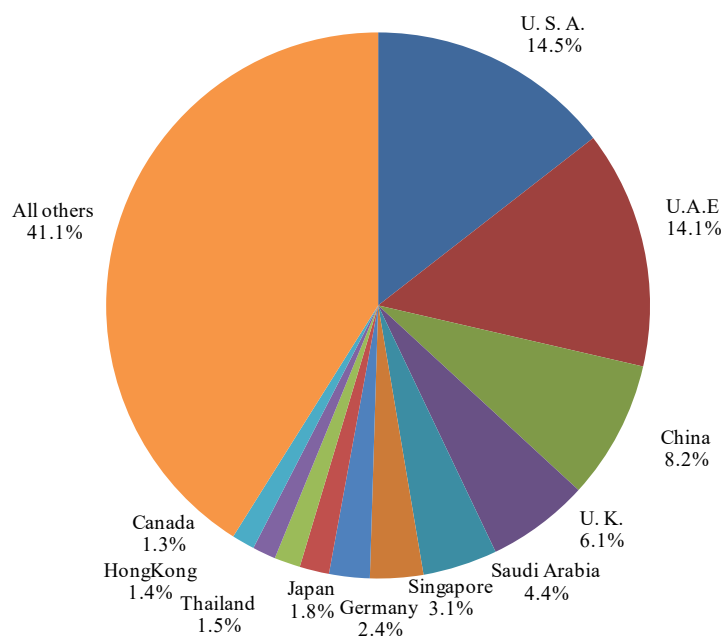


Figure 6: % Share of Major Countries in Imports of Services During July-Mar FY16

Figure 7: Annual Imports of Goods &amp; Services from FY08 to FY15

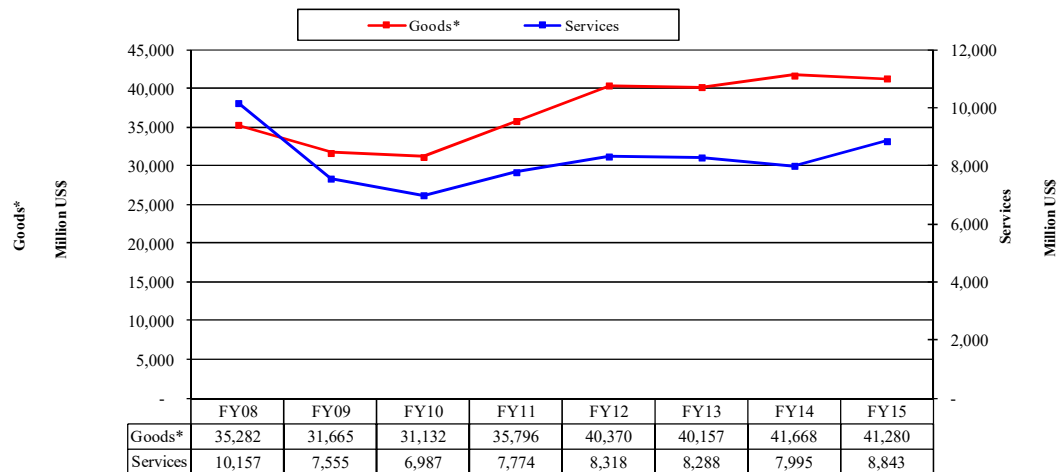


Figure 8: Monthly Imports of Goods &amp; Services
