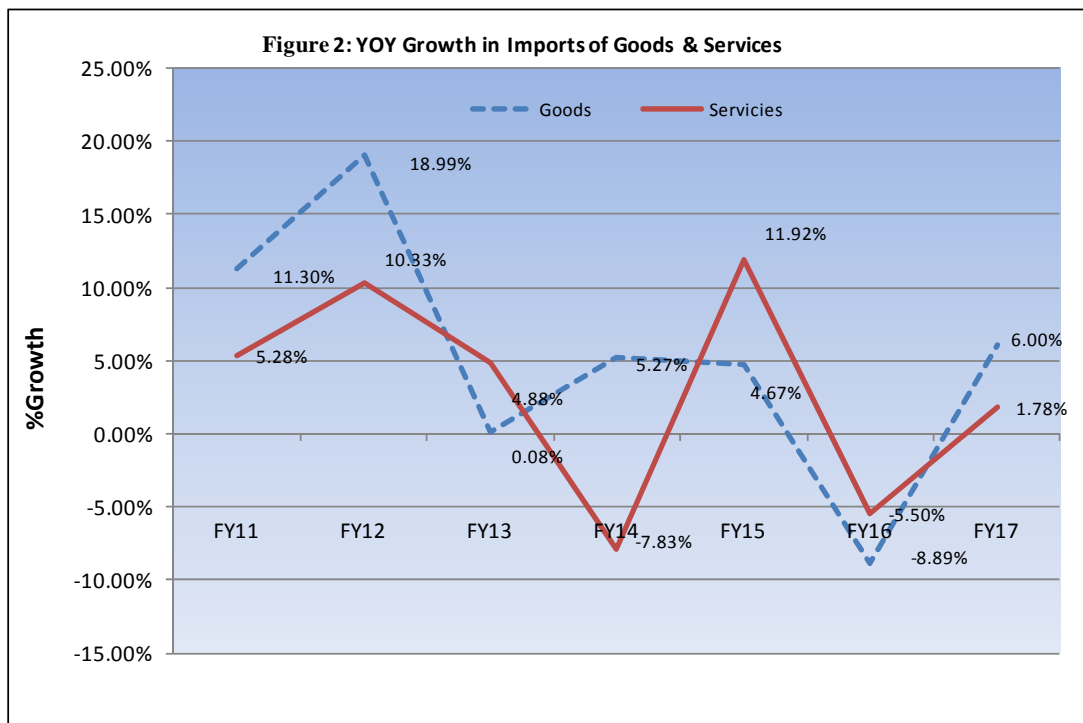
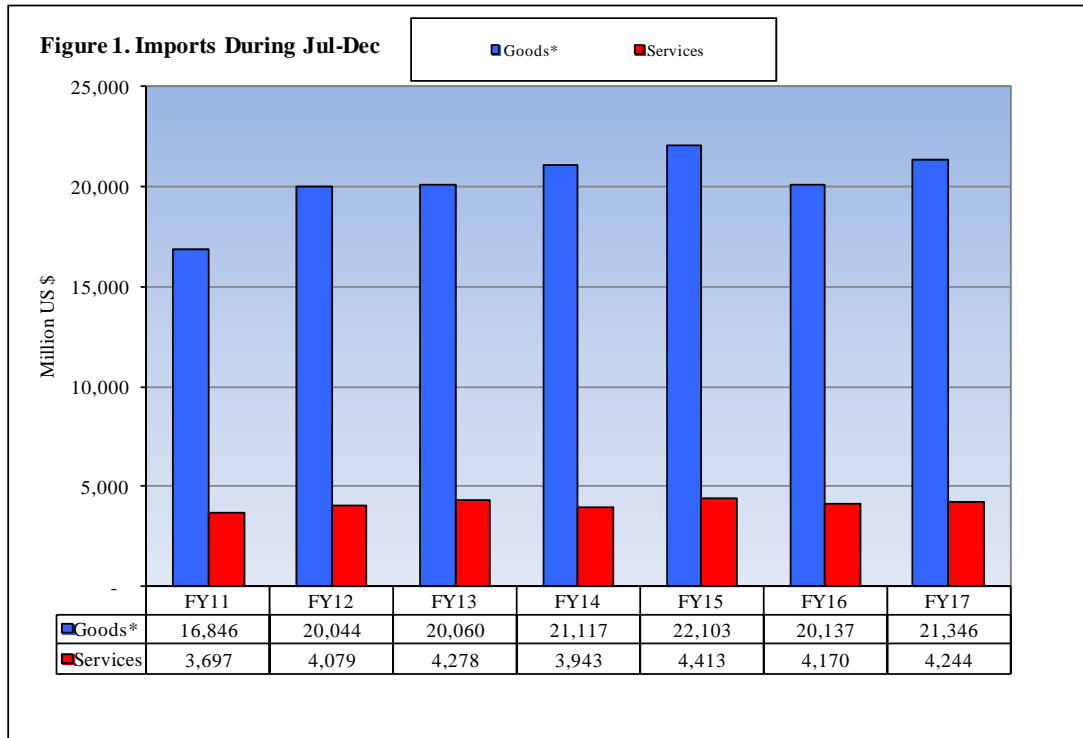

Figure 3: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Imports Payments (Banks)

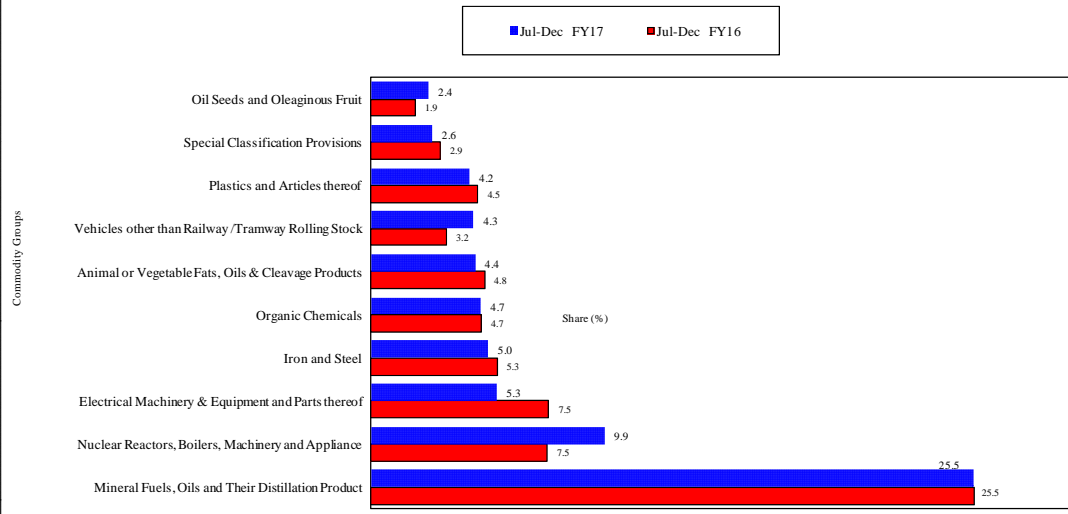
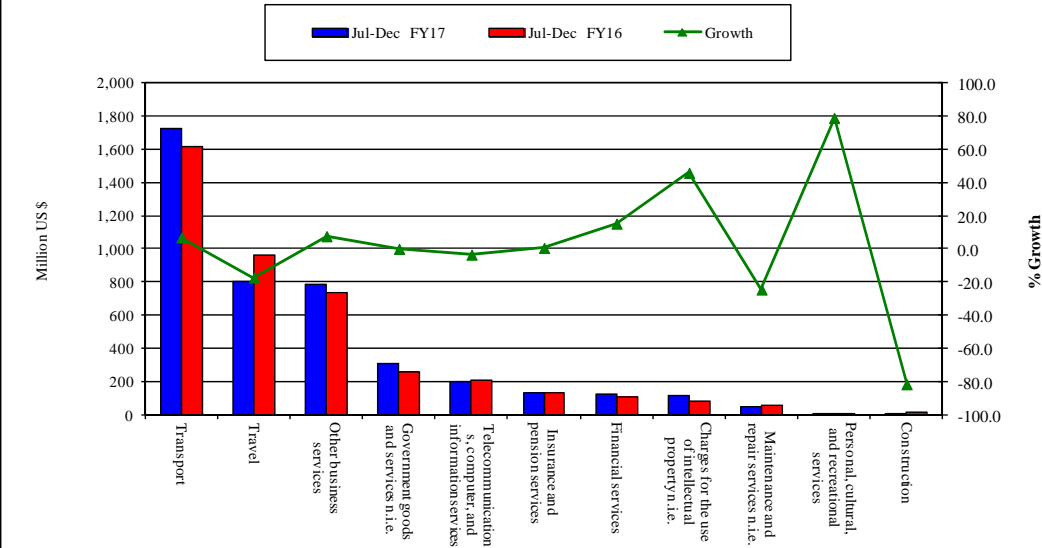


Figure 4: Imports of Services

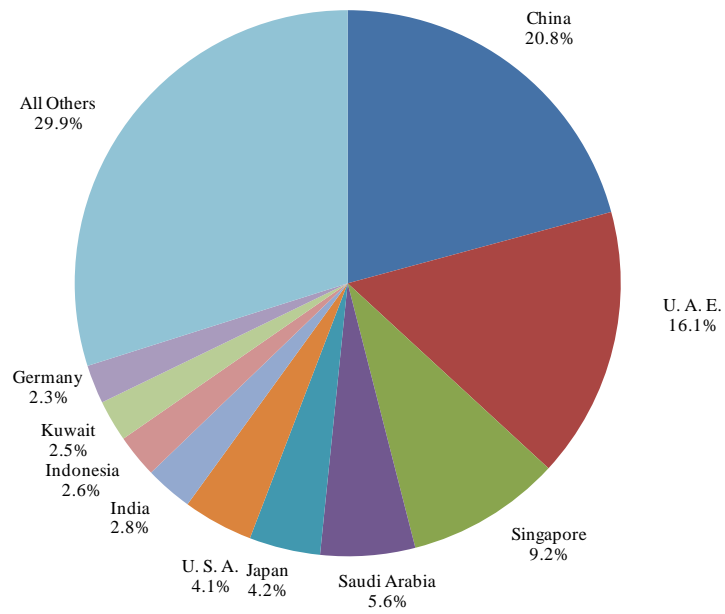
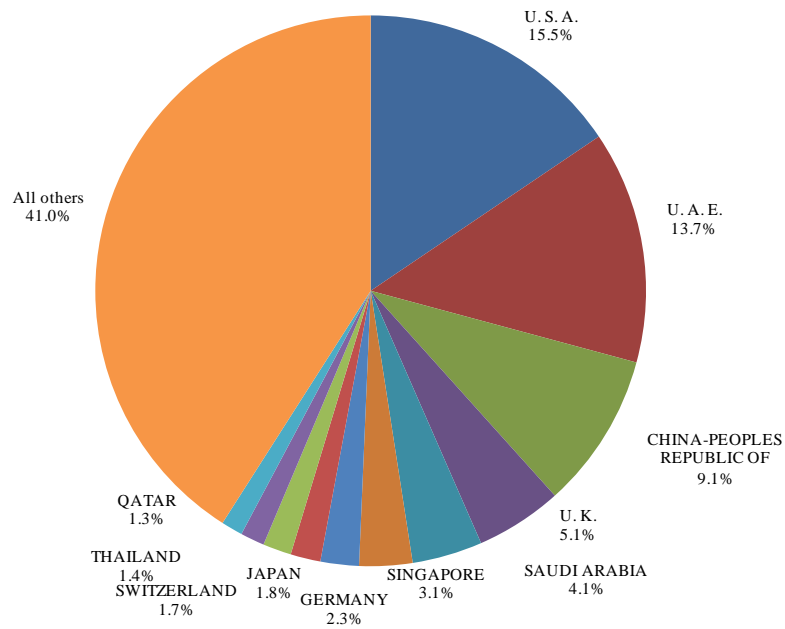

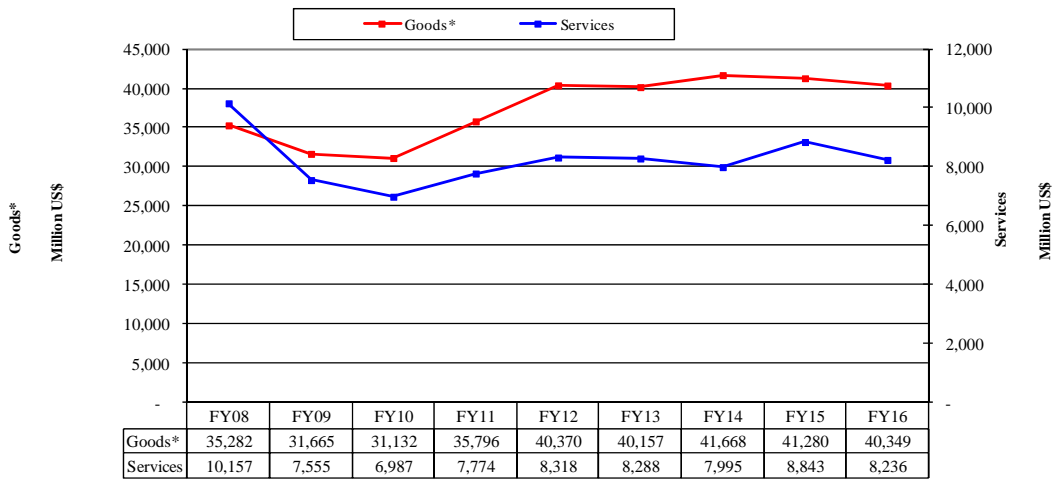

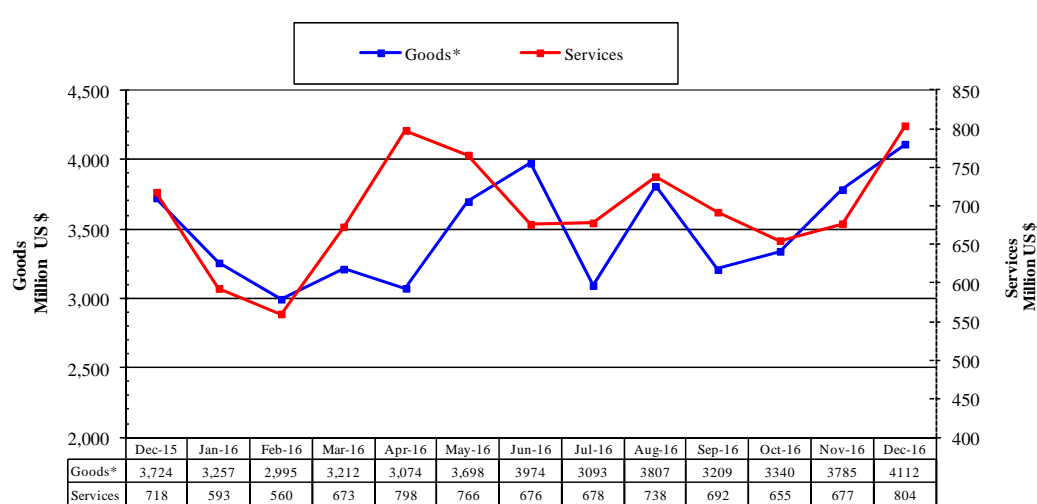
