Figure 4: % Share of Major Countries in Import Payments of Goods During Jul-Jun FY16

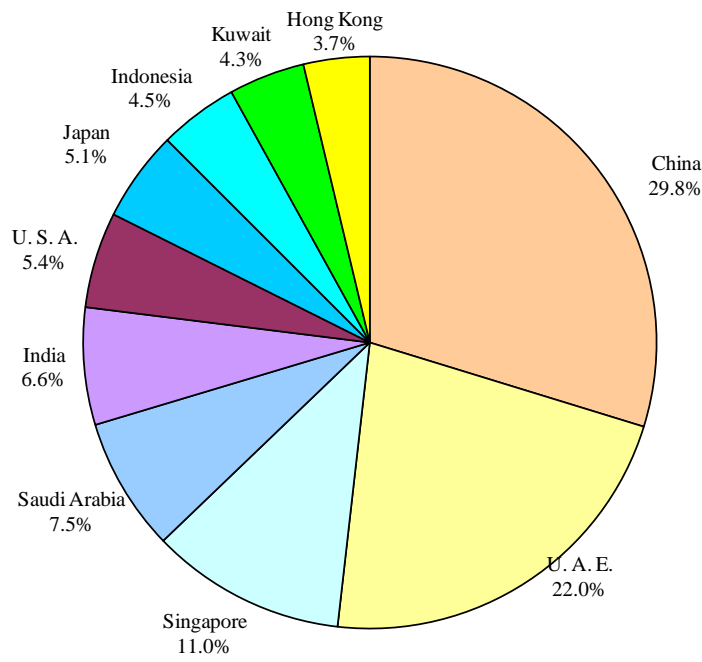
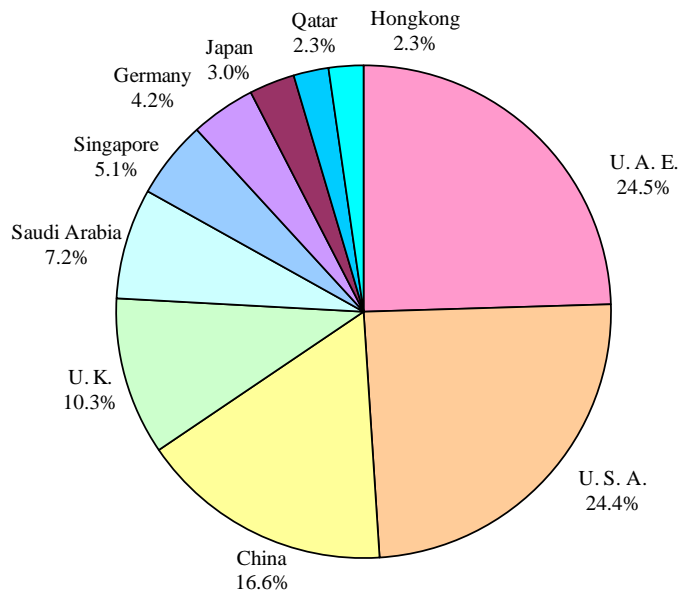
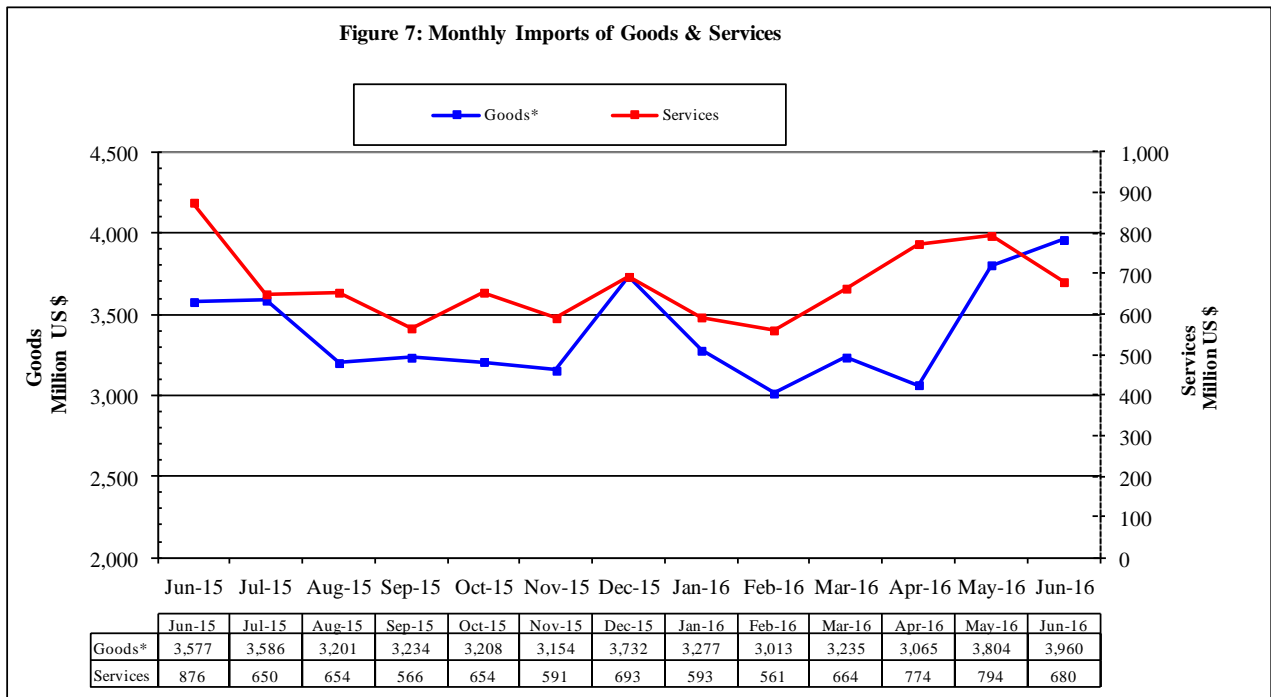
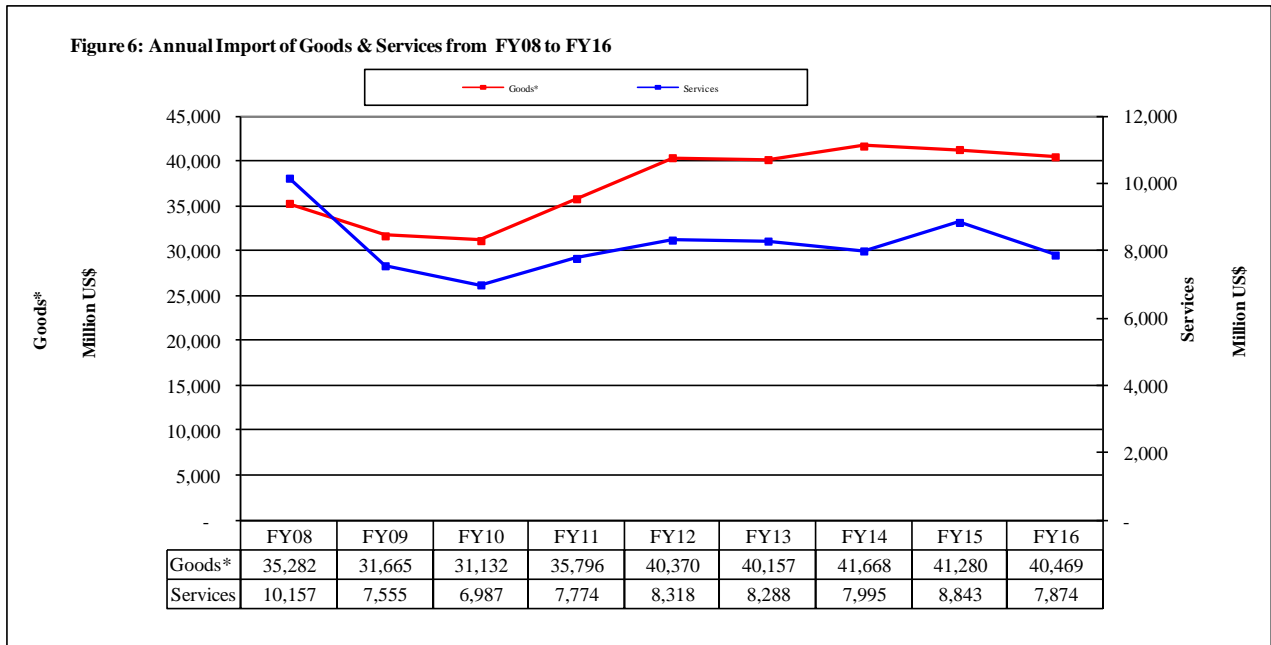


Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Import of Services During Jul-Jun FY16
