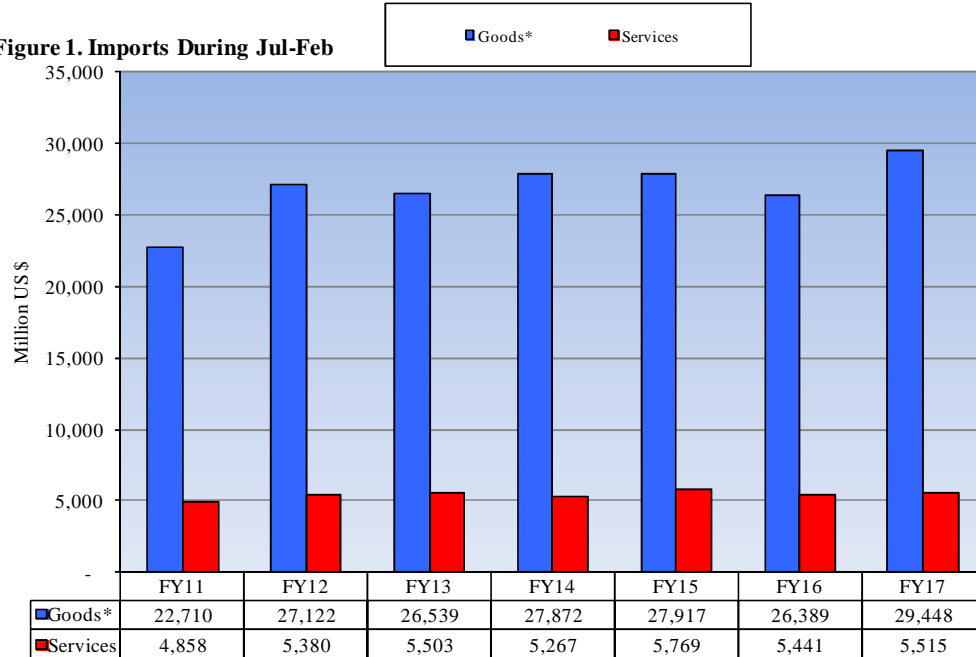
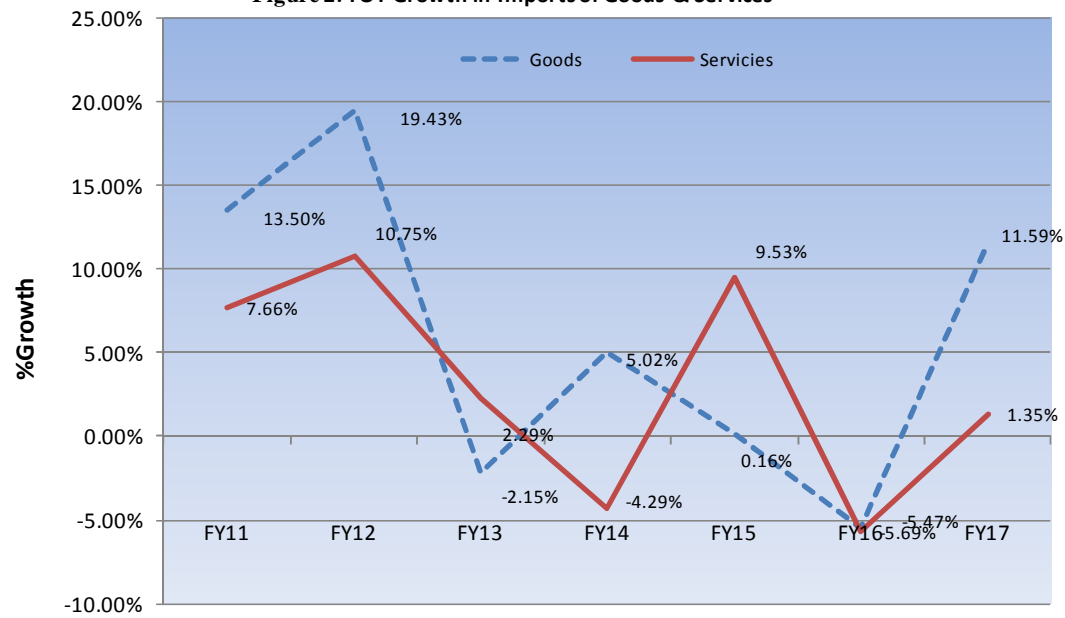
**Figure 1. Imports During Jul-Feb****Figure 2: YOY Growth in Imports of Goods & Services**

Figure 3: Percent Share of Major Commodity Groups in Imports Payments (Banks)

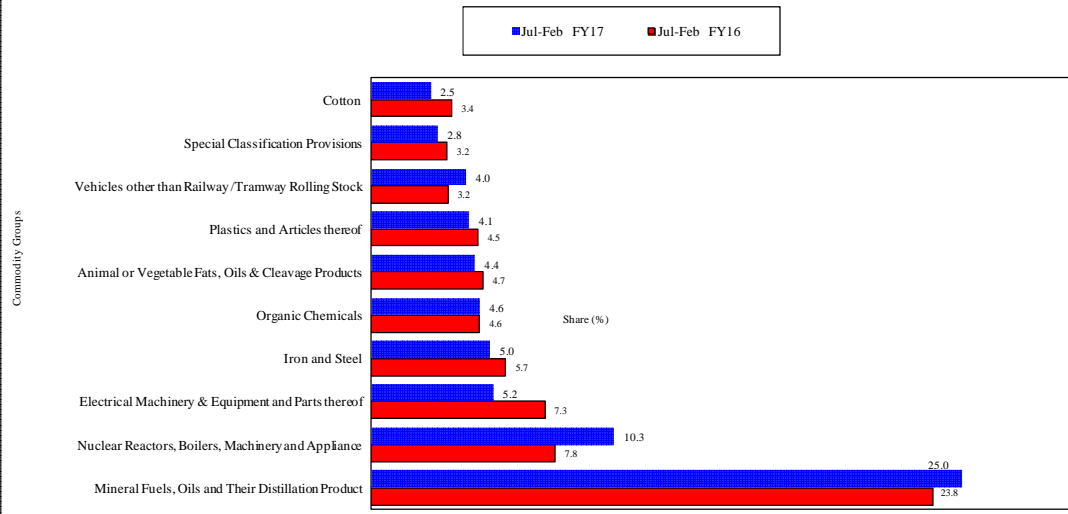
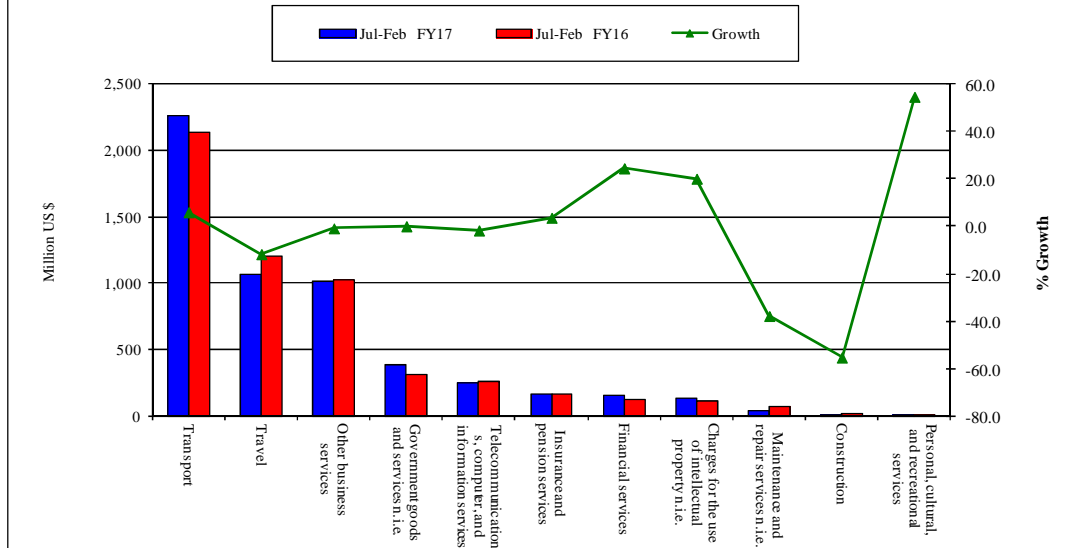


Figure 4: Imports of Services

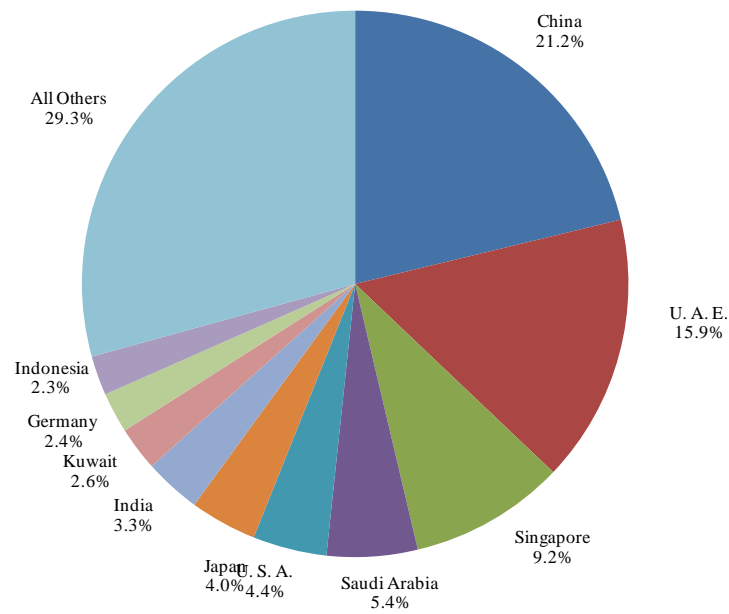
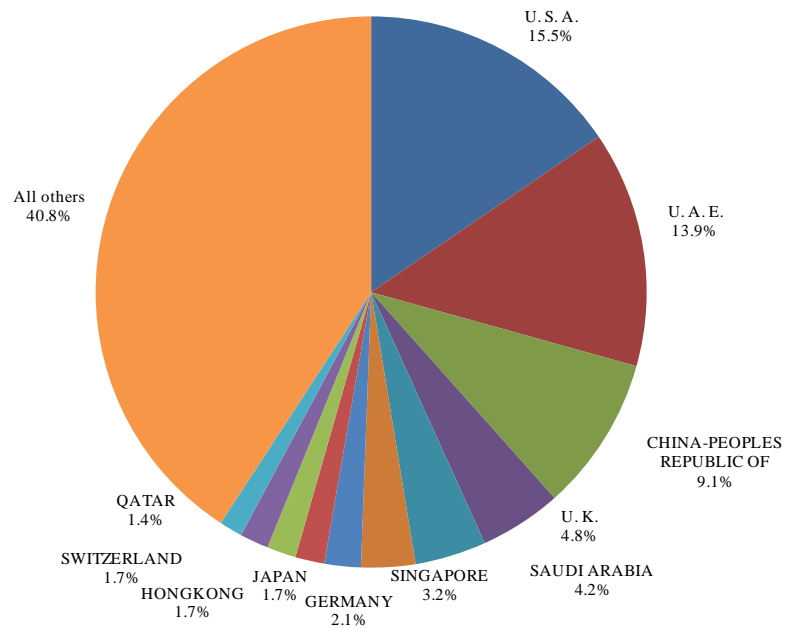

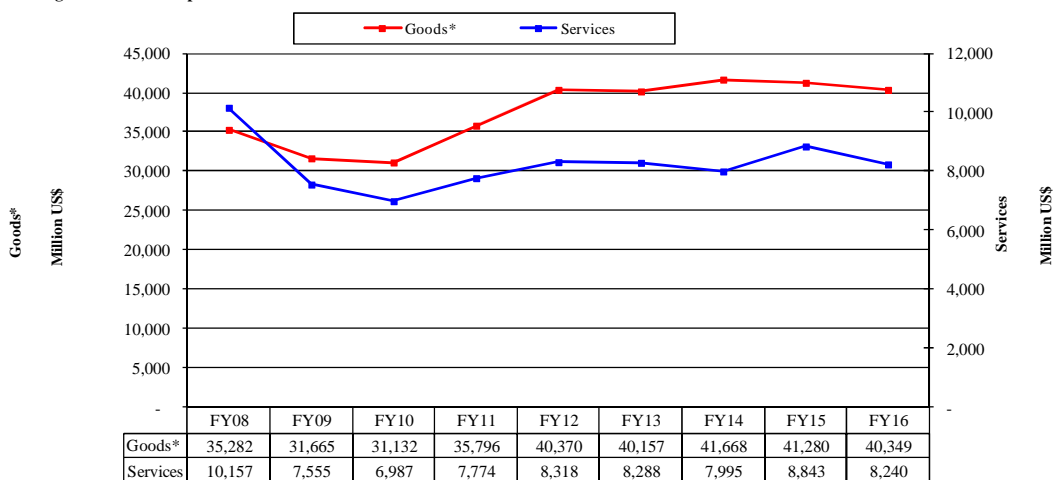
