Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Import Payments of Goods During July-January, FY19

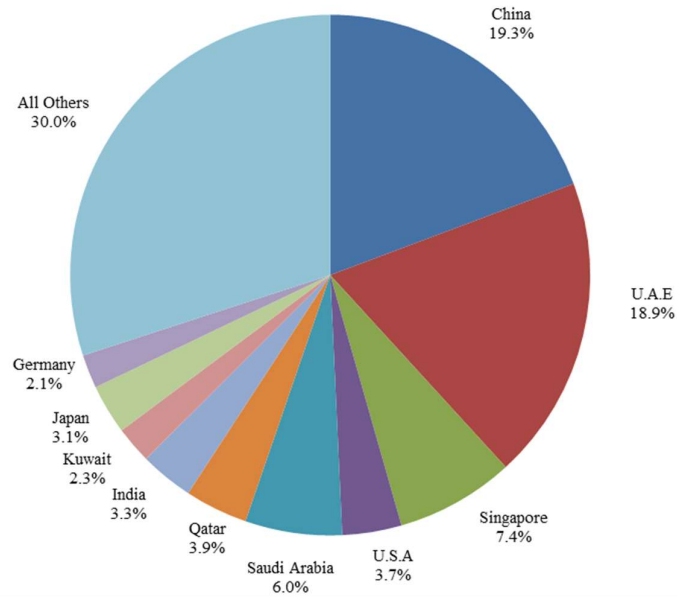
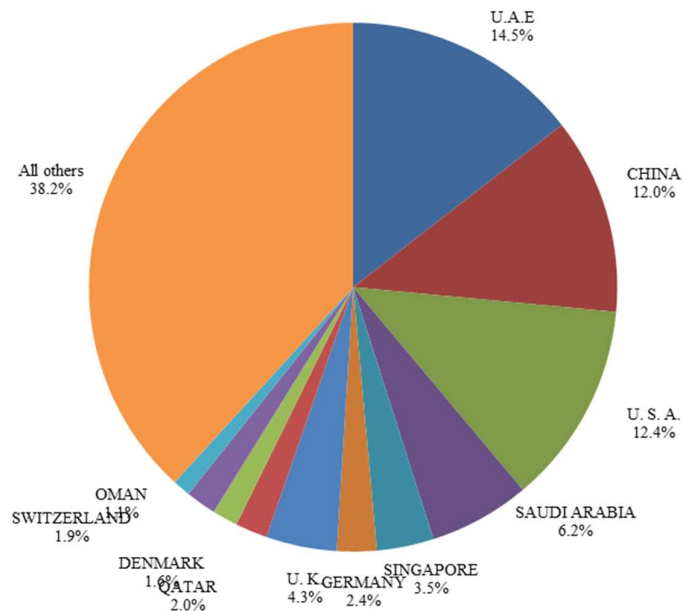
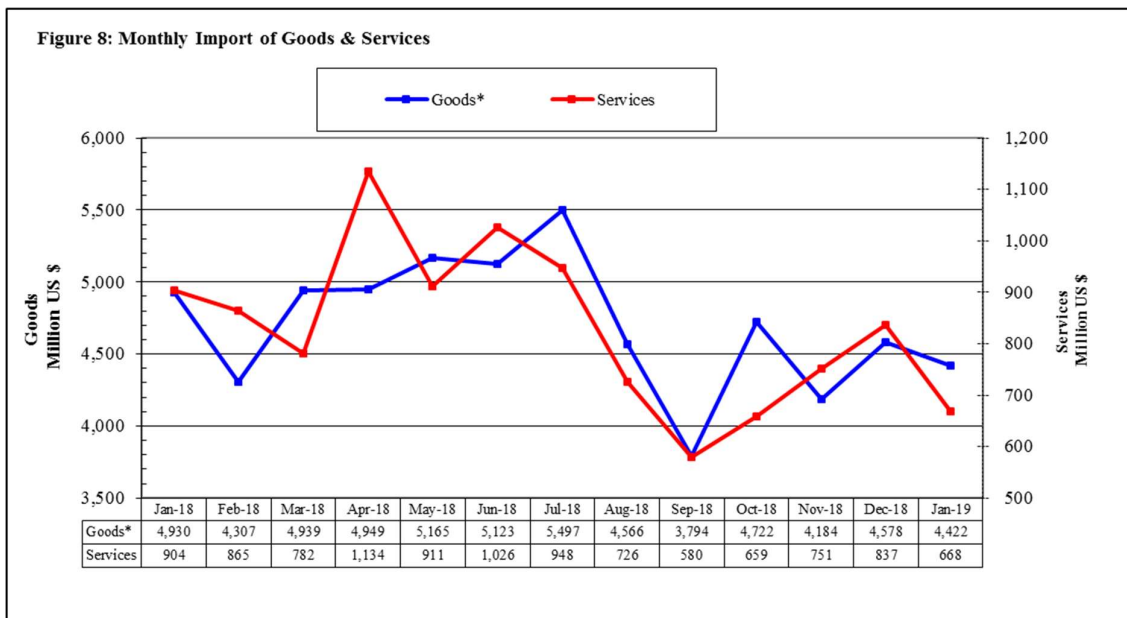
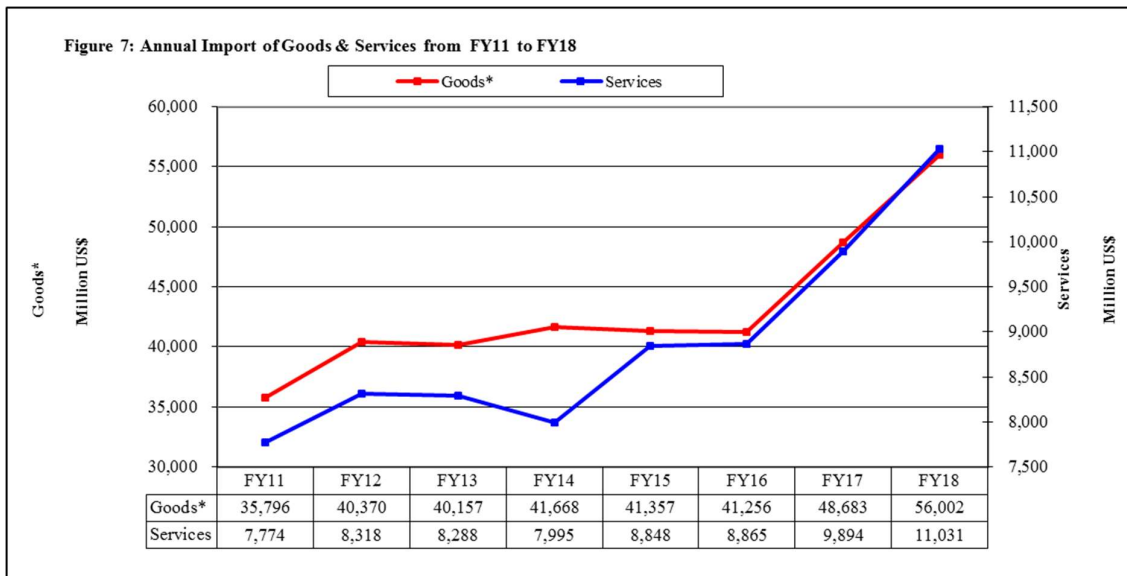


Figure 6: % Share of Major Countries in Import of Services During July-January, FY19
