Figure 5: % Share of Major Countries in Import Payments of Goods During Jul-Nov, FY20

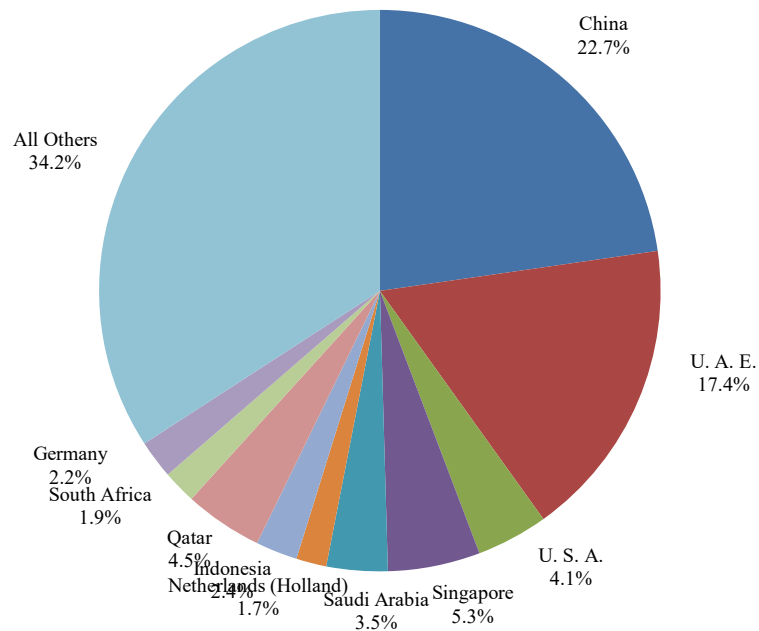
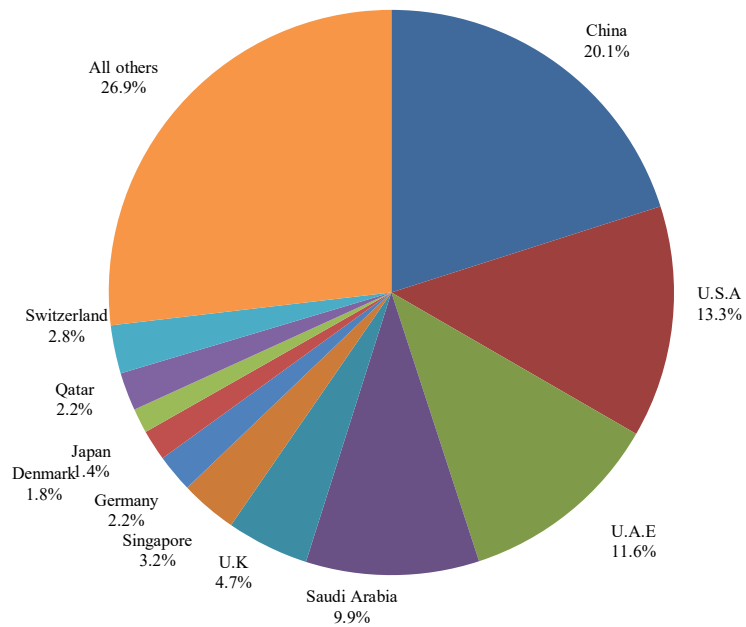


Figure 6: % Share of Major Countries in Import of Services During Jul-Nov, FY20

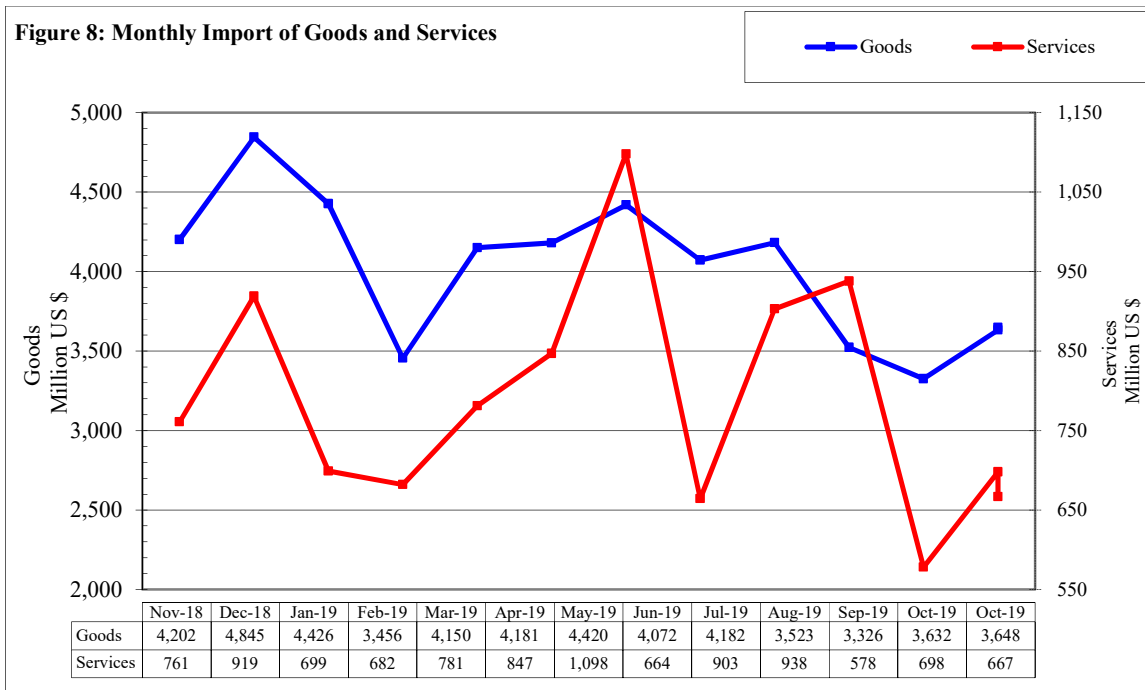
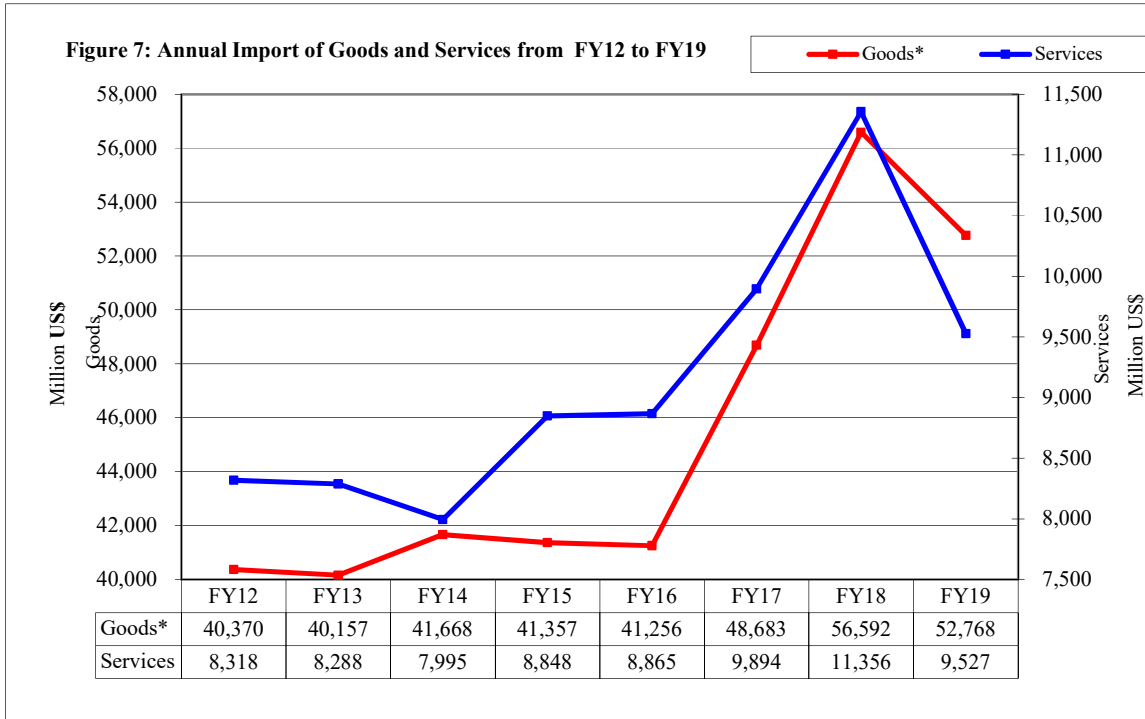
