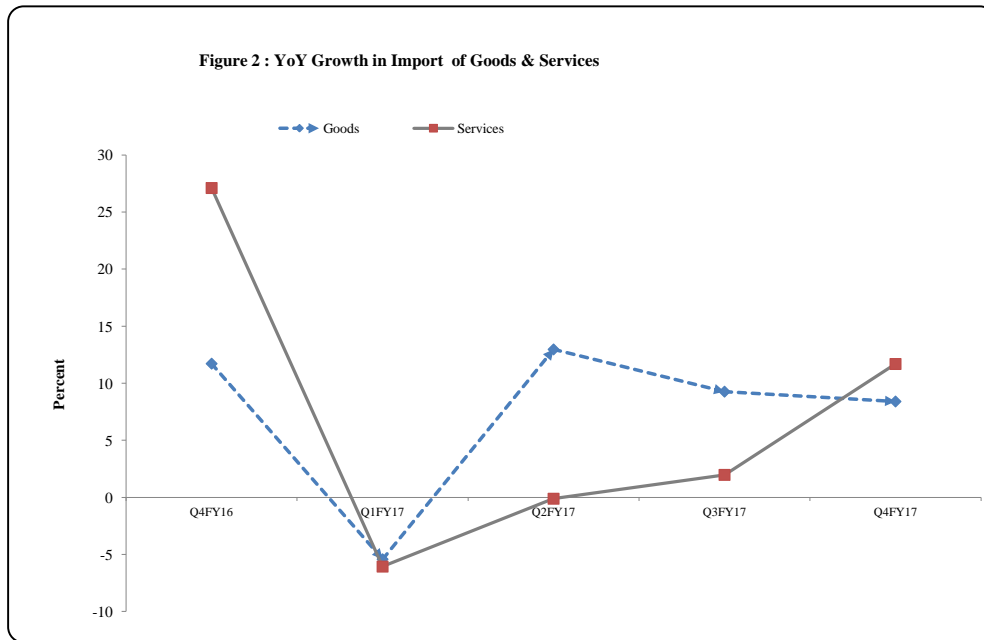
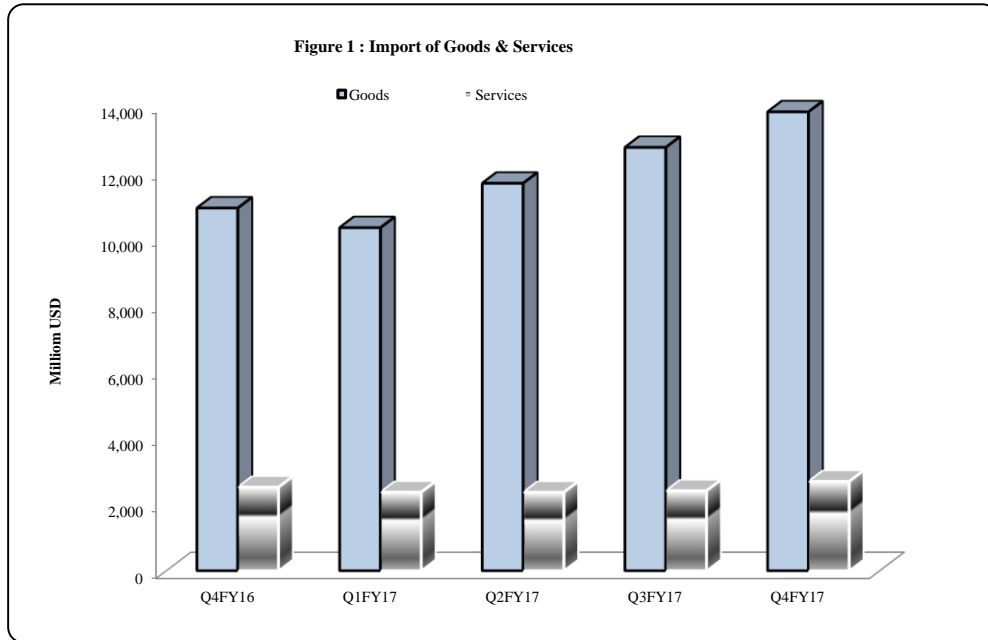

Figure 3: Percent Share of Major Commodities in Import Payments of Goods (Banks)

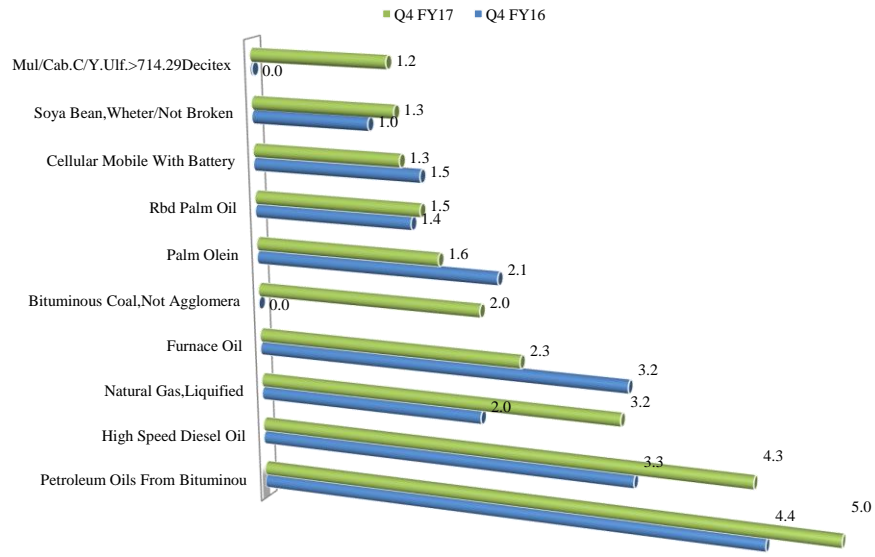


Figure 4: Import of Services

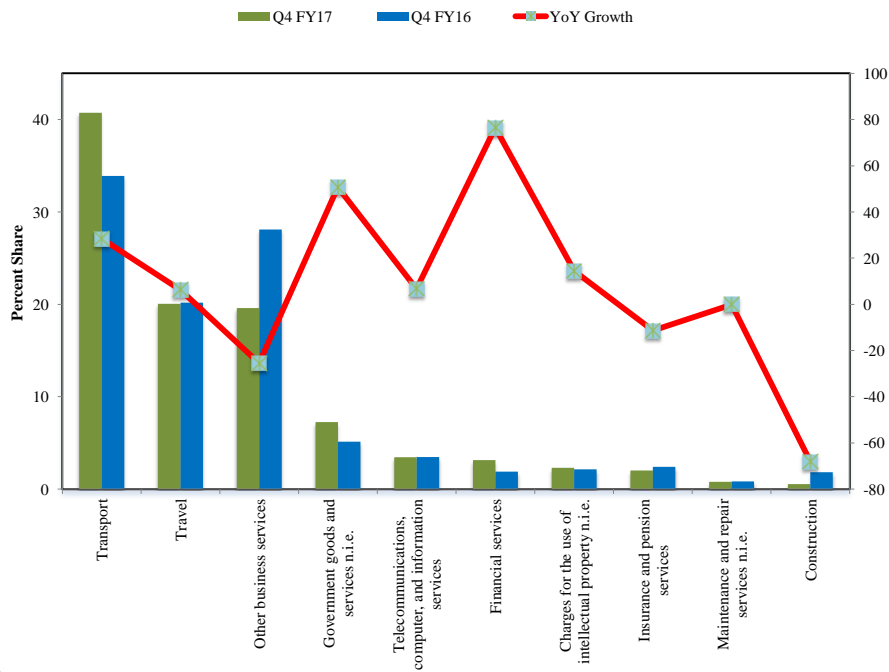

Figure 5: Percent Share of Major Countries in Import Payments of Goods (Banks)

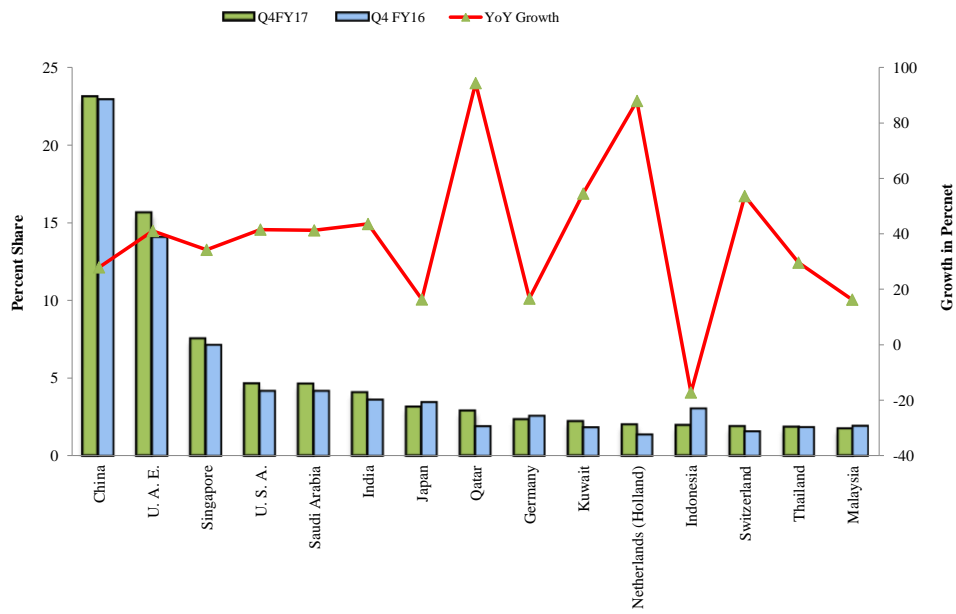
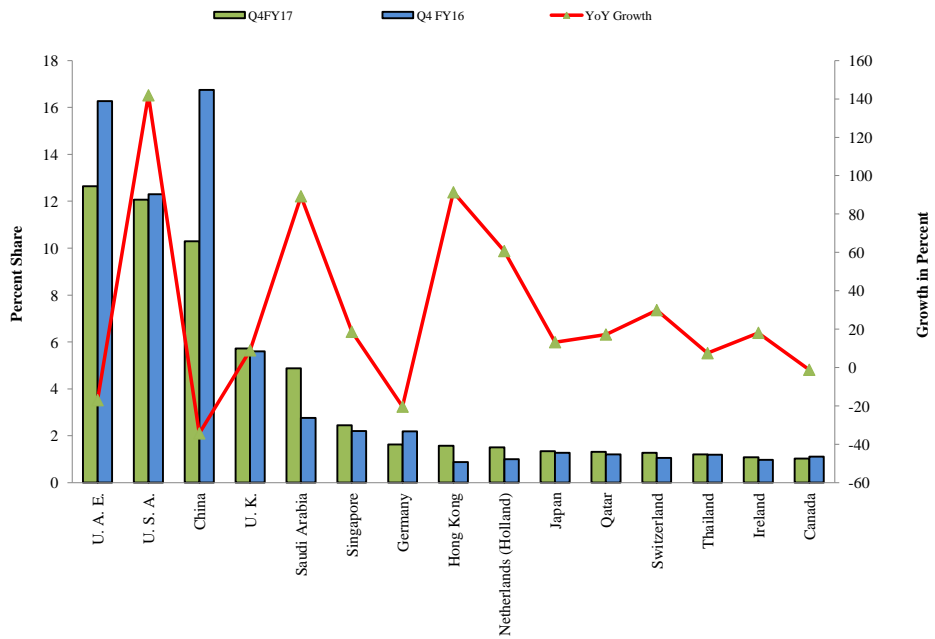


Figure 6: Percent Share of Major Countries in Import of Services



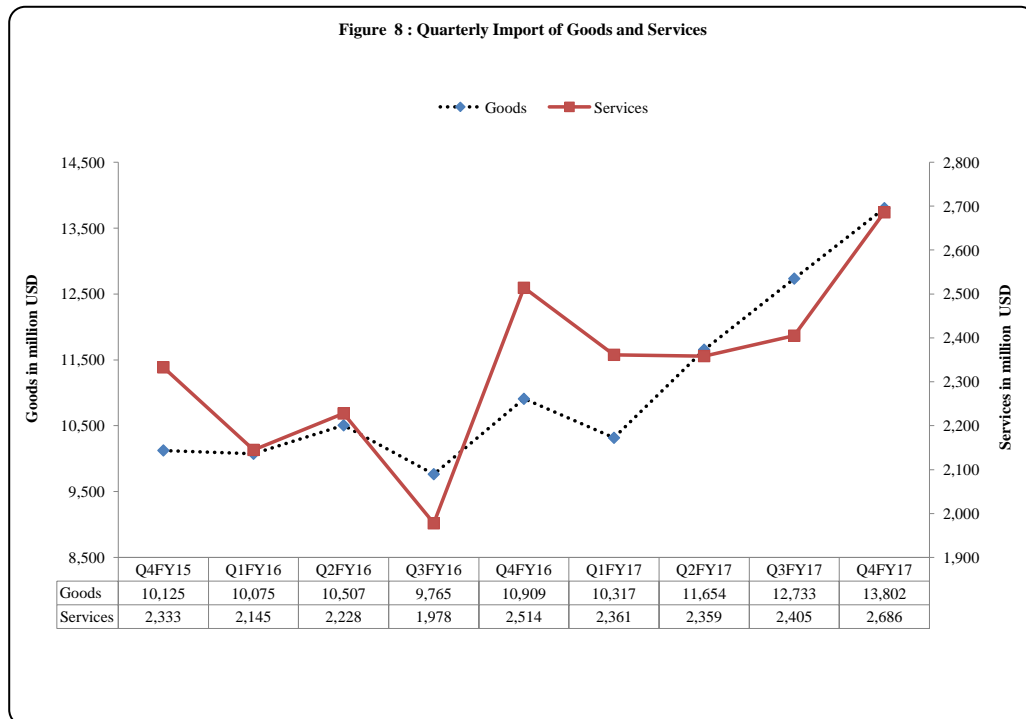
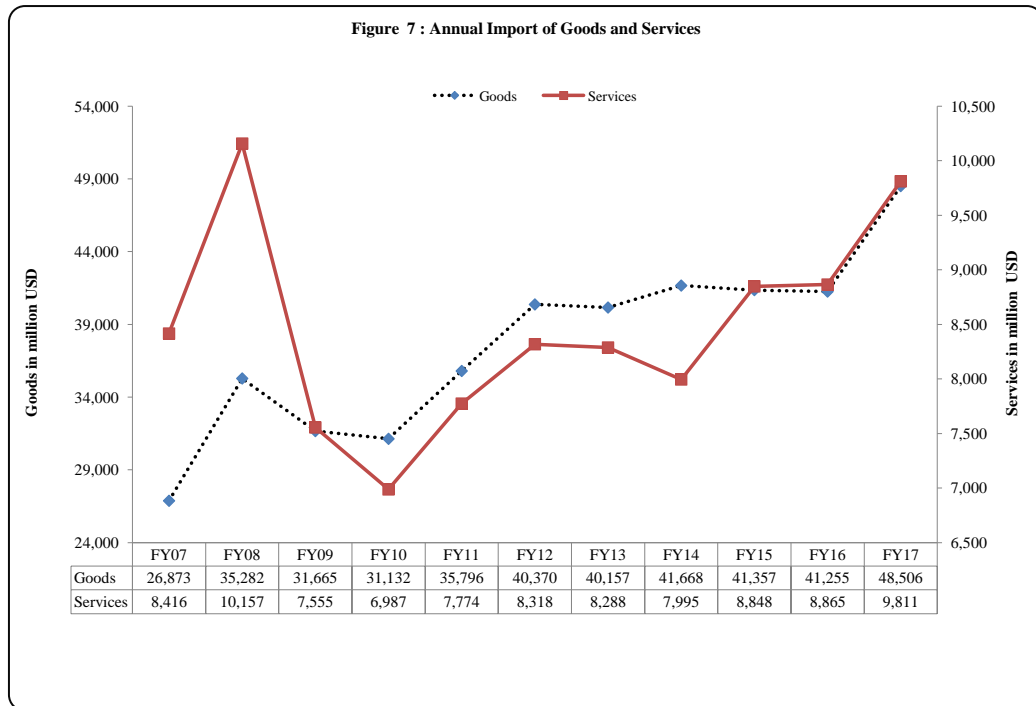
