Introduction of Lahore Office

On 1st July 1948 with the establishment of State Bank of Pakistan, two of its regional offices were also set up, one in Lahore and the other in Dacca. The office in Lahore was housed in Reserve Bank of India building at Nabha road till 1986, when it was shifted to new purpose built complex. After establishment of SBP BSC (Bank) on 2nd January 2002, the office has been discharging its statutory duties as one of the 16 subsidiary offices across the country.

Being the second largest economic hub of Pakistan, Lahore plays an important part in economic life of the country. Therefore, alongside its core responsibilities as an agent to central bank, Lahore office is also engaged in additional activities in the areas of development finance, prize bond (sale, encashment, draws and prize money disbursement) and public savings schemes.
