Muzaffarabad, the capital of Azad Jammu and Kashmir, is located at the confluence of Jhelum and Neelum rivers. The thriving cottage industry in the area revolves around carpet weaving, furniture making, wood carving, garment making and embroidery work. There are also a few textile centers which produce, shawls, bed sheets and coarse cloth.
