SUPPLY OF CHILLED WATER PUMPS FOR SCREW TYPE AIR-COOLED CHILLERS AT SBP MAIN BUILDING, KARACHI

Sealed Tenders are invited for the supply of chilled water pumps for screw type air-cooled chillers at SBP Main Building, Karachi from manufacturers/suppliers or their authorized agents with a minimum of three years experience, enlisted with Government, Autonomous Bodies or any reputed organization and have completed three similar works. The manufacturers/suppliers should be registered with Sales Tax and Income Tax Departments.

The interested firms shall apply for the tender documents along with their company profile with details of works of similar nature presently in hand and executed during the last three years with cost supported by documentary evidence. Tender Documents for the captioned job can be obtained from the office of the Director Engineering on payment of a non-refundable amount of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) (in cash).

The amount of Earnest Money is 2% of total tendered amount payable in the form of a Bank Draft/Payment Order in favour of the State Bank of Pakistan, SBP BSC (Bank), Head Office, Karachi. Incomplete, conditional and tenders without earnest money shall not be accepted. No tender documents will be issued on the date fixed for opening of tenders. The competent authority has rights to reject any/all tenders as per PPRA's rules.

The tender duly filled in as required should be dropped in the sealed Tender Box kept with the P.A. to Director, Engineering Department, State Bank of Pakistan, SBP BSC (Bank), 1st floor, Bolton Market Building, M.A. Jinnah Road, Karachi by 11.00 A.M. on 16-03-2010. The tenders will be opened on the same day at 11.30 A.M. in the presence of representatives of bidders who may wish to be present. Further, personal convincing or recommendations will also disqualify the bidders.
