Figure 1: Export Receipts of Goods from Group of Countries

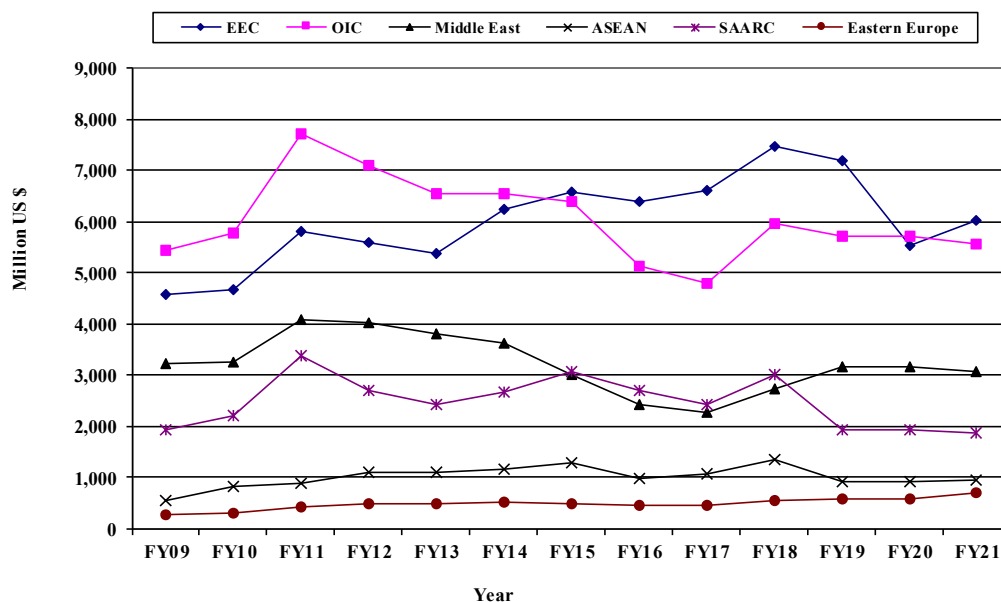

Figure 2: % Share of major commodities in export receipts

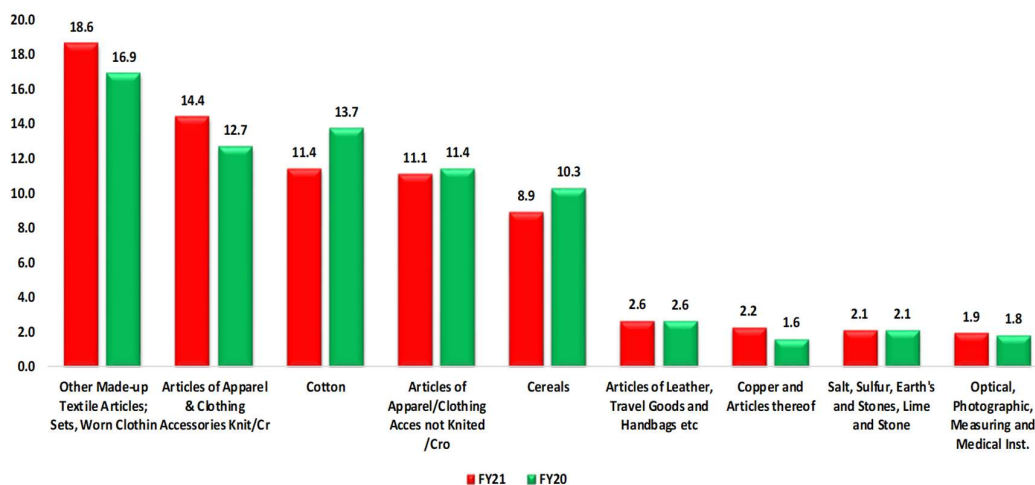

Figure 3: % Share of major countries in export receipts

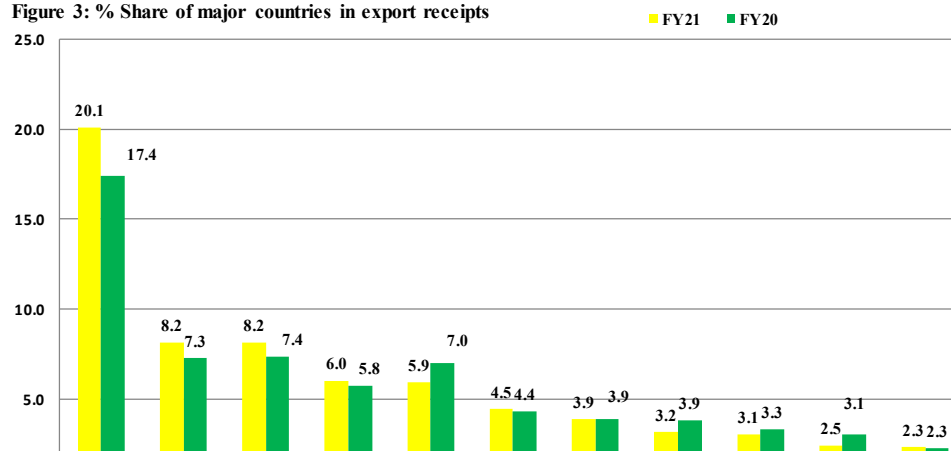

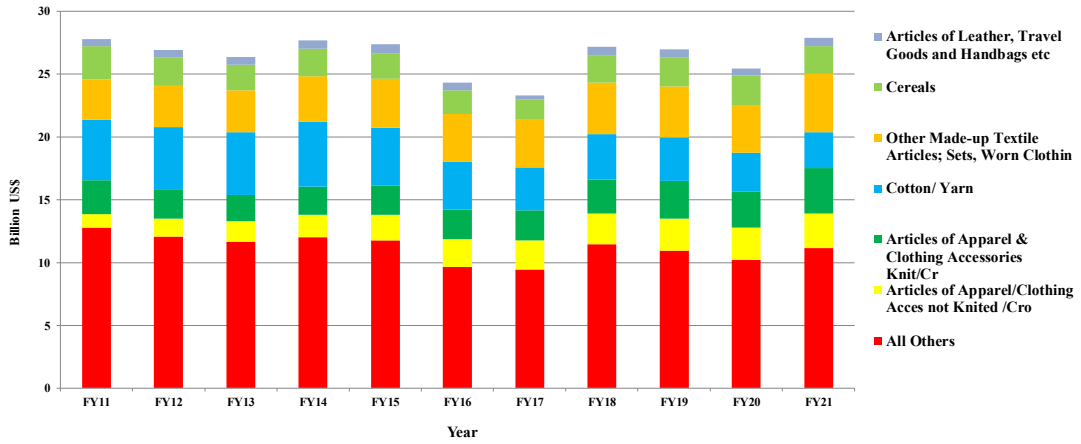

Billion USD

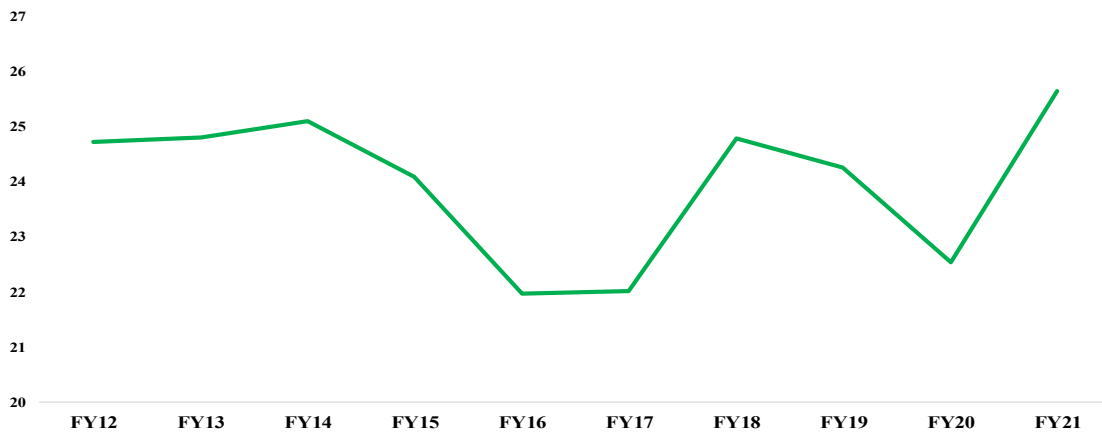


Figure 6: Exports of Services
Billion USD

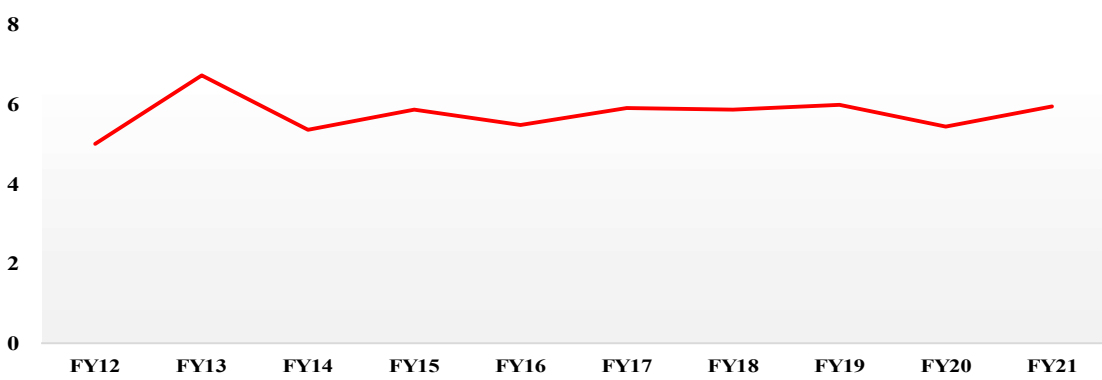
