ORDER

Islamabad, the 9th April, 2003

S.R.O. 335 (I)/2003.-- WHEREAS it is expedient to take necessary measures to protect the public morality, including control of illegal trade and smuggling:

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of provisions of Article X of the Agreement between the Government of Islamic Republic of Pakistan and the Government of Afghanistan for regulation of traffic in transit and in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950) and in supersession of its Notification numbers S.R.O. 135 (1)/96 dated the 12th February, 1996 and S.R.O. 517 (1)/2001, dated the 14th July, 2001, the Federal Government is pleased to prohibit
