
NOTIFICATION

Subject: SUBSIDY FOR "EXPORT / OFF LOAD OF WHEAT STOCKS"

Economic Coordination Committee (ECC) of the Cabinet in case No. ECC-19/3/2015 dated 09-02-2015 titled "Export / Offload of Wheat Stocks" has allowed export of wheat from the Province of Sindh (400,000 metric tons) and Punjab (800,000 metric tons) with export rebate of US\$ 45 per metric ton and US\$55 metric ton respectively as notified by Ministry of National Food Security and Research on 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2015.

2. As directed by the ECC, the following procedure has been developed to complete the expeditious export of the Wheat stock/Flour and payment of rebate:-

- i. A Special Account will be opened at State Bank of Pakistan with the title "Support of Wheat / Flour Export";
- ii. Government of Pakistan, through Ministry of Finance, will deposit Rs. 1.55 billion in the said account as first tranche to start the export of Wheat / Flour;
- iii. The said account will be replenished as the scheme progresses;
- iv. SBP will develop due procedure for the authorized dealers (Ads) for expeditious release of support as soon as export receipts are realized;
- v. Necessary details of exports comprising name of exporter, address (place of business), quantities, destinations and value etc. will be maintained by SBP.

"The Economic Coordination Committee of the Cabinet (ECC) considered the Summary, dated 4<sup>th</sup> February, 2015 submitted by the Ministry of National Food Security & Research on "Offload/Export Public Sector's Surplus Wheat Stocks" and decided as under:

- I. Allowed export of 800, 000 M. tons wheat by the Government of Punjab with the transportation assistance of US\$ 55 per M/ton.
  - II. Allowed export of 400, 000 M. tons wheat by the Government of Sindh with the transportation assistance of US\$ 45 per M/ton.
  - III. Against procurement of specific quantity of wheat from the Provincial Food Departments, the exporters would be bound to export equal quantity of wheat flour (Aata). For example: for 100 tons of wheat procured, the exporters would export 100 tons wheat flour (Aata).
  - IV. Imposed ban on the import of wheat products with immediate effect.
2. Secretary, Finance Division would devise a mechanism for making early payment of subsidies on export of wheat and wheat flour (Aata).



"The Economic Coordination Committee of the Cabinet (ECC) considered the Summary, dated 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2015 submitted by the Ministry of National Food Security & Research on "**Offload/Export Public Sector's Surplus Wheat Stocks**" and decided as under:

- I. Allowed export of 800, 000 M. tons wheat by the Government of Punjab at a rebate of US\$ 55 per M/ton. (including transportation charges @ US\$ 10/ton)
  - II. Allowed export of 400, 000 M. tons wheat by the Government of Sindh at a rebate of US\$ 45 per M/ton.
  - III. Imposed ban on the import of wheat products with immediate effect.
2. The following procedure would be adopted to implement the above Decision.
- a. The Provincial Governments and Wheat Exporters will sign an agreement for export of wheat
  - b. Exporters will submit a Letter of Credit (LC) for 45 days plus bank guarantee equivalent to amount of subsidy (in PKR). The Bank guarantee will be automatically released on validation of export documents by the Provincial Governments.
